

**GUN VIOLENCE – DOWN 3% compared to 2022**

- There were 3 shooting incidents causing injuries to 5 victims this week.
  - For the year, there are a total of 142 incidents resulting in 167 victims
- There were no homicide incidents for the week ending 10.15.23
  - There are 43 homicides YTD with 28 incidents resulting from a firearm.
  - Overall Clearance Rate: 72%






### Gun Violence YTD Comparision 2022 vs. 2023



### Shootings YTD - By District Station - 2022 vs. 2023




### Shootings by Month - 2022 vs. 2023


