## Highlights for February 19, 2025

The following report includes the Department of Police Accountability's recent developments:

- ◆ DPA is initiating an **audit** of SFPD's use-of-force, as required by Charter.
- ◆ We've brought on three new interns for the Spring semester and recently opened applications for our Summer internship program.
- ◆ The **Investigations** and **Legal Divisions** will be attending the final Use of Force course, "Human Factors" at the Police Academy tomorrow.

## Investigation Updates

- ◆ **Cases Opened/Closed:** Our office opened 18 new cases and closed 15 cases since the last Commission meeting.
- ◆ **Allegation Trends:** Neglect of Duty (29%) and Conduct unbecoming (8%) made up most of the allegations over the past week.

Conduct Unbecoming an Officer	The officer behaved or spoke inappropriately.	<b>19%</b>
Use of Force	The officer failed to comply with Department General Order 5.01.	<b>10%</b>
Neglect of Duty	The officer drove a City vehicle in a grossly negligent or reckless manner.	<b>10%</b>
Neglect of Duty	The officer failed to properly investigate.	<b>6%</b>
Conduct Unbecoming an Officer	The officer failed to write an incident report.	<b>6%</b>

Underlying calls for service types involved: Cases involved assault and sexual assault.
