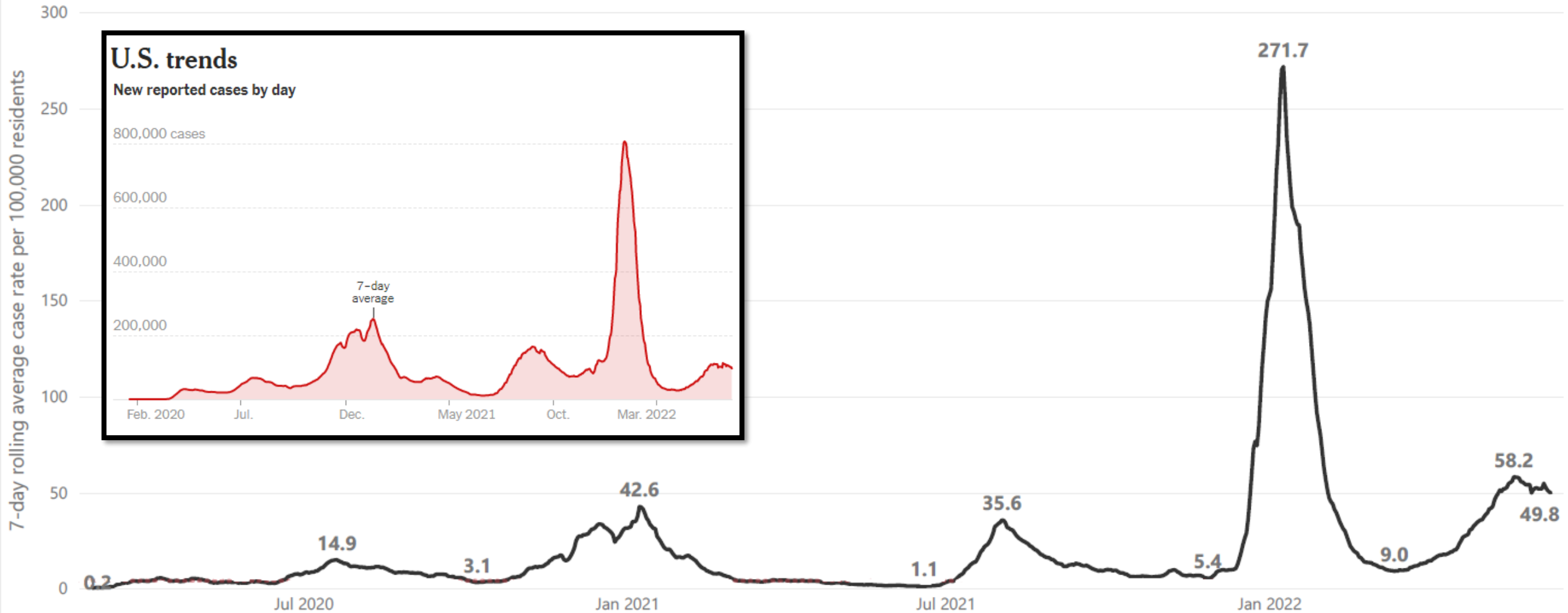

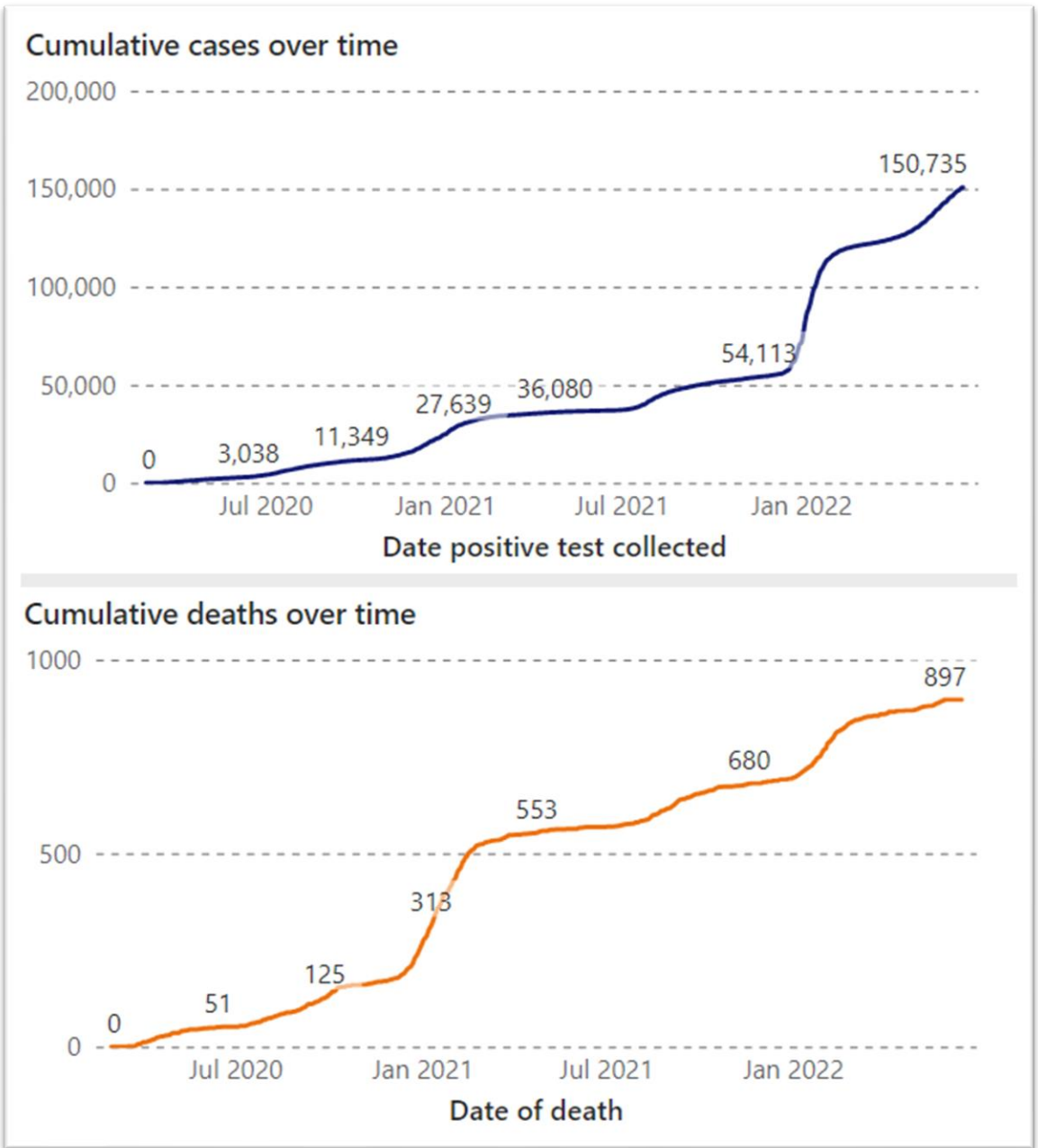
SF COVID cases per 100,000 residents

COVID+ Cases per 100,000 Population (7-day Average)

