
Re: San Francisco Department of Police Accountability March 2025 Monthly Statistical Report

Dear President Cindy Elias and San Francisco Police Commissioners:

Summary of Complaints Received in March 2025

The Department of Police Accountability received a total of 61 cases in March 2025, 57 SFPD complaints and 4 SFSO complaints. Compared with a total of 59 cases, 57 SFPD complaints and 2 SFSO complaint, in the same period last year, the March 2025 case total is 3% lower than the five-year average and is 3% higher than the previous year.


From January through March, the DPA received a total of **232** new cases, **223** SFPD complaints and **9** SFSO complaints. Compared with the **171** cases filed during



the same period in 2024, **164** SFPD complaints and **7** SFSO complaint. The March year to date case total represents an **36%** increase in new complaints over last year.

Currently, DPA has a total of 270 pending cases, 228 SFPD and 42 SFSO.

In March, DPA <u>received</u> a total of **0** referral(s) from SF Sheriff's Office and <u>referred</u> a total of **1** case(s) to SFSO.


