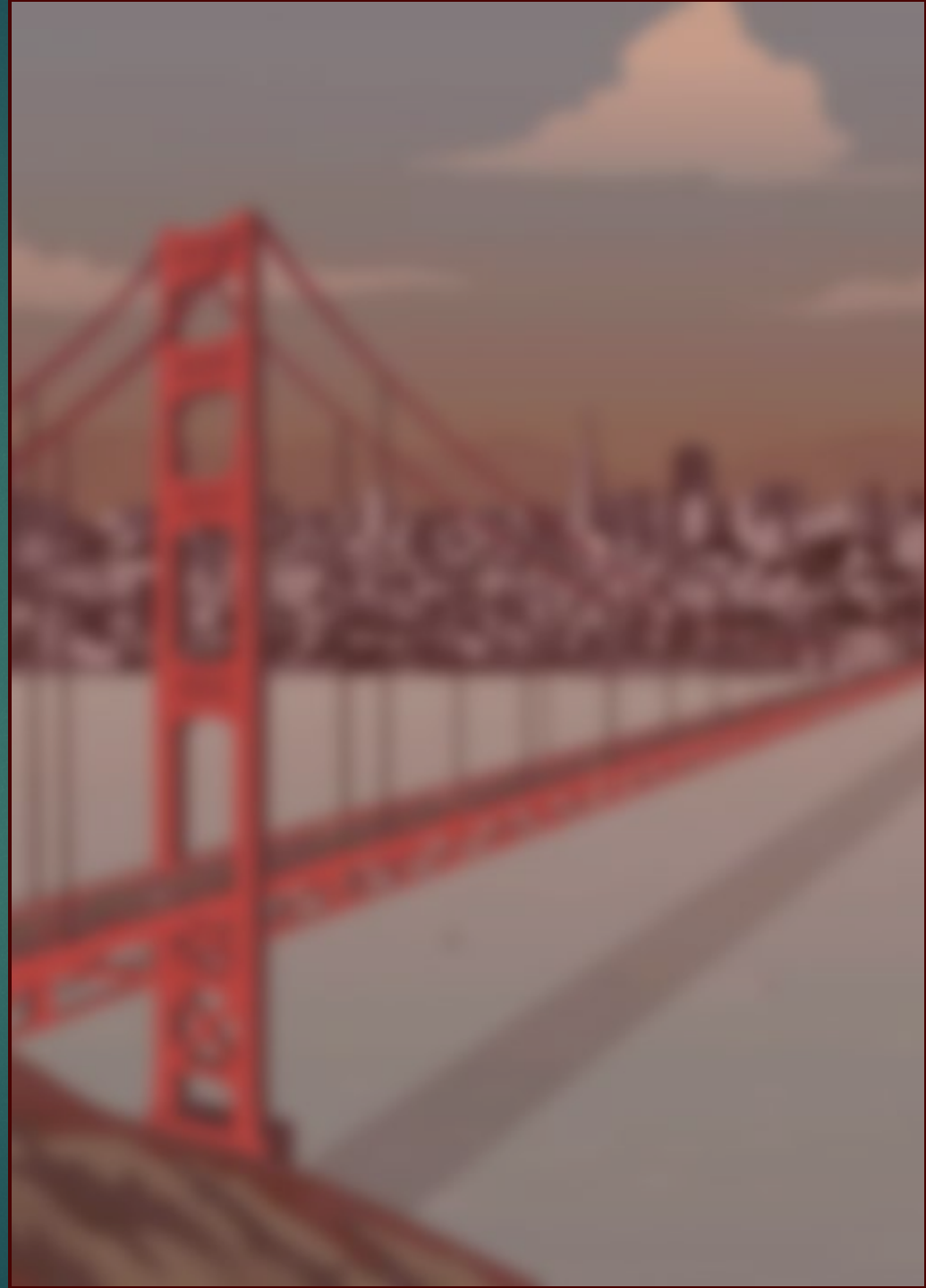

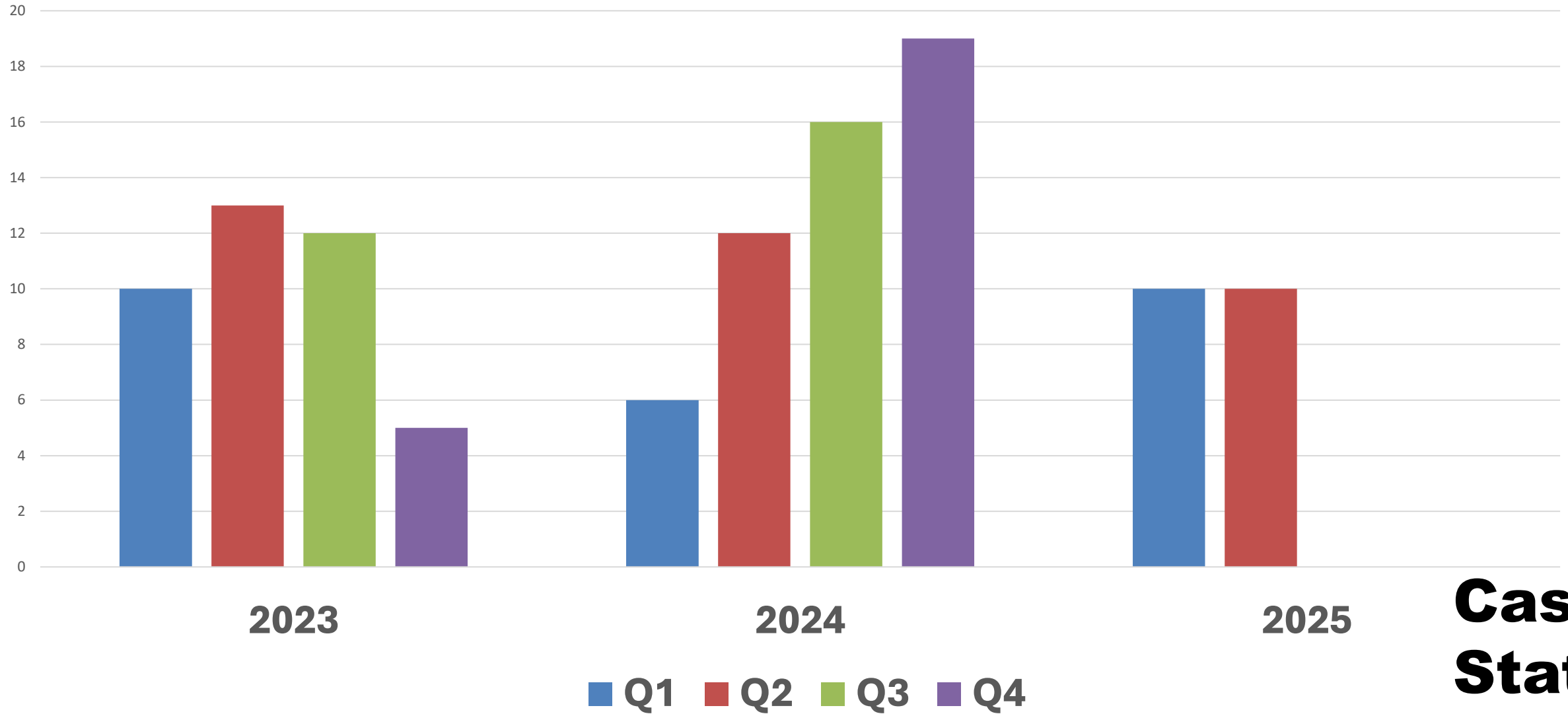

All in-custody