
GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE

GUN VIOLENCE: Total gun violence is DOWN 73% compared to 2025

- There was 1 shooting incident causing injuries to 1 victim the week ending 01.18.26
 - For the year, there are a total of 3 firearm-related incidents resulting in 3 victims

TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are UP 100% compared to 2025

- **There were 2 homicide incidents reported the week ending 01.18.26**
 - There are 2 homicides YTD with 1 resulting from a firearm.
 - There are 2 homicides in January 2026
 - **Overall Clearance Rate for 2026: 100%**





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
Gun Violence YTD Comparison 2025 vs. 2026





Shootings YTD - By Month - 2025 vs. 2026
