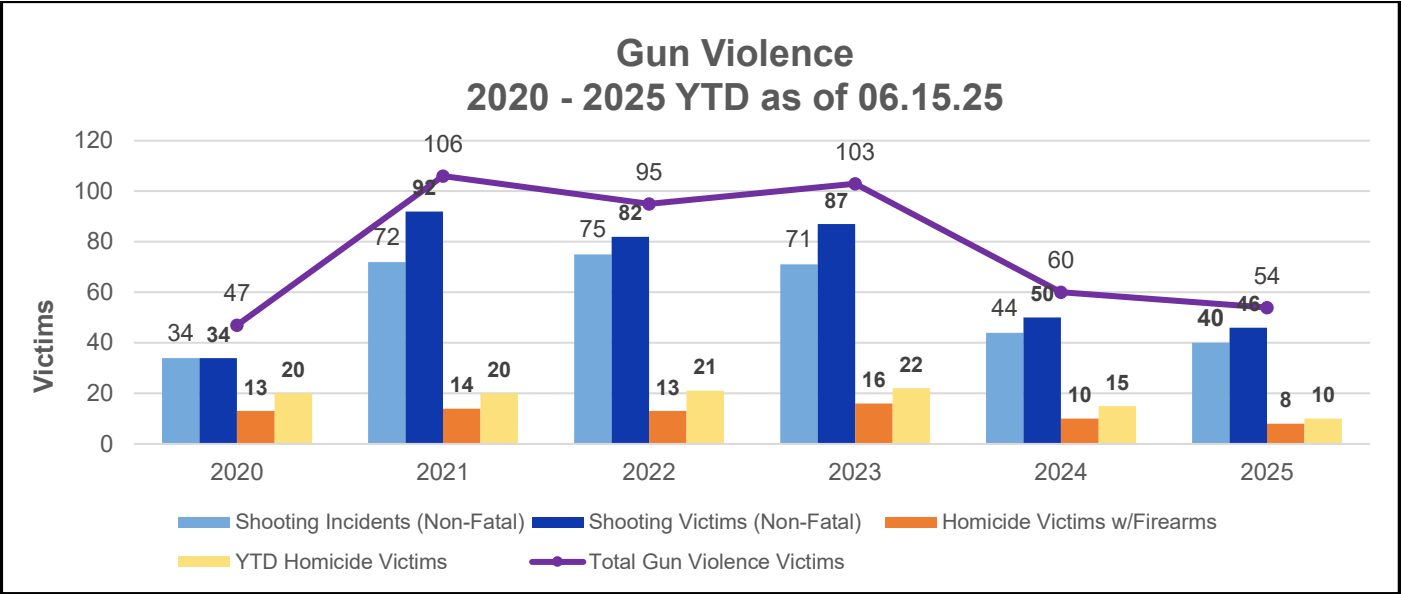
GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE

GUN VIOLENCE: Total gun violence is DOWN 10% compared to 2024

- There was 1 non-fatal shooting incident causing injuries to 1 victim the week ending 06.15.25
 - For the year, there are a total of 47 firearm-related incidents resulting in 54 victims

TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are DOWN 33% compared to 2024

