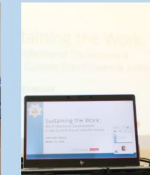

Transformation Updates

- **SFGov TV** JPD Evidence Based Practices Initiative
- **OJJDP Grant Proposal Reentry Services Support Initiative (RSSI)** (\$750,000 over three years):
 - Combat violent crime and improve youth outcomes and public safety by reducing recidivism among youth following their release from SYTF.
 - In collaboration with community based providers, provide intensive reentry coordination services; case management navigation and support; pre- and post-release needs assessments and reentry plans; evidence-based, positive youth development services and strategies; and a network of supportive services, resources, and programs.

Budget Updates

- JPD Leadership & Finance Team in ongoing conversations with the Mayor's Budget Office (MBO), Committee on Information Technology (COIT) and Capital Planning Committee (CPC).
- MBO is currently focused on personnel; will focus on programmatic costs next.
- Announced layoffs do not include JPD staff at this time.
