



Notice of Intent to Award a Contract

May 4, 2026

To All Proposers:

The City has completed its evaluation of Sourcing Event ID 0000011435, Request for Proposals for the Code Enforcement Outreach Grant Program.

The City intends to award grants and begin contract negotiations with the following proposers:

1. Chinatown Community Development Center for the Chinatown service area.
2. Tenderloin Housing Clinic for the Tenderloin and South of Market service areas.
3. Housing Rights Committee of San Francisco for the Citywide, Mission, Bayview and Richmond service areas.

For a protest to be considered, the Contract Administrator must receive the Notice of Protest by mail or email no later than 5:00pm Pacific Time on May 7, 2026.

All protests must be in writing, dated, and must cite the law, rule, local ordinance, procedure, and/or Solicitation provision on which the protest is based. In addition, the Notice of Protest must specify facts and evidence sufficient for the City to determine the validity of the protest. Protests should be transmitted by a means that will objectively establish the date the City received the protest. Protests or notice of protests made orally (e.g., by telephone) or by fax will not be considered.