deaths	All in-custody deaths
Recommend investigative findings only	Recommend findings & disciplinary action
No subpoena power to conduct hearings	Subpoena power
Access to information by agreement	Requires cooperation

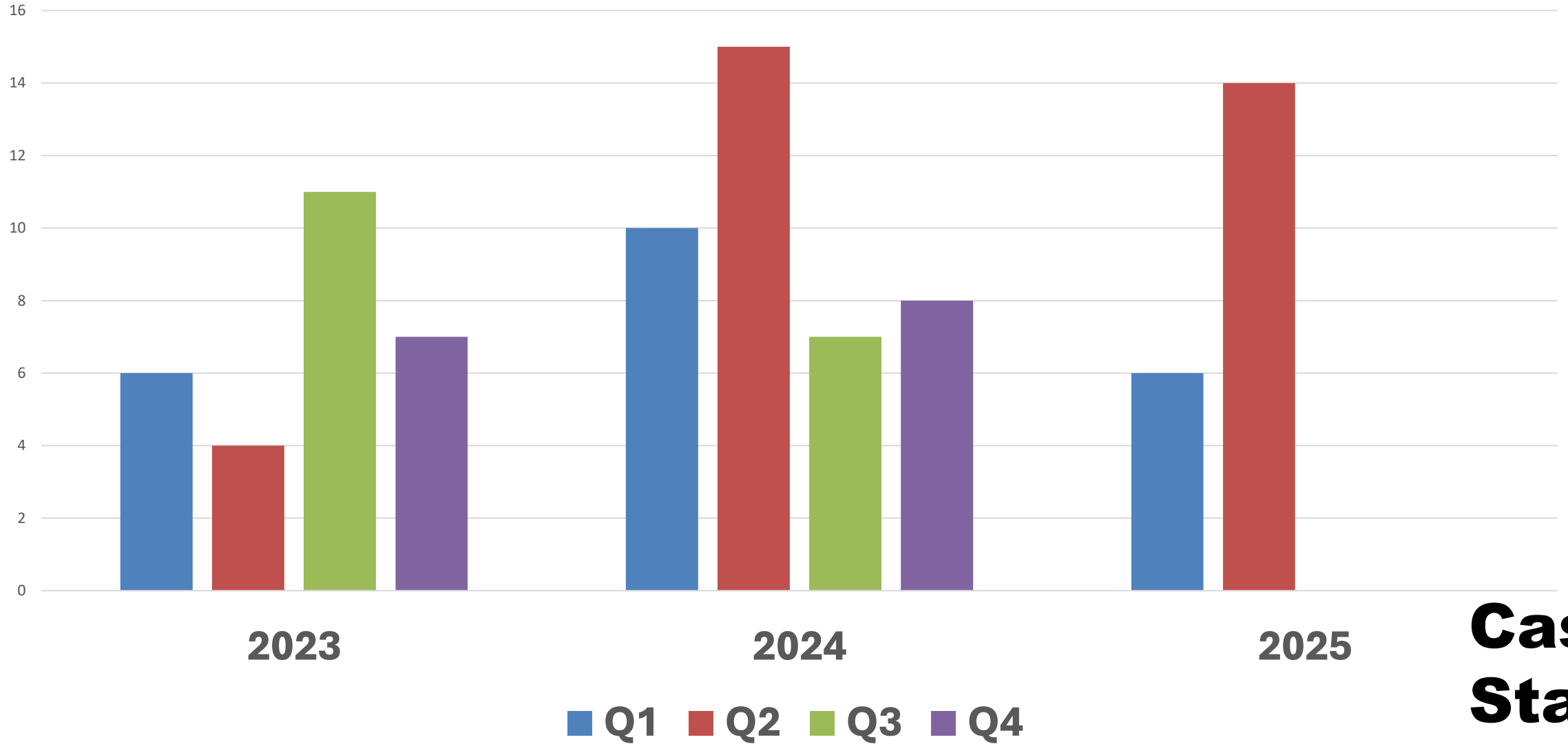
3-YEAR COMPARISON

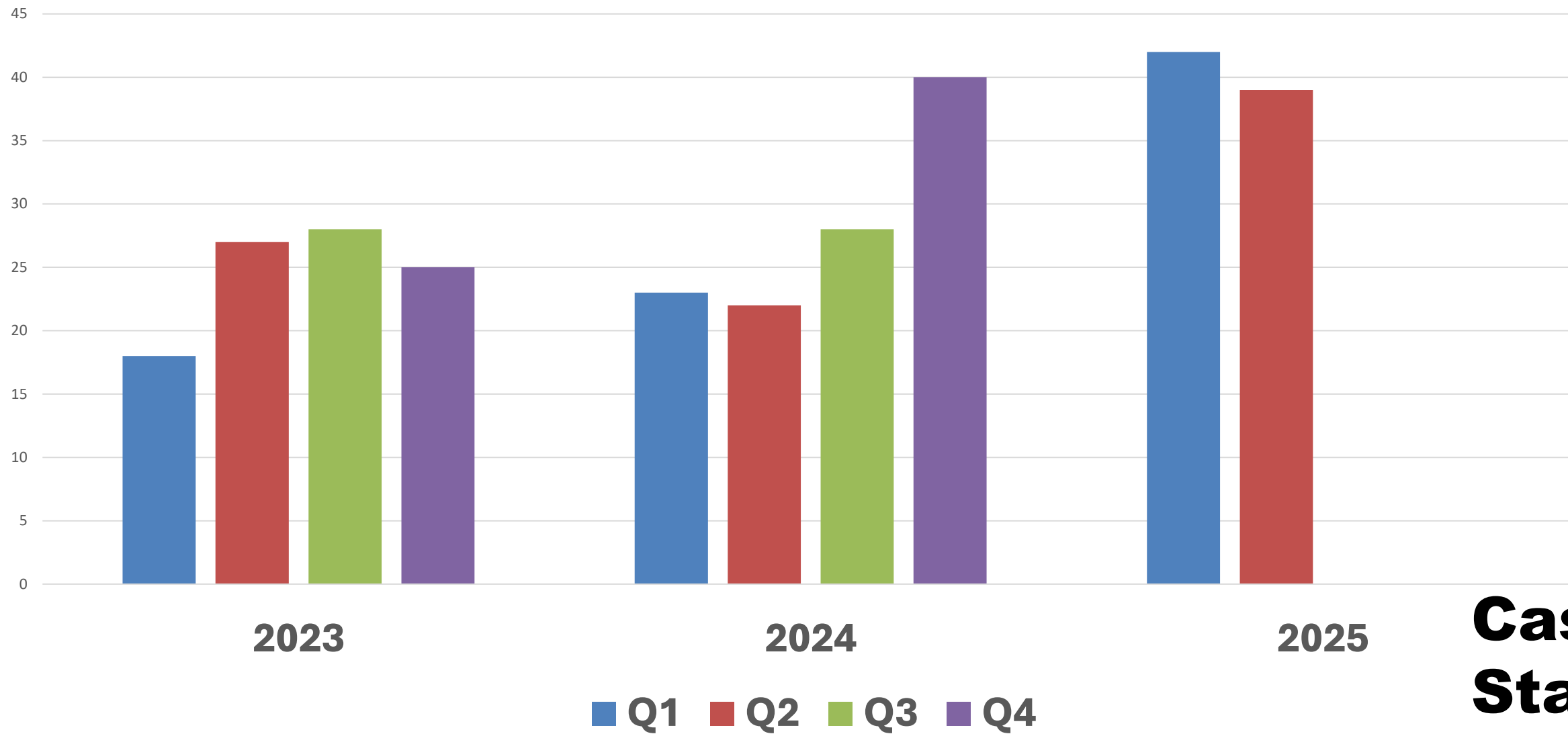