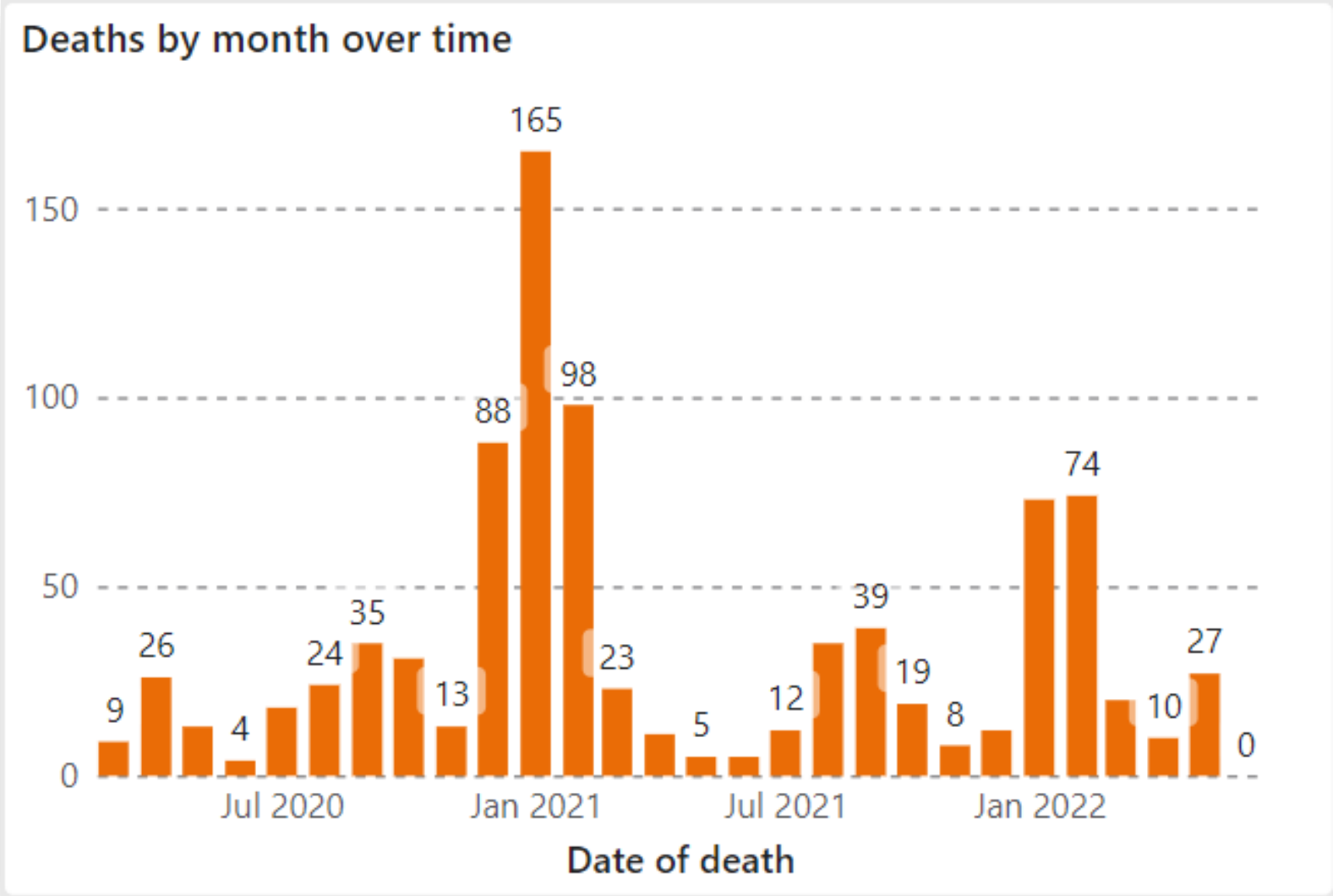

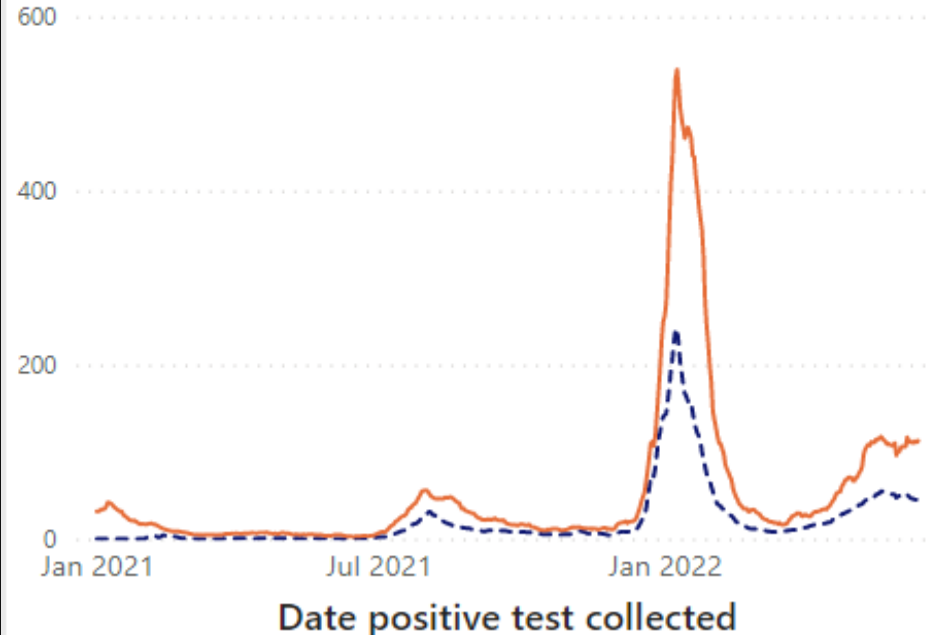

