

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR FLOOR PLAN

### For Commercial Projects – Exception to Architectural Plan Requirements



### Ensure floor plan meets these requirements

- The floor plan must be <u>dimensioned</u> and <u>drawn proportionately</u> of the space the business plans to occupy.
- The dimensions shall be sufficient to calculate the gross floor area or net floor area.
- o A straightedge must be used, if produced by hand.
- The floor plan shall <u>identify all the uses/activities</u> within the business, location and width of exits, location of fixed (counters, booths, stations...) and movable (tables, chairs, shelving...) furniture and equipment.
- The floor plan shall identify the <u>number of occupants that will be in each</u> space.

#### Sign off on the floor plan

Sign the affidavit in the "Project Description" box

#### Print floor plans

 Two sets of floor plans are required for submittal to the Department of Building Inspection, printed on 11"x17" size paper.

## Include photographs of the space(s) that the business will occupy

- Photos must <u>show each space</u> to be occupied by the business (e.g., kitchen, bar, restroom, retail space, etc.)
- o Each space must be shown from at least two different angles
- o Photos should show <u>full current state</u> of each space to be occupied
- Ways to include the photographs:
  - Create a digital photo collection with each space labeled and print two color copies on 11"x17" paper to be included with the floor plan, OR
  - Arrange printed photos together and make two color copies on 11"x17" paper with spaces labeled to be included with the floor plan
