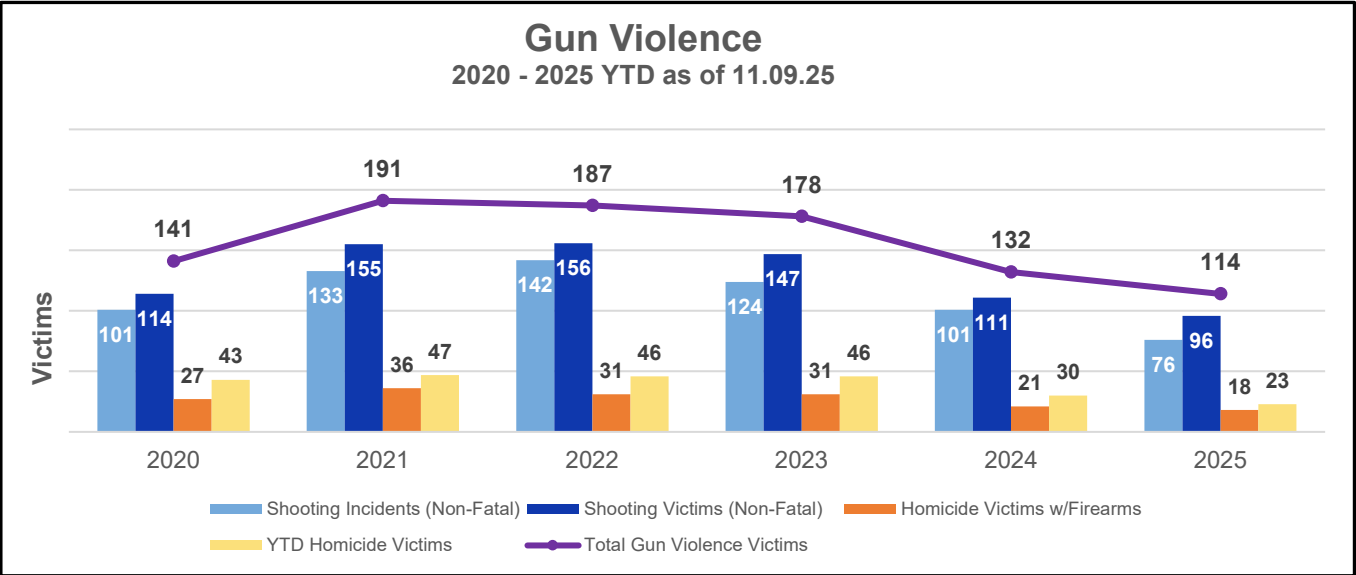
GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE

GUN VIOLENCE: Total gun violence is DOWN 14% compared to 2024

- There were 3 shooting incidents causing injuries to 7 victims, one