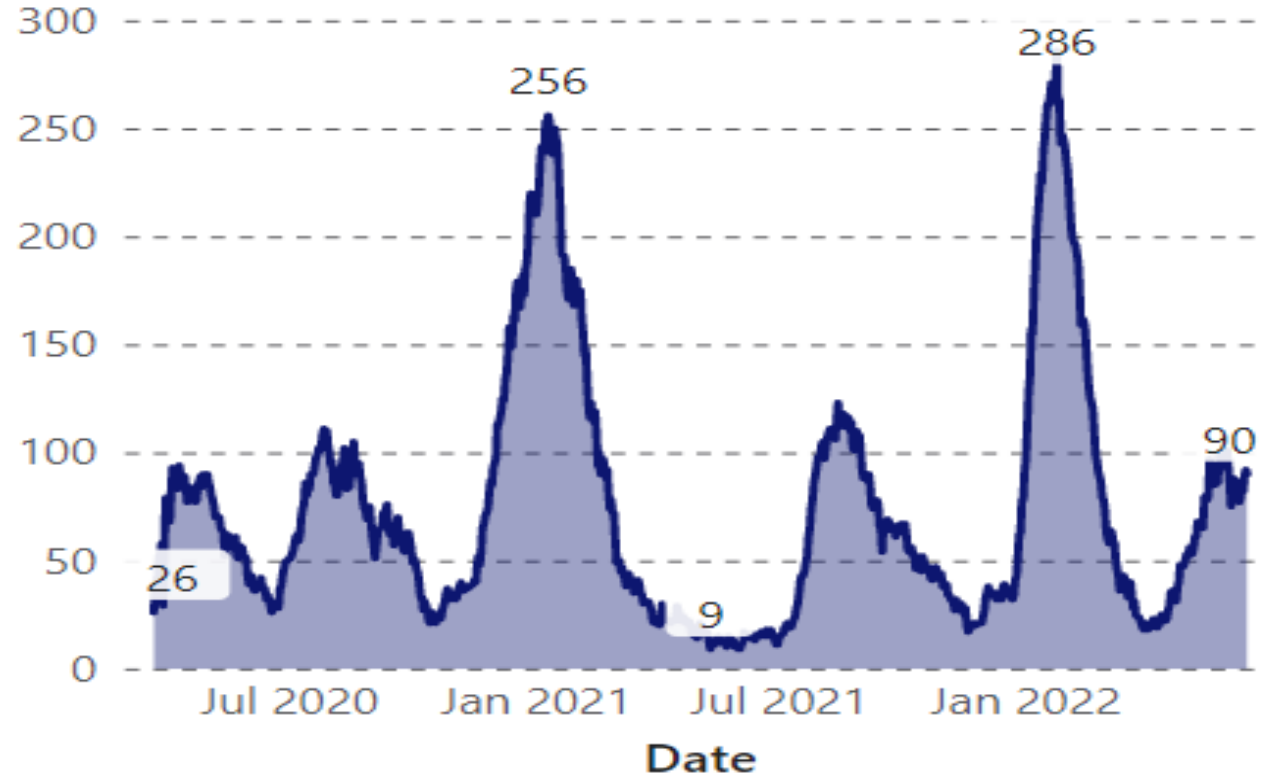




Hospitalizations

