Subject: Request for Approval of Sole Source Contract – Fine Art Installation Services

I. Background

The San Francisco Arts Commission (SFAC) administers the City's Public Art Program under the authority of <u>Charter Section 5.103</u>, which grants the Commission jurisdiction over the acquisition, placement, and maintenance of works of art on City property. In fulfillment of this mandate, SFAC is overseeing the design, fabrication, and installation of public artworks for the Mission Bay School Public Art Project. To complete this project, staff is requesting approval of a Sole Source contract for the installation of a tile artwork at the site's east entrance by Certified Tile and Stone, Inc., given the specialized expertise required.

II. Sole Source Justification

Under <u>San Francisco Administrative Code Chapter 6</u>, <u>Section 6.73</u>, Sole Source contracts may be approved only in limited circumstances, such as when services are available from a single provider due to unique qualifications, proprietary rights, regulatory requirements, or when switching vendors would result in duplicative costs, delays, or loss of warranty; they may not be justified by lack of planning, convenience, or expediency. The responses to the following five questions provide justification for a sole source contract.

1. What specific work or services are required to meet the department's needs, and what is the estimated contract value?

The installation of the tile artwork is considered a "Public Work" as defined by San Francisco Administrative Code Section 6.1 (I) and therefor requires a licensed contractor with a valid appropriate licenses under California law or the applicable jurisdiction. Additionally, the Public Art Program requires specialized fine art handling and installation expertise. The estimated contract value is \$31,756.

2. What are the proposed contractor's unique qualifications to perform this work, or why does the nature of the work require Sole Source procurement?

Certified Tile and Stone, Inc. possesses specialized expertise in tile installation, including Custom & Commercial Lic. #1076945 (CA). The contractor also has proprietary knowledge of site conditions because they are subcontracting separately with SFUSD's general contractor, Swinerton/McCarthy, for the installation of architectural tile at various other locations at the project site. Pursuant to $\S6.73(c)(2)$, the services are only available from this source due to unique qualifications and technical capacity.

3. What is the anticipated cost to the City, and why is this cost in the City's best financial interest?

The anticipated cost is \$31,756. This cost is in the City's best financial interest because engaging

another vendor would likely result in risk of artwork damage and additional mobilization costs, consistent with $\S6.73(c)(3)(A)-(C)$.

Was a solicitation or advertisement issued to determine Sole Source eligibility? If not, why was issuing a solicitation impracticable, and what market research (if any) was conducted?

A competitive solicitation was not issued: It was determined impracticable because the services are reasonably available only from Certified Tile and Stone, Inc., consistent with §6.73(c)(1). Staff confirmed this through prior project experience, which demonstrated that no other vendors possess the necessary expertise to provide services within the project timeframe.

III. Commission Resolution

Motion to approve a Sole Source contract with Certified Tile and Stone, Inc. for fine art installation services for the Mission Bay School Public Art Project, pursuant to San Francisco Administrative Code Section 6.73, in an amount not to exceed \$31,756. The contractor's specialized qualifications, proprietary knowledge of the project site and artwork, and proven expertise in fine art installation make these services not reasonably available from another provider without risk of duplicative costs, delays, or potential damage to the artwork.
