
## **GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE**

#### **GUN VIOLENCE: Total gun violence is DOWN 20% compared to 2024**

- There were 5 non-fatal shooting incidents causing injuries to 5 victims the week ending 10.05.25
  - o For the year, there are a total of 79 firearm-related incidents resulting in 98 victims

#### **TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are DOWN 21% compared to 2024**


- There was 1 homicide incident reported the week ending 10.5.2025
  - o There are 19 homicides YTD with 15 incidents resulting from a firearm.
  - There are no homicides in October 2025
  - Overall Clearance Rate: 139% for 2025