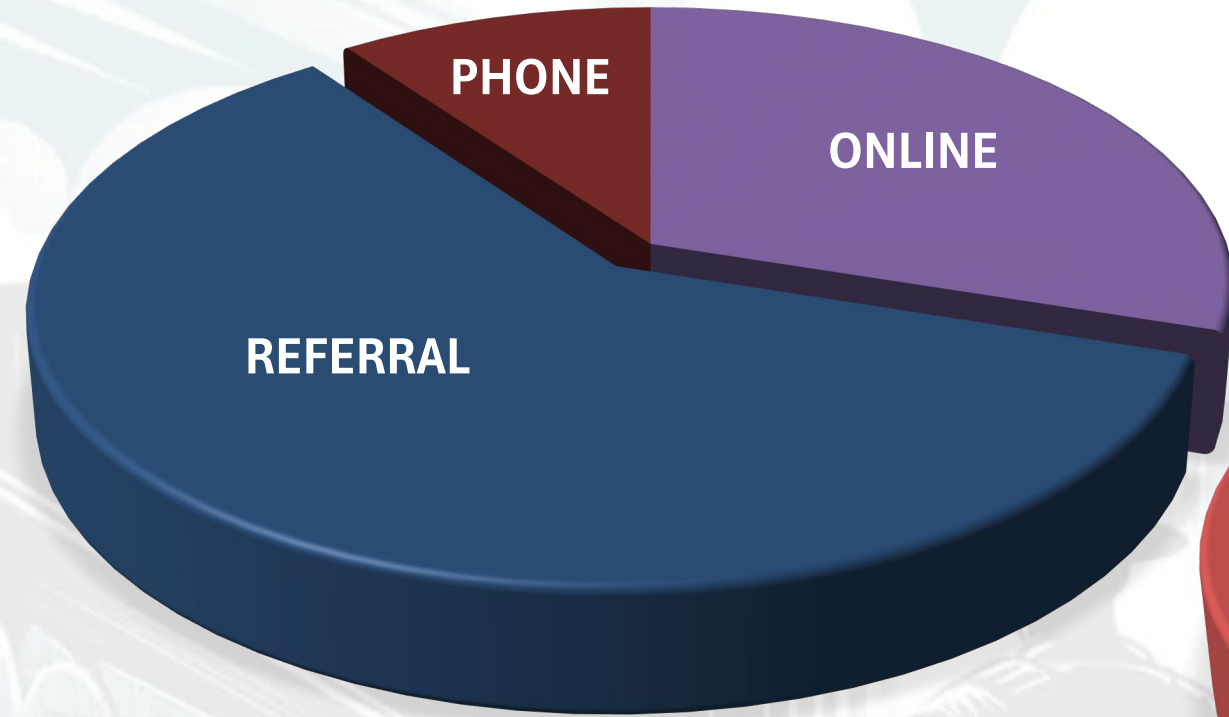

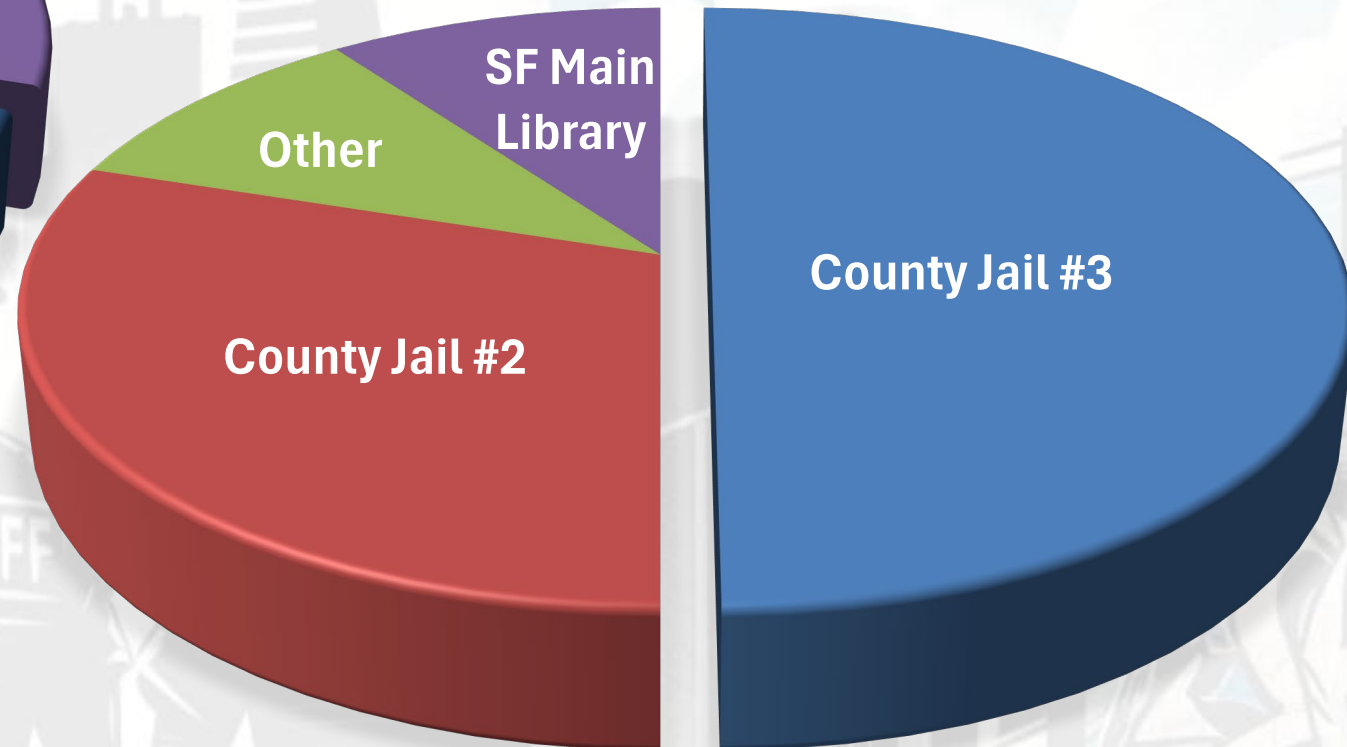

