


SFPD Crackdown: Over 350 Arrests, 12 lbs. of Narcotics Seized in 2 Weeks 25-139

■ Total Focus on 5 Violations ■ All Other Traffic Violations







SF Vision Zero Traffic Fatalities: 1/1/2025 – 12/31/2025



SF Vision Zero Traffic Fatalities: 2024 YTD vs 2025 YTD


