NAHLA AWAD, Appellant(s)

DEPT. OF BUILDING INSPECTION, Respondent PLANNING DEPT. DISAPPROVAL

22 Wawona Street.

Appealing the ISSUANCE on July 3, 2025, to Nahla Awad, of a Notice of Cancellation (The Planning Department cancelled two building permits for the following reasons: (1) Failure to submit requested or required revisions, and (2) No response from applicant to email dated 3/18/25. Following are the two permits: Permit 2020/0228/5795 (vertical fourth-story No. addition and horizontal, third,-floor addition; add a window on the third floor and relocate two windows on the first floor); Permit No. 2020/0228/5793 (change of use of dwelling unit on third and fourth floors to ADU per Ordinance No. 95-17; landscaping improvements and required front setback).

PERMIT NO. 2020/02/28/5795 and 2020/02/28/5793. FOR HEARING TODAY.

ACTION: Upon motion by Commissioner Swig, the Board voted 4-0 to deny the appeal and uphold the Notice of Cancellation on the basis that it was properly issued.

50 Scenic Way.

Appealing the ISSUANCE on July 1, 2025, to Derek and Caroline Reisfield, of an Alteration Permit (correction to Notice of Violation # 202536052: scope of work at exterior deck only, includes repair select portion of existing northwest corner low wall; remove existing, nonfire rated lattice on top of exterior low wall; new rain water leader/scupper along wall near deck). PERMIT NO. 2025/05/29/7531. FOR HEARING TODAY.

ACTION: Upon motion by Commissioner Saroyan, the Board voted 4-0 to grant the appeal and issue the permit on the condition it be revised to require that Item No. 2 of Notice of Violation No.

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202536052 is addressed, more specifically repair the damaged garage level wall below the deck. This motion was made on the basis that the revision of this permit will be Code compliant and meet the full requirements of the Notice of Violation that was issued.