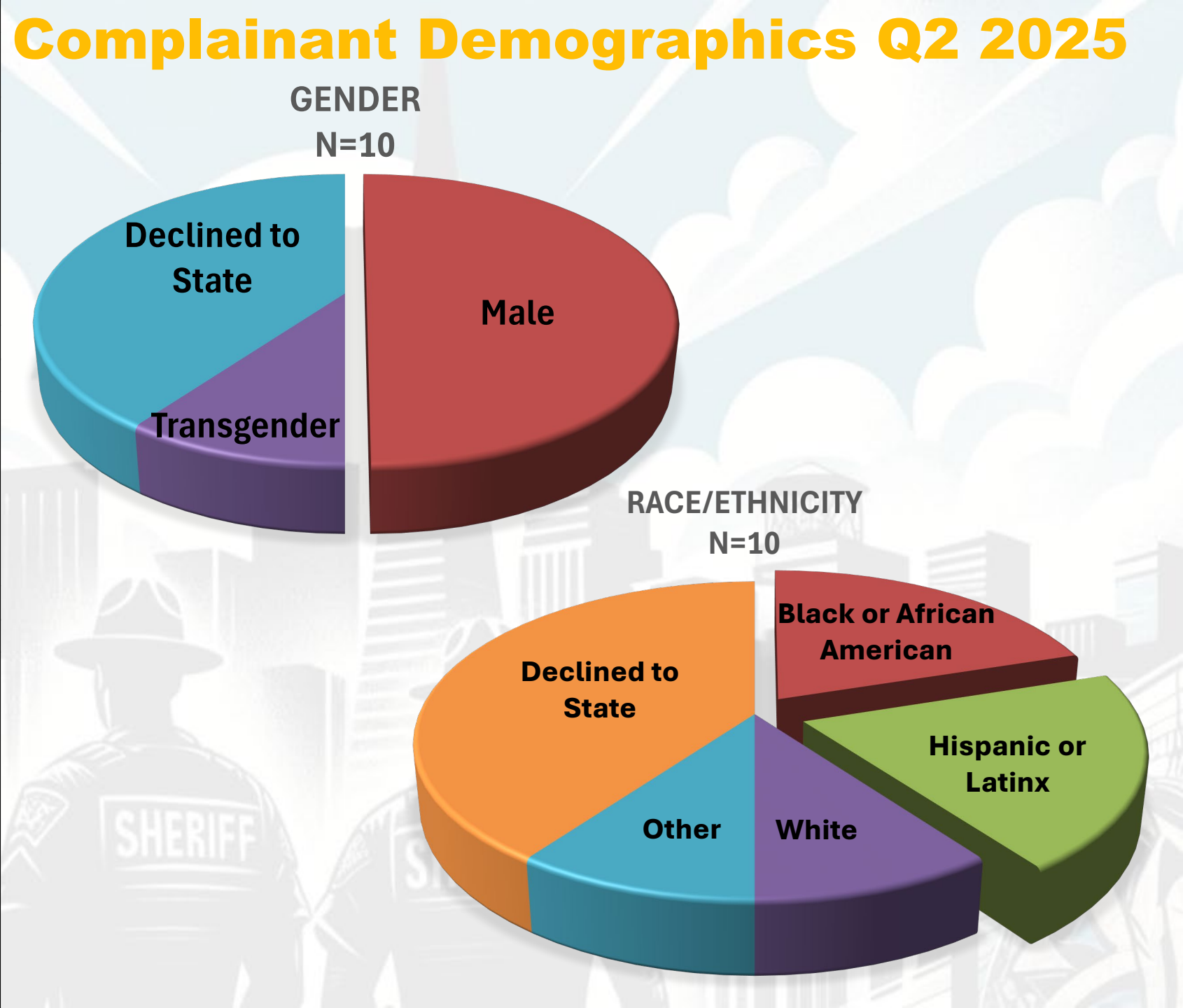

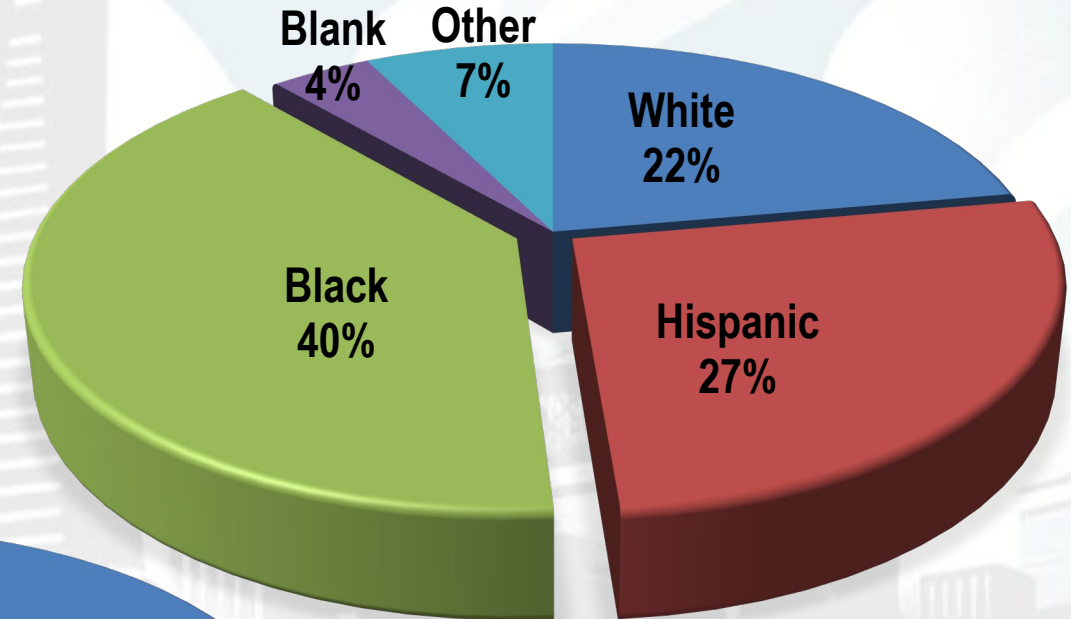
