


Dept. Wide Traffic Violations & Focus on the Five Violations 1/1/2024 – 9/30/2024








Non-Vision Zero Cases:

- 3. Crash that occurred at 914 Point Lobos Ave is waiting for OCME verification as most likely the driver suffered medical issues prior to the crash.


