At the Commission's request, the Department of Police Accountability is now submitting, in writing, the statistics we previously reported on weekly during the Director's Report at Police Commission Meetings.

During the Director's Report, we will be reporting on the cases received in the past three weeks:

DPA Received 52 new cases in the past three weeks

- **12%** **The officer behaved or spoke inappropriately.**
- **11%** **The officer failed to take required action.**
- **10%** **The officer behaved or spoke in a manner unbecoming an officer.**
- **9%** **The officer used unnecessary or excessive force.**
- **8%** **The officer failed to properly investigate.**

Call for service involved assault, behavior health crisis, burglary, domestic violence, neighbor dispute, and a noise complaint.

C- Bayview	2		Officers were preventing a person from receiving medical treatment and failing to tell the reason they were arrested.
D - Mission	8		Driving recklessly, entering a hotel room inappropriately, officer loitering, and making inappropriate comments about a person's race.
E - Northern	3		Failing to investigate a vehicle theft and making inappropriate comments.
F – Park	2		Failing to write an incident report.
G - Richmond	4		Failing to investigate, failing to enforce a restraining order, and racially profiling a person.
H - Ingleside	2		Failing to take action regarding a noise complaint and issuing a falsified citation.
I – Taraval	4		Detaining a person without cause and making inappropriate comments via phone.
J - Tenderloin	4		Speaking inappropriately and hanging up on a caller. Unlawfully detaining and racially profiling a person.
Airport	2		Pulling over a person without justification and acting rudely to a person.
Not Applicable	6		Referral
Out of Town	1		Referral
Pending Further Investigation	2		Failing to arrest a person for violating a restraining order.