Jail Population Demographics

July 10, 2025: Jail Population (N) = 1244

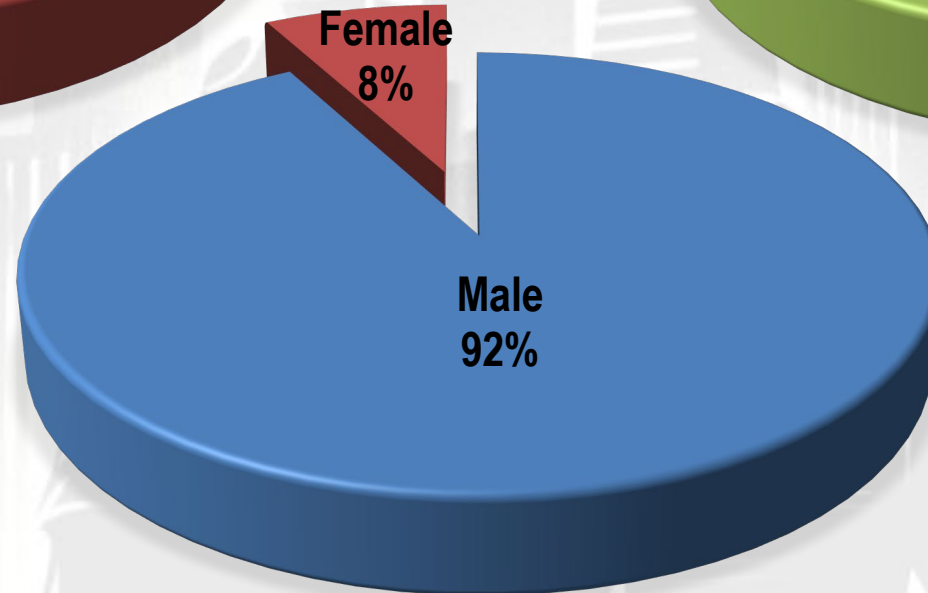
