Summary for June 17, 2026

The Department of Police Accountability's highlights for the week:

- DPA presented our annual Budget to the Board of Supervisors Budget and Appropriations Committee on June 12, 2026, and is close to finalizing the FY 2026-2027 Budget.

Investigation Updates:

◆ **Statistics Since the Last Police Commission Meeting (June 10, 2026):**

- **Cases Opened:** 10
- **Cases Closed:** 26
- Year-to-Date Comparison:
 - The volume of incoming complaints continues to rise and is approximately 15% higher than for the same period last year.
 - The number of cases past 270 days is currently 7 and all are tolled.

Neglect of Duty	The officer failed to properly investigate.	36%
Neglect of Duty	The officer failed to take required action.	18%
Neglect of Duty	The officer failed to comply with Department General Order or Department Bulletin.	9%
