## Summary for Oct 8, 2025

The Department of Police Accountability's highlight for the week:

- **DPA Fall Intern Onboarding**
  - DPA is currently onboarding four interns for our Fall term. They will be joining us from S.F. State, U.C. Berkeley and Stanford.
- **Report Reenvisioning Project Update**
  - DPA is finishing up our Commissioner input survey and hope to have it out ahead of schedule in early November.
- **Audit Update**
  - The Use of Force draft report has been sent to the Controller's Officer and is undergoing independent review.

## Investigation Updates:

- ◆ **Statistics Since the Last Police Commission Meeting (October 1, 2025):**
  - **Cases Opened:** 12
  - **Cases Closed:** 9
  - Year-to-Date Comparison:
    - **Case openings have increased by 27%** (152 cases) compared to the same period in 2024.
    - **The number of pending cases is currently 10% higher** (an increase of 21 cases) than at this time last year.
