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17	WHEREAS, Administrative Code, Chapter 22H was enacted on March 13, 2020, and
18	requires the City and County of San Francisco to designate certain City departments as
19	Health Care Components under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of
20	<u>1996 (HIPAA); and</u>
21	WHEREAS, The City performs certain functions as a health care provider and health
22	plan that make it subject to HIPAA, and also performs many functions that are unrelated to
23	healthcare and are not subject to compliance with HIPAA; and
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1	WHEREAS, This structure makes San Francisco a single legal entity that engages in
2	functions covered by HIPAA and also in non-HIPAA-covered functions, known as a Hybrid
3	Entity; and
4	WHEREAS, Section 22H.4 of the Administrative Code requires the City Administrator
5	to not less than three years after the initial report, "issue a report identifying every City
6	department and/or division thereof that would meet the definition of a Covered Entity or
7	Business Associate if it were a separate legal entityin consultation with the City Attorney;
8	based on a review of the functions performed by City departments and divisions thereof;" and
9	WHEREAS, Section 22H.4(c) states that upon issuing such report, the City
0	Administrator shall submit it to the Board of Supervisors, accompanied by a proposed
1	resolution to accept the report and to designate as Health Care Components the City
2	departments and/or divisions thereof that would meet the definition of a Covered Entity or
3	Business Associate if they were separate legal entities; and
4	WHEREAS, The last report (on file with the Clerk of the Board in File No. 210343)
5	identified the Department of Public Health, Fire Department, and Health Service System as
6	meeting the definition of a Covered Entity if they were a separate legal entity, but only to the
7	extent they perform covered functions, and the City Attorney, Treasurer-Tax Collector, and
8	Department of Technology as meeting the definition of a Business Associate if they were a
9	separate legal entity, but only to the extent they perform covered functions; and
0	WHEREAS, This report further identifies the Department of Homelessness and
1	Supportive Housing, the Controller's Office, and DataSF (a division under the Office of the
2	City Administrator) as meeting the definition of a Business Associate if they were a separate
3	legal entity; now, therefore, be it
4	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors accepts the report of the City Administrator
5	that determines the Department of Public Health, Fire Department and Health Service

1	System continue to meet the definition of a Covered Entity if they were a separate legal
2	entity, but only to the extent that they perform covered functions; and, be it
3	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors accepts the report of the City
4	Administrator that determines the City Attorney, Treasurer-Tax Collector and Department of
5	Technology, continue to meet the definition of a Business Associate if they were a separate
6	legal entity, but only to the extent that they perform covered functions; and, be it
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors accepts the report of the City
8	Administrator that determines the Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing, the
9	Controller's Office, and DataSF would meet the definition of a Business Associate if they
0	were a separate legal entity, but only to the extent that they perform covered functions; and,
1	<u>be it</u>
2	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors designates the Department of
3	Public Health, Fire Department, Health Service System, City Attorney, Treasurer-Tax
4	Collector, Department of Technology, the Department of Homelessness and Supportive
5	Housing, the Controller's Office, and DataSF as Health Care Components, but only to the
6	extent they perform covered functions; and, be it
7	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors requests that the designated
8	departments develop and implement policies and procedures relevant to their specific HIPAA
9	compliance responsibilities, subject to review by the City Attorney and approval by the City
0	Administrator. WHEREAS, The first letter of the first word of the statement following the

8	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the last "FURTHER RESOLVED" statement ends with a
9	period.
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
