## Highlights for June 11, 2025

The following report includes the Department of Police Accountability's recent developments:

DPA's audit of SFPD's use of force update:

- This audit reviews how SFPD supervisors evaluate use-of-force incidents.
- To help ensure comprehensive and informed analysis, we are surveying SFPD supervisors to incorporate their insights into the audit.
- DPA sent the survey to supervisors on June 2<sup>nd</sup>, with a reminder email on June 9<sup>th</sup>. The survey will close on June 16<sup>th</sup>.

## Budget FY 2025-2026 and 2026-2027

- The DPA is scheduled to present its budget to the Board of Supervisors' Budget and Appropriations Committee on Friday, June 13, 2025.

## Investigation Updates

- ♦ **Statistics Since Last Commission Meeting on June 4, 2025:** Our office opened 16 cases and closed 32 cases.

## Investigations Over 270-Days/Tolling

The DPA has 14 cases open for more than 270 days. Of those, 11 cases are “tolled”.

Note: Per California Government Code Section 3304, there are several exceptions that “toll,” or pause the one-year time limit. DPA closed one of the cases reported last week. The other case is expected to close shortly after the member response forms are due on June 17. The DPA also closed a tolled case. Two additional cases crossed 270 days last week. Neither case is sustainable, and both are being reviewed for closure.

## DPA Sustained Cases Pending Final Adjudication

- ♦ There are 98 cases sustained by DPA that are pending with the SFPD.
- ♦ There are 2 cases pending with the San Francisco Police Commission.
