
GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE

GUN VIOLENCE: Total gun violence is DOWN 16% compared to 2024

- There was 1 non-fatal shooting incident causing injuries to 1 victim the week ending 11.02.25
 - For the year, there are a total of 86 firearm-related incidents resulting in 108 victims

TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are DOWN 27% compared to 2024


- There were NO homicide incidents reported the week ending 11.02.2025
 - o There are 22 homicides YTD with 18 incidents resulting from a firearm.
 - There were 3 homicides in October 2025
 - Overall Clearance Rate: 136% for 2025





