

Summary of Complaints Received in May 2025


The Department of Police Accountability received a total of 74 cases in May 2025, 71 SFPD complaints and 3 SFSO complaints. Compared with a total of 74 cases, 68 SFPD complaints and **6** SFSO complaint, in the same period last year, the May 2025 case total is 14% higher than the five-year average and is the same as the previous year.

From January through May, the DPA received a total of 382 new cases, 364 SFPD complaints and 18 SFSO complaints. Compared with the 324 cases filed during the same period in 2024, 308 SFPD complaints and 16 SFSO complaint. The April year to date case total represents an 18% increase in new complaints over last year.



Currently, DPA has a total of **282** pending cases, **237** SFPD and **45** SFSO.


In May, DPA received a total of **0** referral(s) from SF Sheriff's Office and referred a total of **4** case(s) to SFSO.
