## Details

### **Roca Inc.**

JPD currently contracts with Roca Inc. for technical assistance services, as outlined in Contract ID 1000035592. The Juvenile Probation Commission approved the Initial Agreement on May 14, 2025.

Roca Inc. will provide technical assistance and intensive coaching to JPD staff to implement the RISE in-custody behavioral development model and extend it into reentry services for youth exiting the Secure Youth Treatment Facility. They will also support JPD in integrating Rewire CBT practices into policies and procedures through ongoing coaching, preparation, and follow-up.

This Amendment 1 extends the current 10-month contract term by 6 months for a revised contract term of 16-months.
