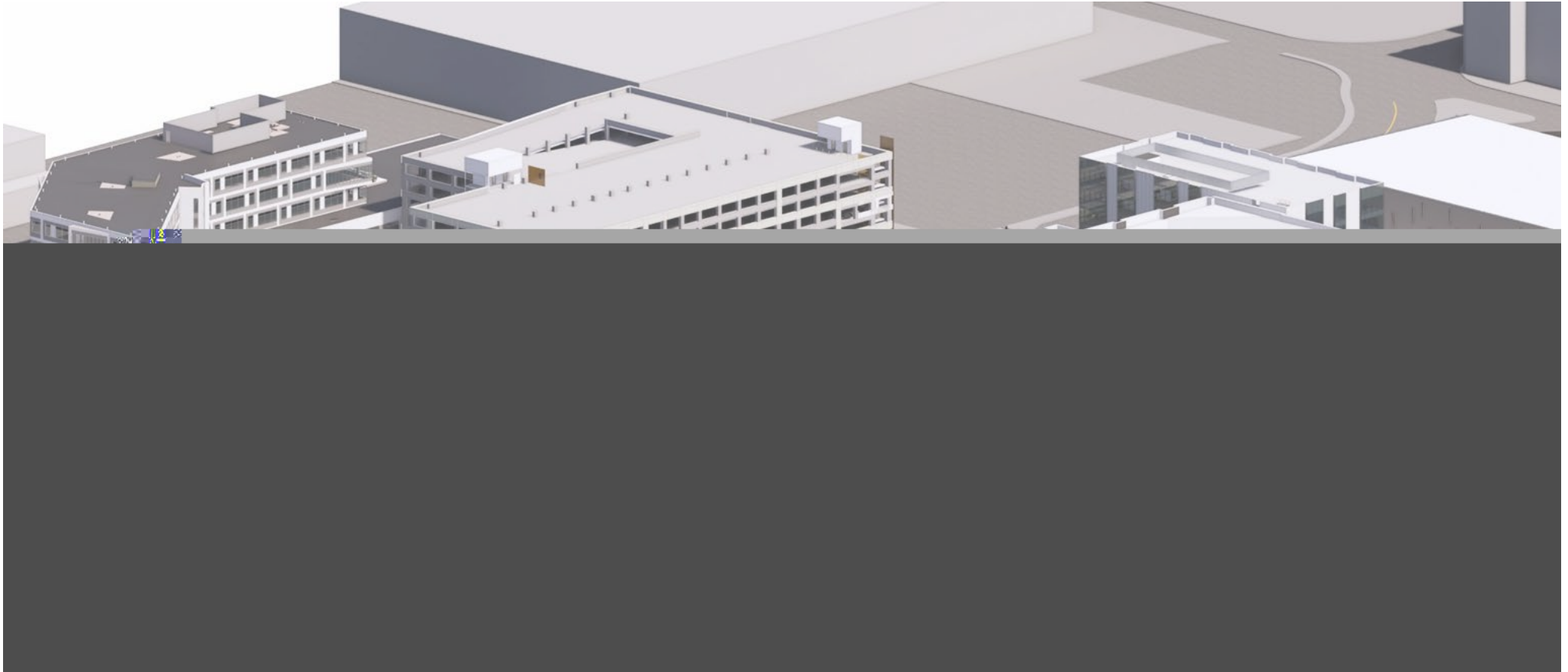

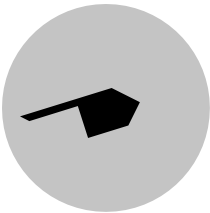
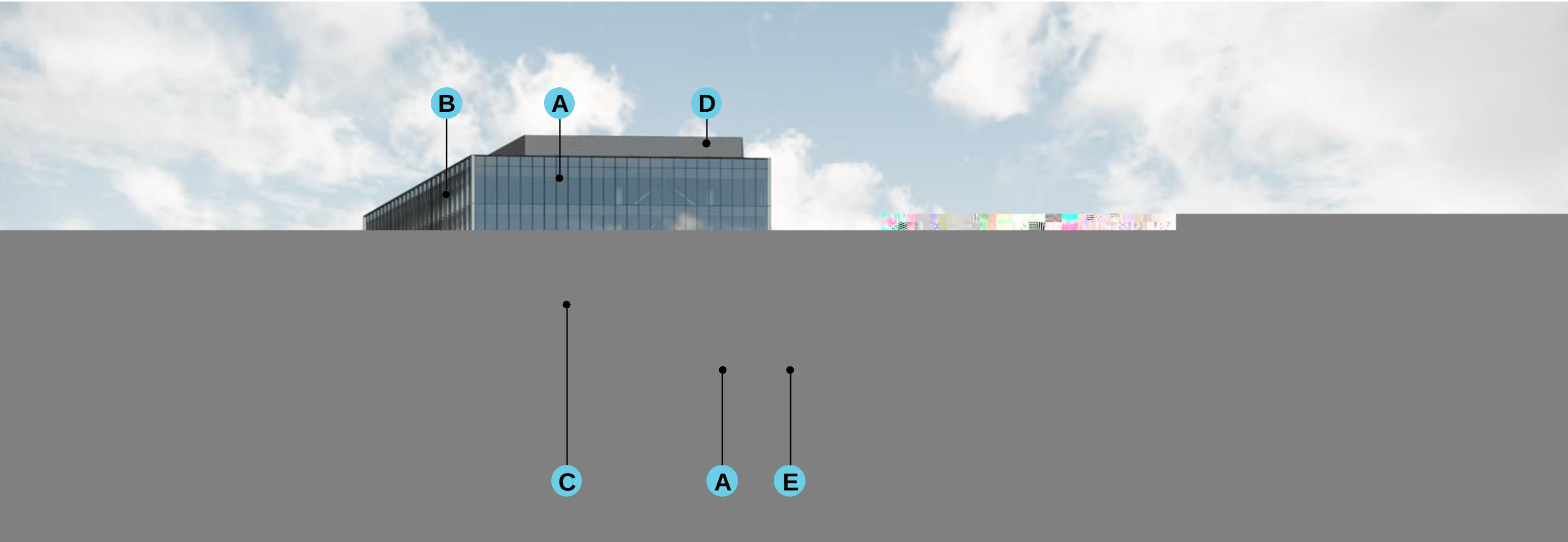
Aerial View – from Southwest





