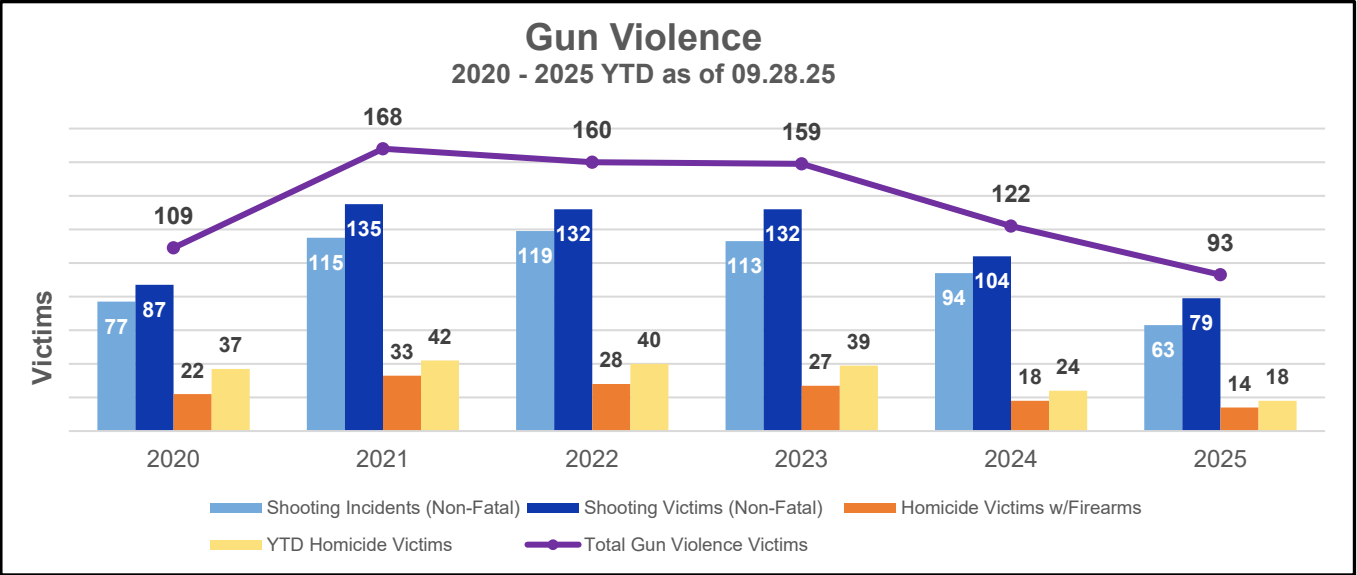
GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE

GUN VIOLENCE: Total gun violence is DOWN 24% compared to 2024

- There was 1 non-fatal shooting incident