(1) PUBLIC COMMENT

(5) REHEARING REQUEST FOR APPEAL NO. 25-021

Subject property at 111 Taylor Street. Chandra Laborde, Appellant, is requesting a rehearing of Appeal No. 25-021, CHANDRA LABORDE vs. ZONING ADMINISTRATOR decided July 16, 2025. At that time, upon motion by Commissioner Swig, the Board voted 4-1 (Vice President Eppler dissented) to deny the appeal and uphold the Letter of Determination on the basis that the Zoning Administrator did not err or abuse his discretion. The Board strongly encouraged the Zoning Administrator to continue the investigation of potential violations and to take enforcement action as needed. **Determination Holder:** GEO Reentry Services. **Determination Description:** The site is used for a work furlough program sponsored by Federal and State government contracts. The Zoning Administrator determined that the legal use of the property is legal, nonconforming, Group Housing. **Record No.:** 2024-010623ZAD.

ACTION: Upon motion by Vice President Eppler, the Board voted 2-3 (Commissioner Lopez, Commissioner Saroyan and Commissioner Swig dissented) to continue this matter to October 8,

2025, so that the requestor's attorney would have time to familiarize herself with the case. Lacking the three votes needed to pass the motion failed.

Upon motion by Commissioner Saroyan, the Board voted 3-2 (President Trasviña and Vice President Eppler dissented) to deny the request because the Board did not find that any of the elements of Article V, Section 9(b) of the Board Rules were met.