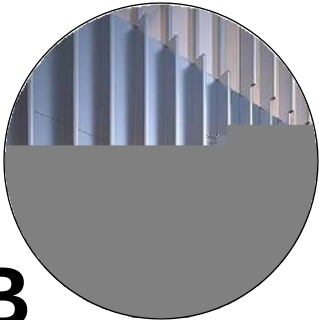

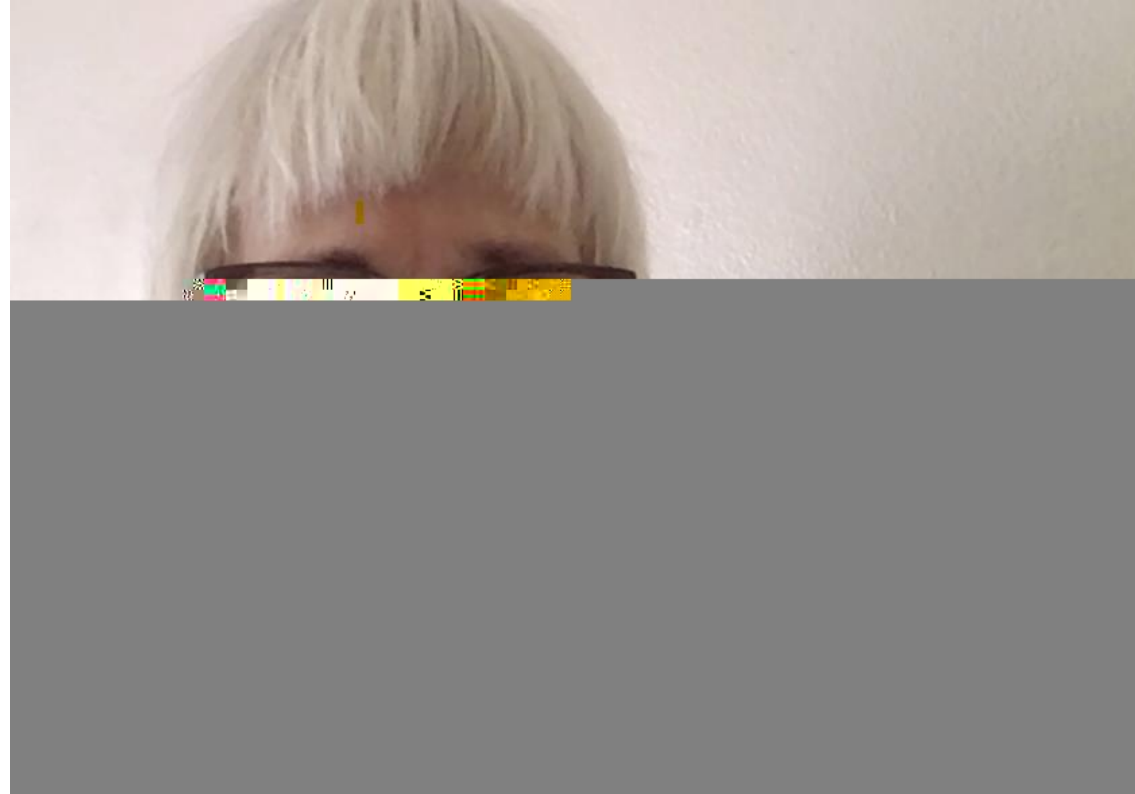
Kara Q. Smith - Writer, Curator, Educator, Community and Arts