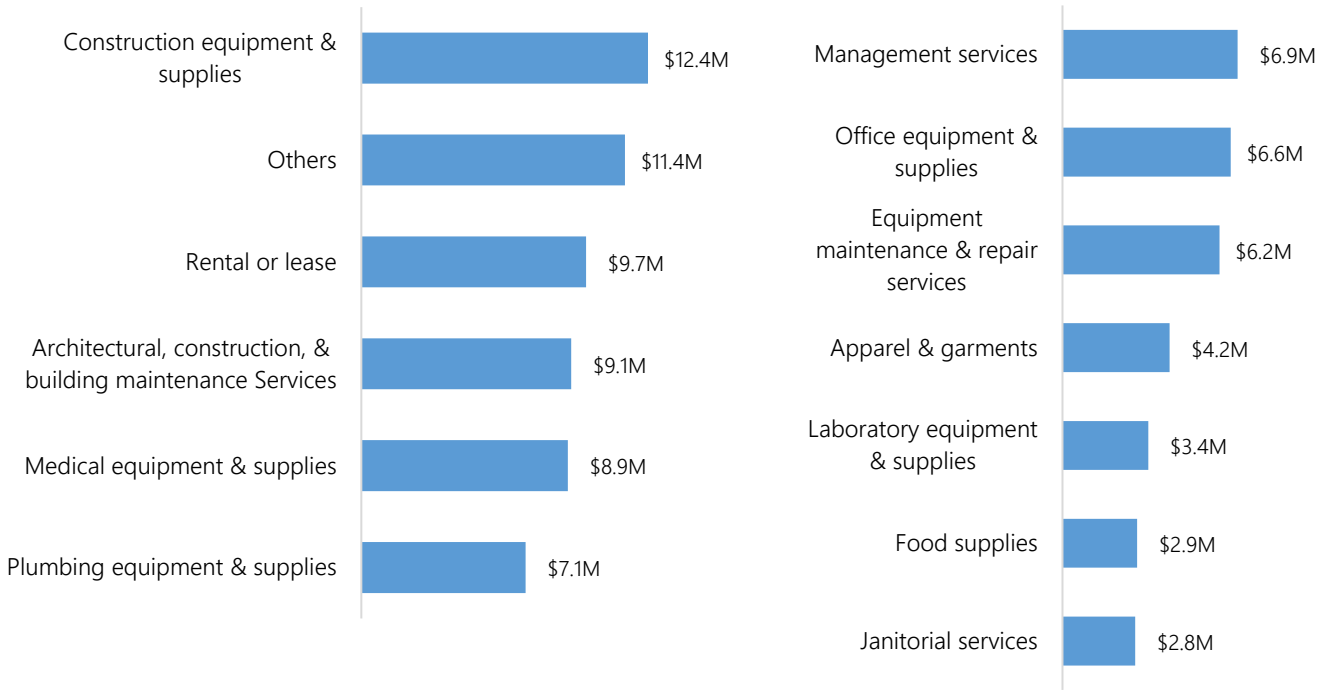

The City's Office of Contract Administration (OCA) is responsible for procuring the goods and services that our departments need for their day-to-day operations. To fulfill this role, OCA procures long-term contracts for a wide variety of commonly-needed goods and services and conducts procurements for one-time purchases. OCA holds over 609 Term Contracts with a cumulative value of \$2.86B. In the past Fiscal Year, OCA issued over 1,953 purchase orders for one-time purchases.