causing injuries to 1 victim the week ending 09.28.25
 - For the year, there are a total of 74 firearm-related incidents resulting in 93 victims

TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are DOWN 25% compared to 2024

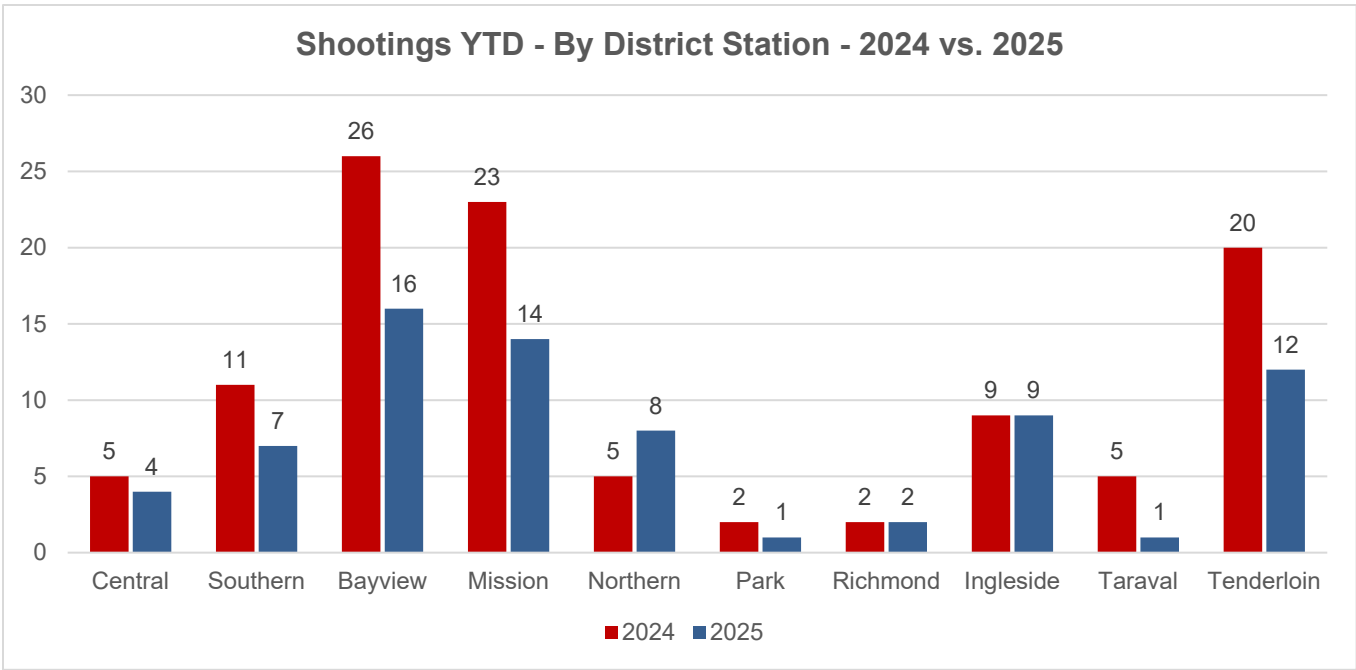
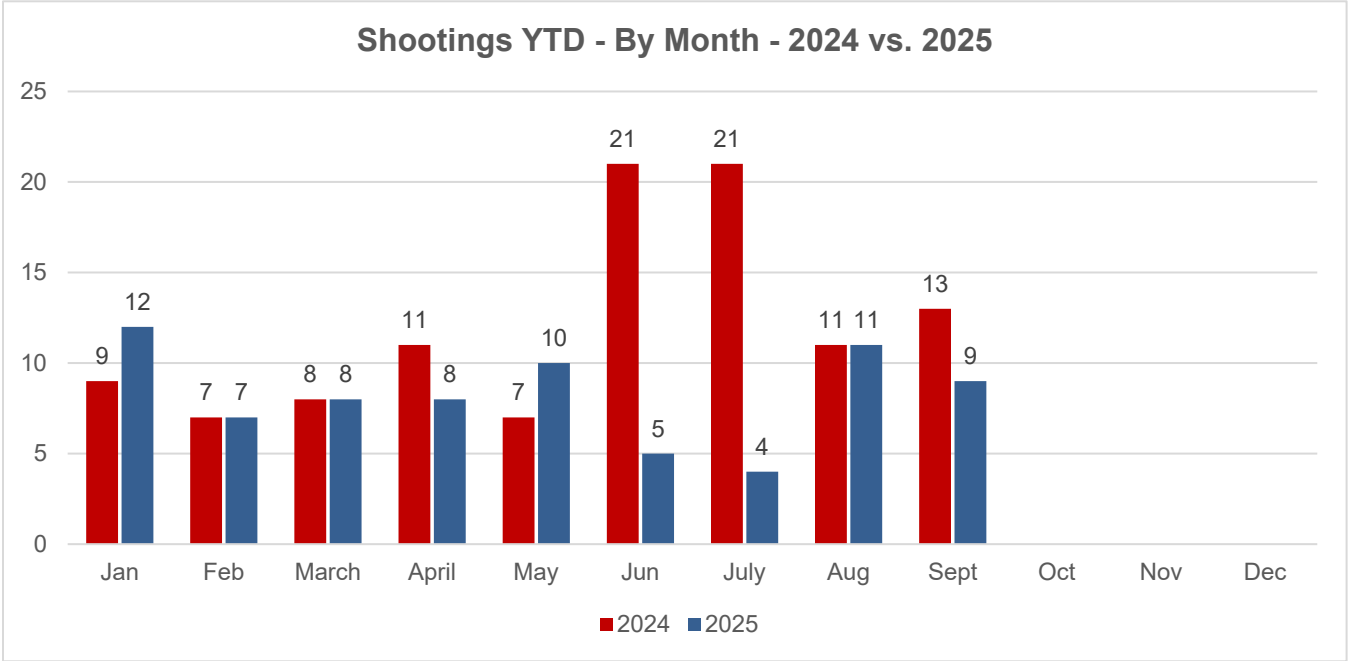
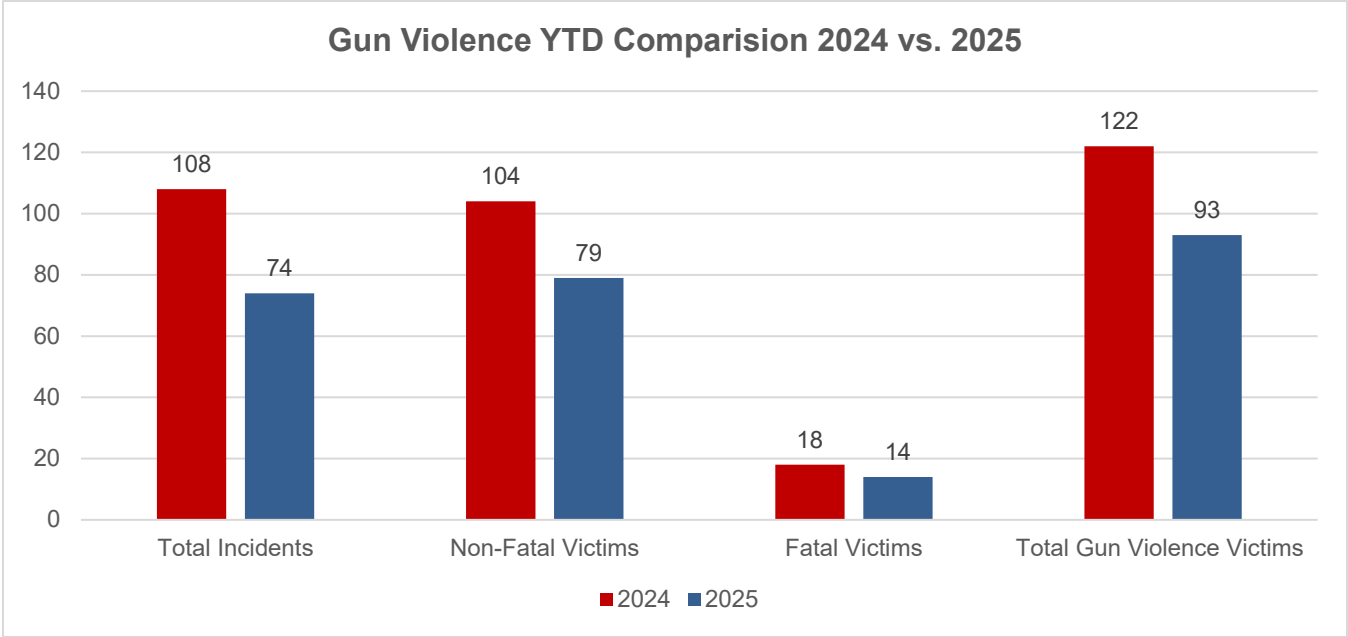
- There were no homicide incidents occurring