Advocate. Born July 17, 1984 ï June 17, 2025 (age 40)



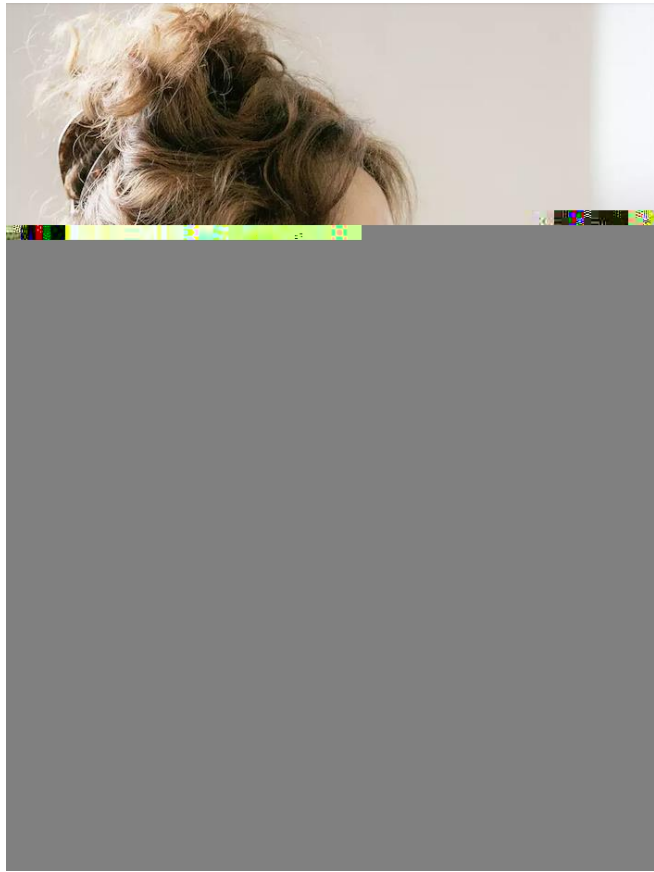
***Shakiri i Choreographer, dancer, visual artist, writer, and
