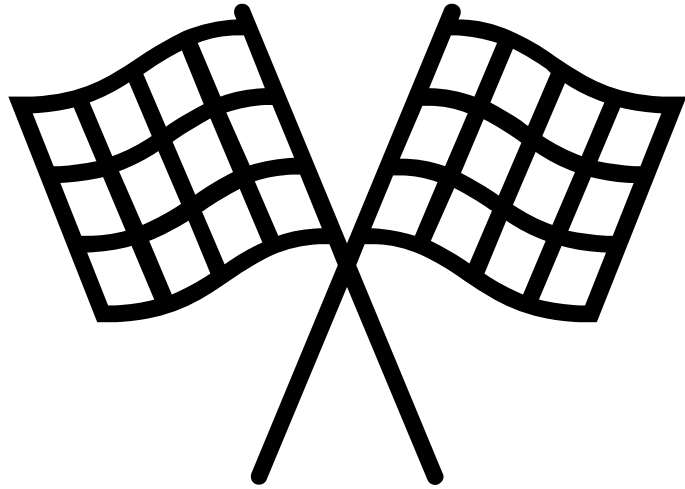

# DJJ Realignment Subcommittee 9/30/25

## Transformation

- **San Francisco DJJ Realignment Population**

- Probation Caseload: 74 youth have prior sustained 707(b) petitions (27.5% of probation caseload, excluding AB12)
- Secure Youth Treatment Facility (SYTF) Commitments: 17 young people have been committed to San Francisco's SYTF since 2021. 10 young people currently in SYTF
- Juvenile Hall Commitments w/ 707(b) Offenses: 5 young people have been committed to San Francisco Juvenile Hall w/ 707(b) offenses since 2021.

- **Focus on Girls**

- 16% of girls on JPD's caseload have a prior sustained 707(b) offense
- To date, no girls have been ordered to Secure Youth Treatment Facility commitment or Juvenile Hall commitment for a 707(b) offense
- Presentations by San Luis Obispo Coastal Valley Academy and Beloved Village.



# Career Technical Education Transformation

- First cohort of Career Technical Education (CTE) training in Secure Youth Treatment Facility (SYTF) launched in August.
- Partnership with **San Francisco County Office of Education**.
- Certified instructors in Urban Agriculture teach two mornings per week, for 8 weeks.
- Youth earn certifications and work experience that prepares them for working upon release.

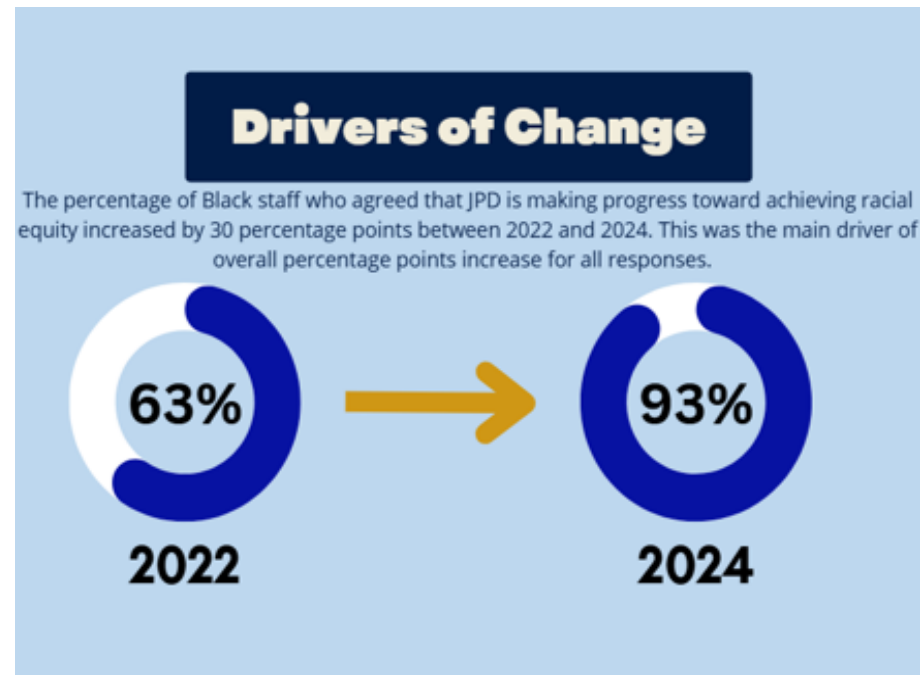




# Racial Equity Survey 2025
