Summary for April 8, 2026

The Department of Police Accountability's highlights for the week:

- DPA has opened an independent investigation into the Sunday, March 22, 2026 incident involving federal immigration agents at the San Francisco International Airport.
- DPA staff presented at the Mission Station Community Meeting and the Hayes Valley Neighborhood Association Public Safety Committee Meeting.
- DPA's 2023 audit of the handling of officer misconduct issued 31 recommendations to SFPD. The Office of the Controller is currently conducting follow-up on those recommendations. DPA will ensure the Commission receives a copy of the Controller's report when it is final.

Investigation Updates:

◆ **Statistics Since the Last Police Commission Meeting (April 1, 2026):**

- **Cases Opened:** 19
- **Cases Closed:** 21
- Year-to-Date Comparison:
 - Volume of incoming complaints continues to rise and is now about 18% higher than for the same period last year.
 - The number of cases past 270 days is currently 8 and all but one are tolled. This continues to be a historic low.

Allegation Type	Allegation Summary	Percent
Conduct Unbecoming an Officer	The officer behaved or spoke inappropriately.	21%
Neglect of Duty	The officer failed to take required action.	16%
Conduct Unbecoming an Officer	The officer displayed threatening, intimidating, or harassing behavior.	16%
Neglect of Duty	The officer failed to properly investigate.	11%