Booster Recipients by Age

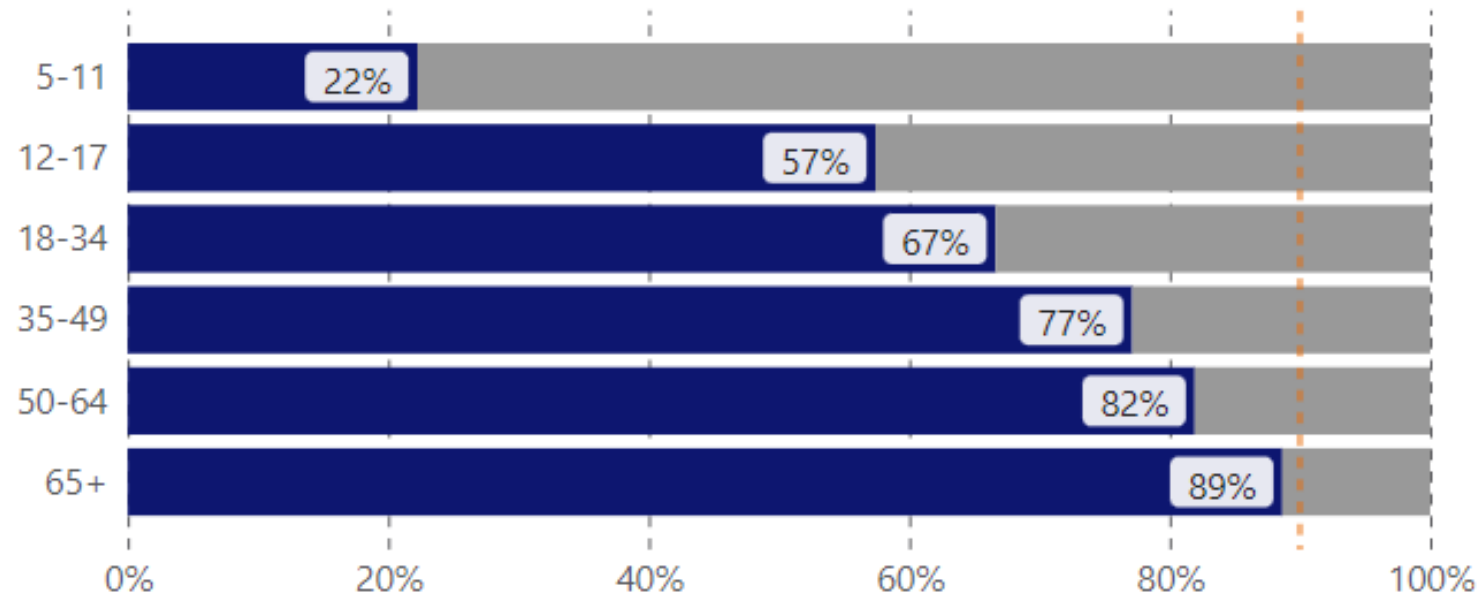
