
2012 Bond

- **89%** of initial bond issuances spent or encumbered.
- 76 projects are complete.

2008 Bond

- All 75 projects complete.
- 100% of all bond and interest spent.

2012 Bond – Funding Status




*11% balance has been allocated to respective 2012 Bond Programs to be encumbered.


