
**GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE**

**TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are DOWN 100% compared to 2025**




- There were NO homicide incidents reported the week ending 01.11.26**

  - Overall Clearance Rate for 2026: 0%**





