## **Logging into Avatar via NIAM - Reference Sheet**

NIAM (Netsmart Identity and Access Management) is a two-factor authentication system for logging into Avatar.


Beginning on August 4, 2025, most users will be able to log into Avatar, from any browser, using the following URL:


Additionally, instead of entering their Avatar System Code, Username, and Password, users will enter using their remote access username and password (i.e., the one used to access the SFDPH network, where the username is typically the first and last name, separated by a space).

Click on *Login with Enterprise Credentials* to log into your Avatar account via NIAM.

(Only certain users will continue to log in using their previous (i.e., local) credentials.)



This dialog below is accessible by clicking on the *Login with Local Credentials* link on the dialog displayed on the left. Only certain users who are not NIAM-enabled should continue to use this dialog.



## **Step-by-Step Instructions**

**NOTE**: The steps outlined below assume you have the Duo Mobile app installed on your phone and configured to access the SFDPH network. If you need assistance with a first-time login, contact the Avatar Help Desk at 628-217-5196.



- 1. Use any browser (e.g., Chrome, Edge, Firefox, Safari) to access https://sfdphnx.netsmartcloud.com
- 2. Click on Login with Enterprise Credentials
- 3. Enter your remote access username (typically your first and last name, separated by a space)
- 4. Enter your remote access password
- 5. Authenticate in Duo and, if prompted, acknowledge your device

**NOTE**: If you authenticated in Duo recently, you may not be prompted to do so again

6. If you have more than one system code assigned, you will need to select one