self-inflicted fatal, the week ending 11.09.25
 - For the year, there are a total of 89 firearm-related incidents resulting in 114 victims

TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are DOWN 23% compared to 2024

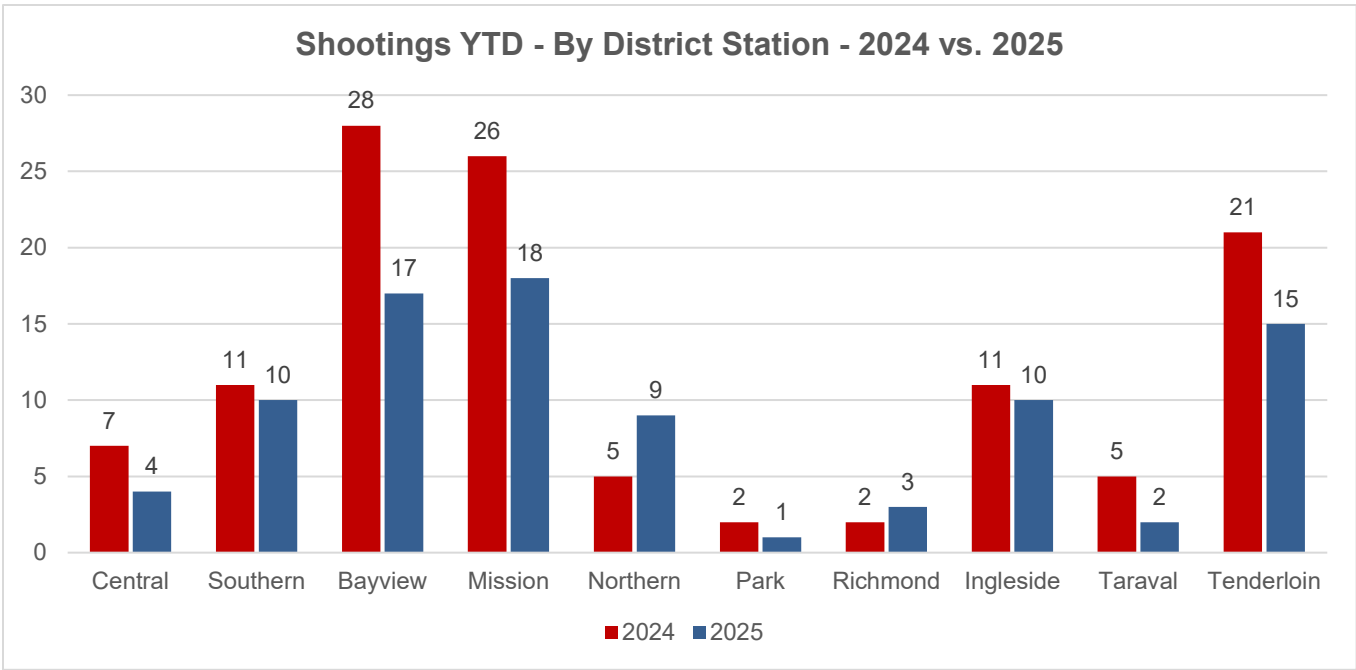
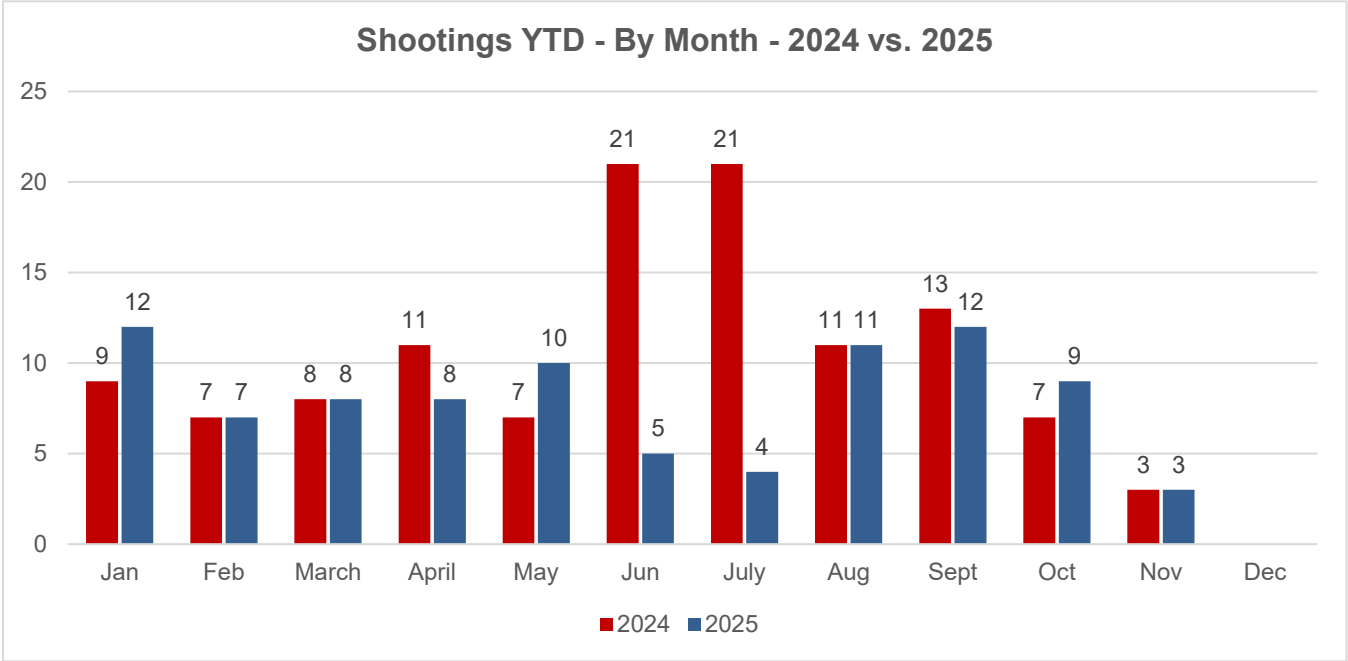
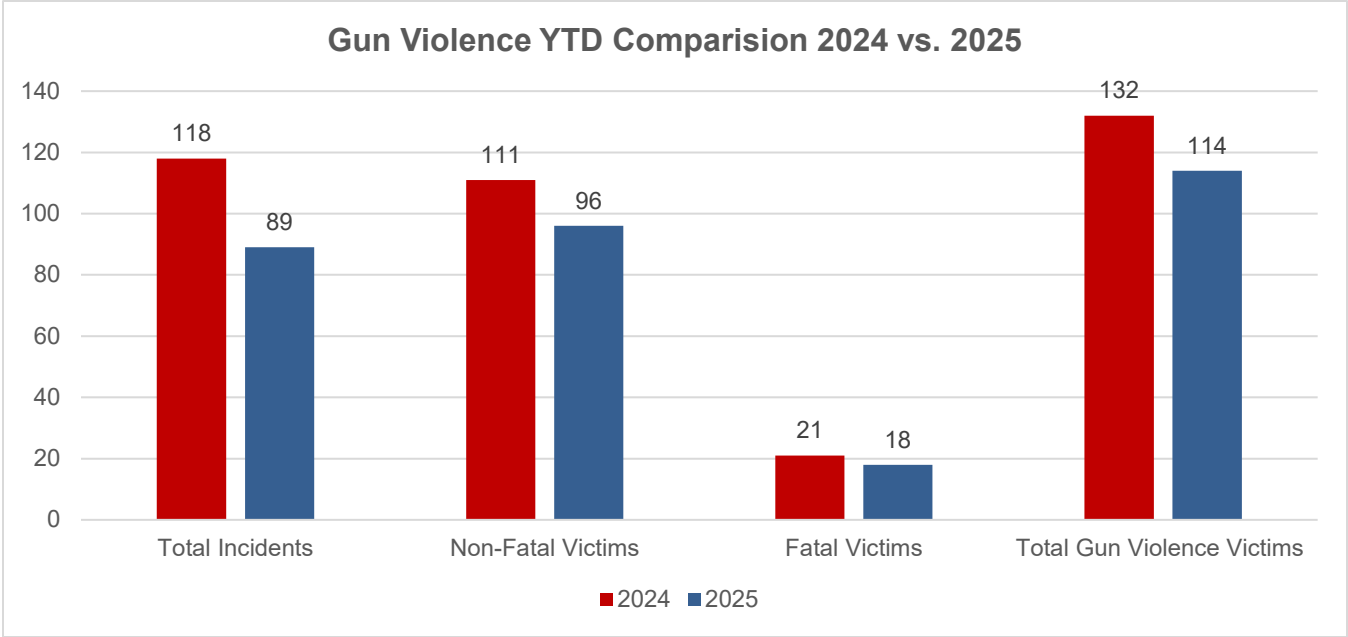
- There was 1 homicide incident reported the week ending 11.09.2025
