Department of Police Accountability

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Summary for July 15, 2026

The Department of Police Accountability's highlights for the week:

- Following last week's Commission meeting, community members who attended the meeting contacted DPA investigators to share information. Based on that information, DPA has opened an investigation into incidents related to the events at Stud Alley on June 27th.
- DPA staff and interns participated in One City Day, the City's inaugural citywide day of service, by volunteering at Larkin Street Youth Services.

Investigation Updates:

◆ **Statistics Since the Last Police Commission Meeting (July 8, 2026):**

- **Cases Opened:** 24
- **Cases Closed:** 17
- Year-to-Date Comparison:
 - The volume of incoming complaints is approximately 14% higher than for the same period last year.
 - The number of cases past 270 days is currently 7 and all but one are tolled.

Allegation Type	Allegation Summary	Percent
Neglect of Duty	The officer failed to take required action.	33%
Conduct Unbecoming	The officer improperly touched an adult in a sexual manner.	19%
Neglect of Duty	The officer failed to write an incident report.	14%
Neglect of Duty	The officer drove improperly.	14%
Conduct Unbecoming	The officer behaved or spoke inappropriately.	10%
