Purpose of Contract:

RFQ SFGOV-0000011079 included eight Fire Alarm system manufacturer categories, that represent the different Fire Alarm systems currently in use across the department. Schedules and costs for Fire Alarm testing and maintenance in each category will vary depending on the particularities of each Manufacturer's equipment.

Siemens Industry Inc. was selected under SFGOV-0000011079 and admitted to all eight Manufacturer pools. The RFQ allows for a contract initial term and amendments per City's preferences.

Siemens Industry Inc. will inspect, test, maintain, repair Fire Alarm and Fire Suppression systems across the department on a weekly, monthly, quarterly, and/or annual basis depending on the specifications of the manufactured system and the needs of the hospital or clinic location, as determined by the department. Siemens Industry Inc. must have up-to-date regulatory documentation at all times. Documentation must be provided monthly to comply with potential unannounced visits by regulatory agencies. Sabah International Inc. may be asked to provide as-needed services.

Siemens Industry, Inc. is part of the global technology company Siemens AG, founded in Berlin in 1847 by Werner von Siemens and Johann Georg Halske to manufacture pointer telegraphs. Werner von Siemens discovered the dynamo-electric principle, which revolutionized electrical engineering. It evolved from a 10-man telegraph workshop into a multinational engineering conglomerate focused on automation, digitalization, and electrification across industry, infrastructure, and transportation.

Performance Monitoring:

The contract will be monitored by the Program Manager assigned to these services and in accordance with Hospital and network monitoring procedures.