 - There are 23 homicides YTD with 18 incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - There is 1 homicide in November 2025
 - Overall Clearance Rate: 136% for 2025



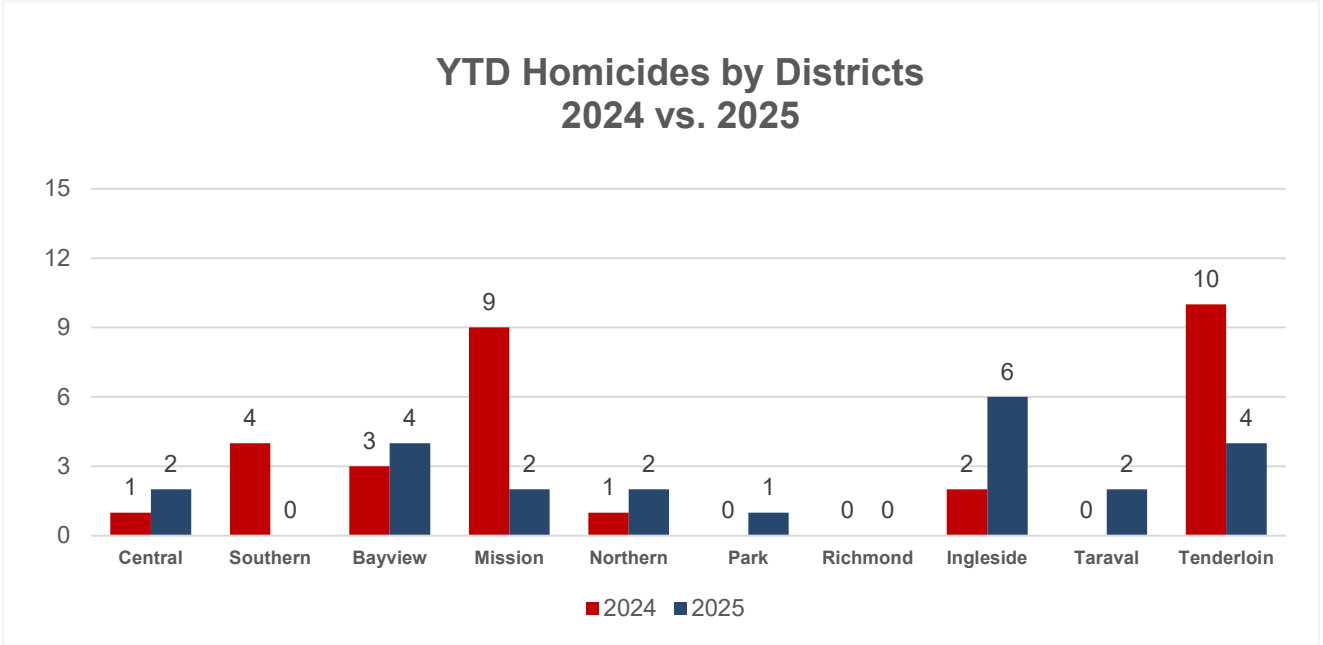
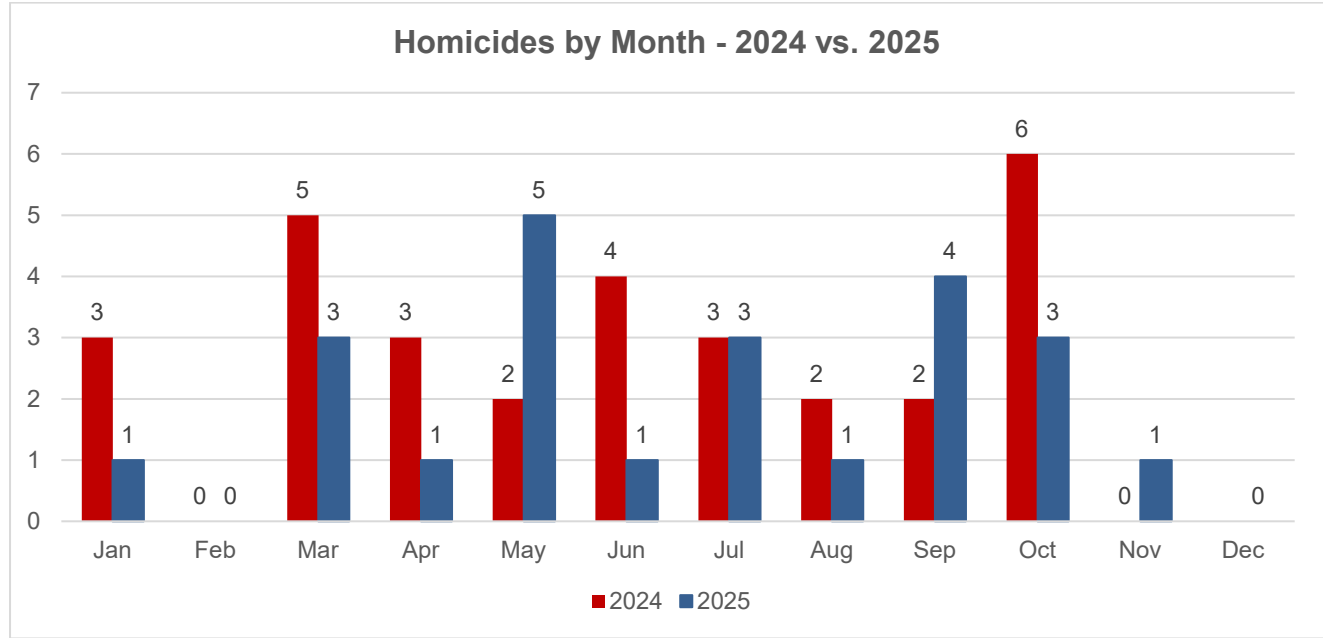
