Rafiki Coalition for Health and Wellness (“Rafiki”) provide a culturally affirming, trauma-informed, holistic approach to all ethnicities and populations, with a special focus on the unique cultural and linguistic needs of Black/African American (B/AA) people’s health and well-being to address and decrease health disparities that disproportionately impact this population. Utilizing a culture-specific African American relationship-focused model, Rafiki provides a community-based approach that uses culturally and spiritually affirming activities to engage and promote wellness, strengthen social support networks, reduce isolation, and address and prevent trauma. In addition, Rafiki’s approach increases health literacy, offers health and wellness screenings, provides support for service linkage(s), and increased access to culturally responsive and appropriate services.
