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Summary for March 4, 2026

The Department of Police Accountability's highlight for the week:

- **DGO 5.20 Working Group** – Last week, DPA participated in the DGO 5.20: *Language Access Services for Limited English Proficient Persons* Working Group. This was the first of three scheduled sessions, and it proved to be both productive and meaningful. The working group is focused on addressing the concerns raised by the community about the policy update and ensuring that all perspectives are heard and thoughtfully considered.

Investigation Updates:

◆ **Statistics Since the Last Police Commission Meeting (February 18, 2026):**

- **Cases Opened:** 32
- **Cases Closed:** 45
- Year-to-Date Comparison:
 - Volume of incoming complaints this year is slightly lower than for the same period last year.
 - DPA is completing investigations at a similar rate to the same period last year.

Neglect of Duty	The officer failed to follow pursuit policy.	8%