the week ending 09.28.2025

 - There are 3 homicides in September 2025
 - Overall Clearance Rate: 139% for 2025



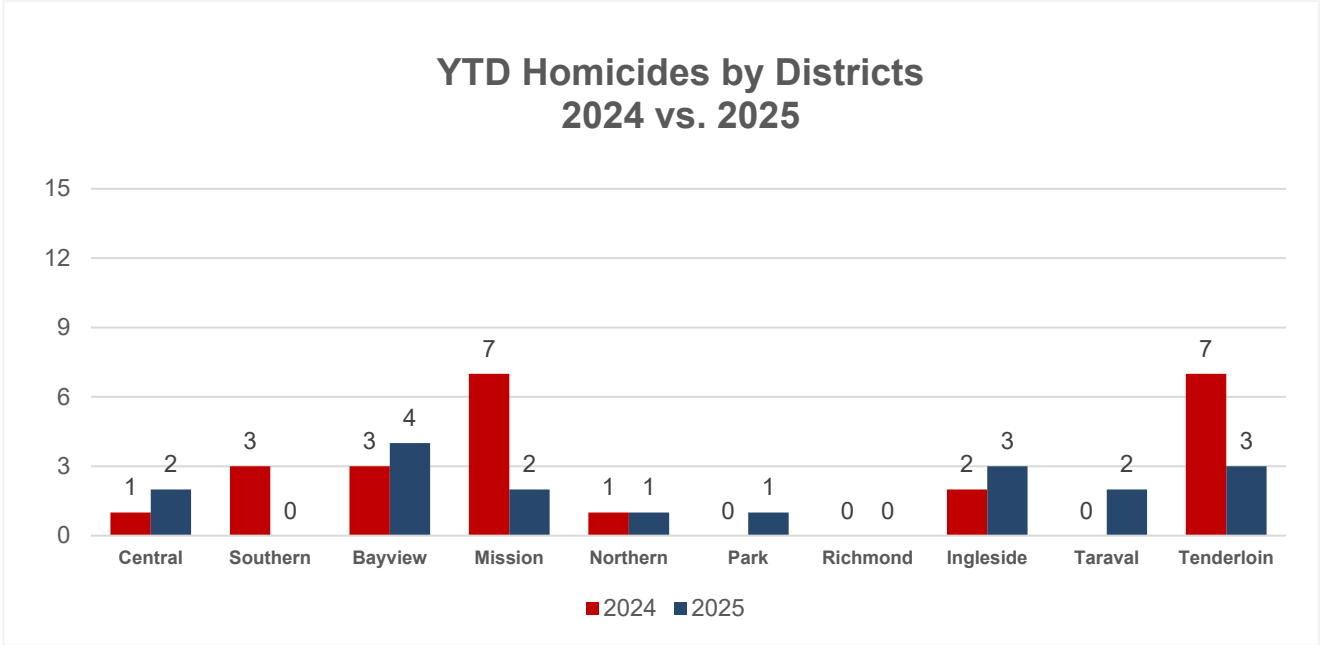
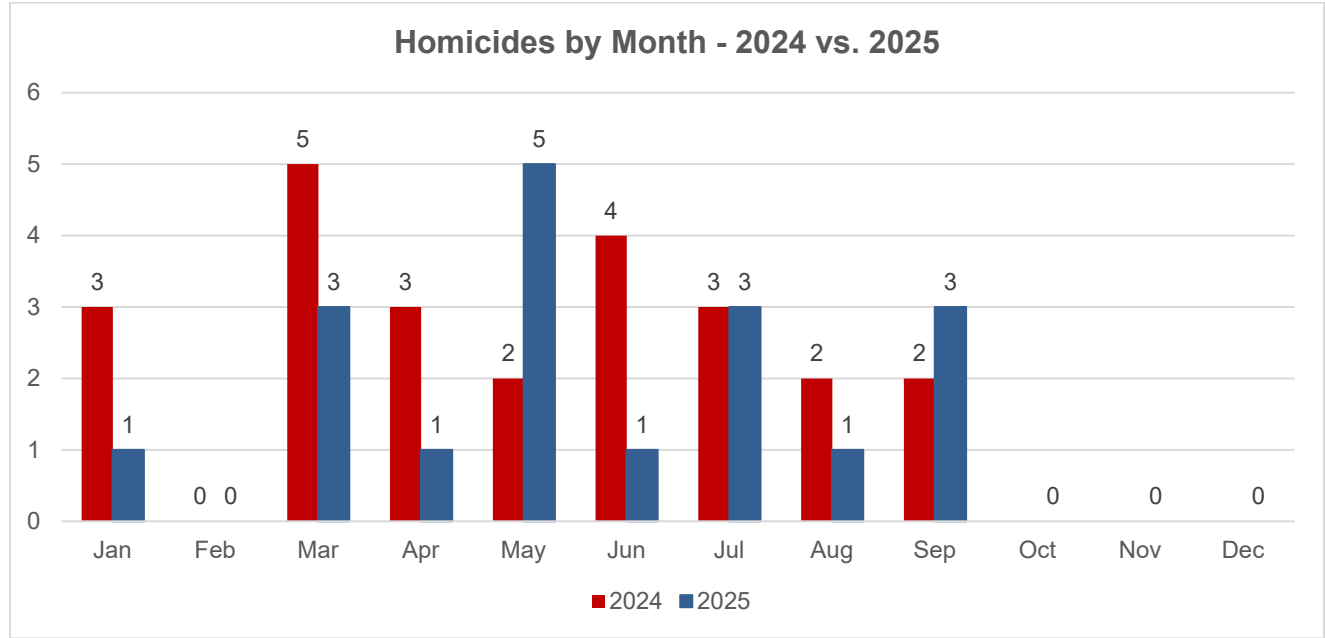