AGE GROUPS*

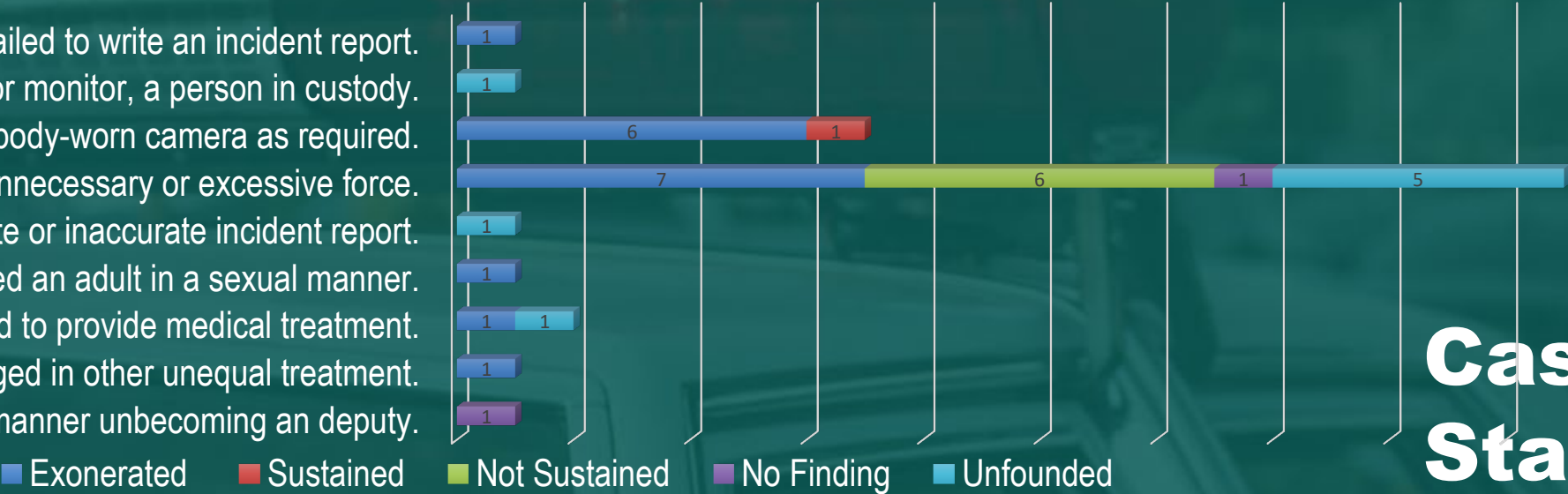

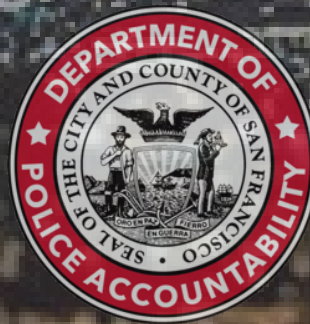