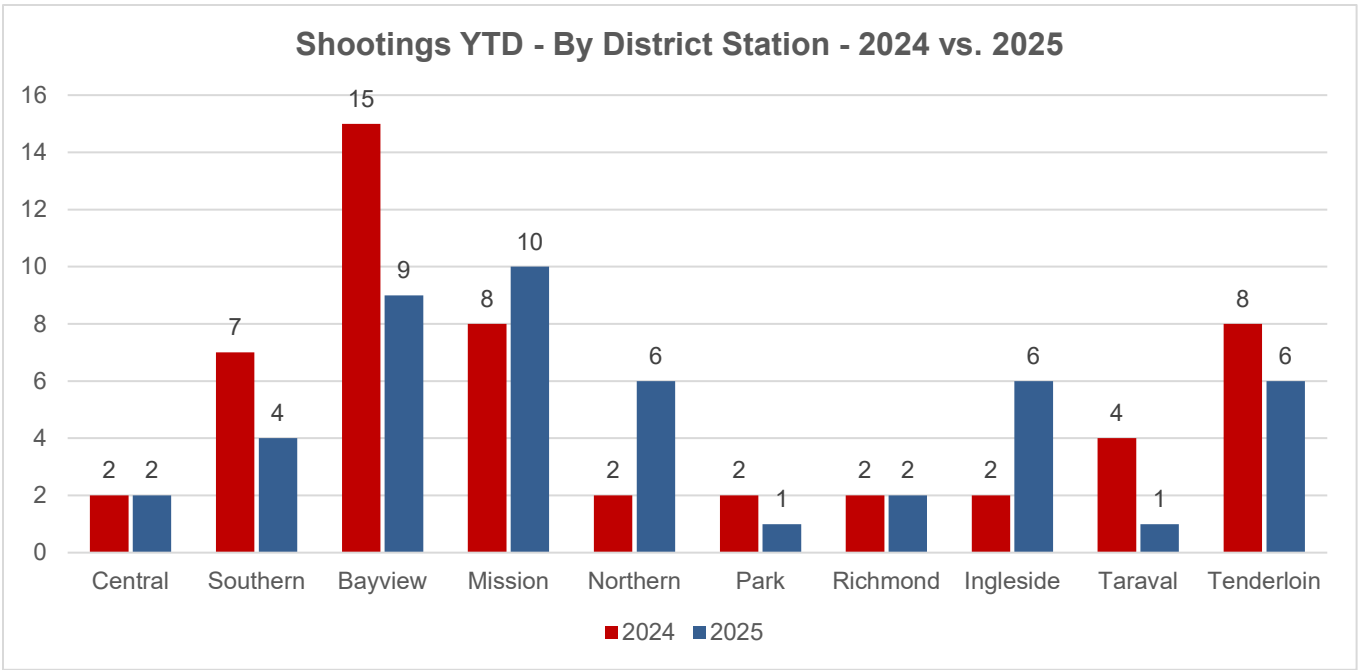
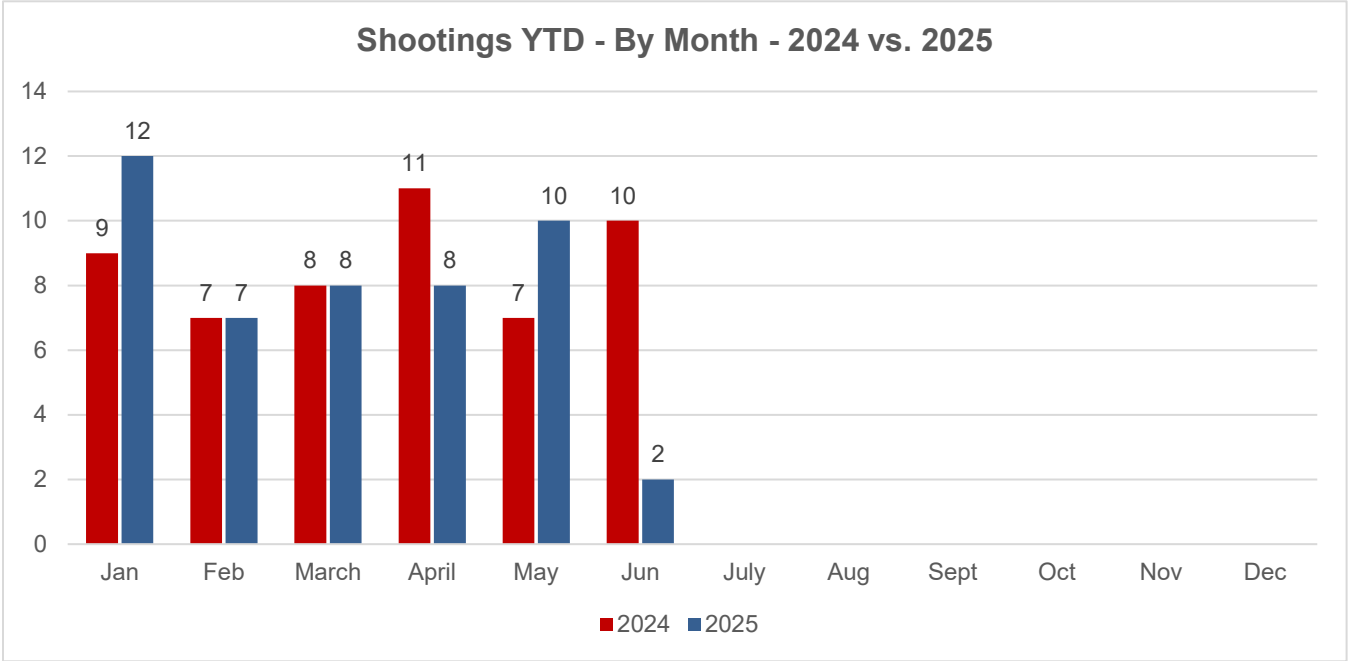
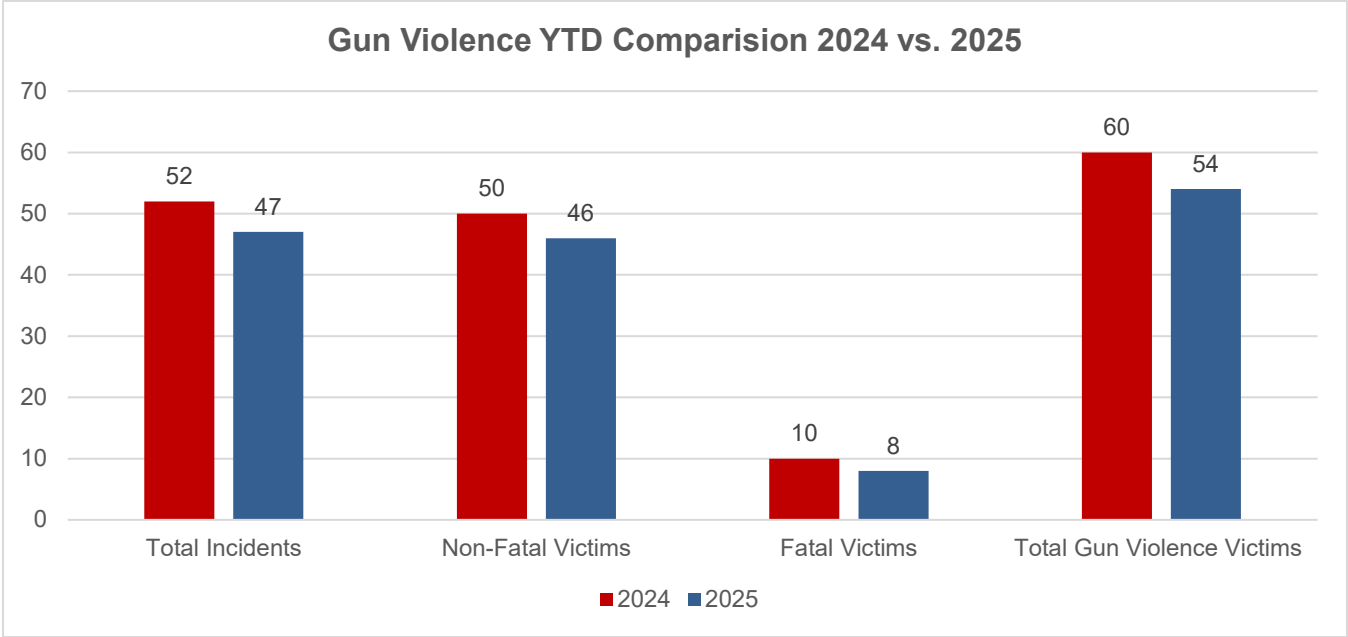
- There were 0 homicide incidents for the week ending 06.15.2025

 - Overall Clearance Rate: 160% for 2025**



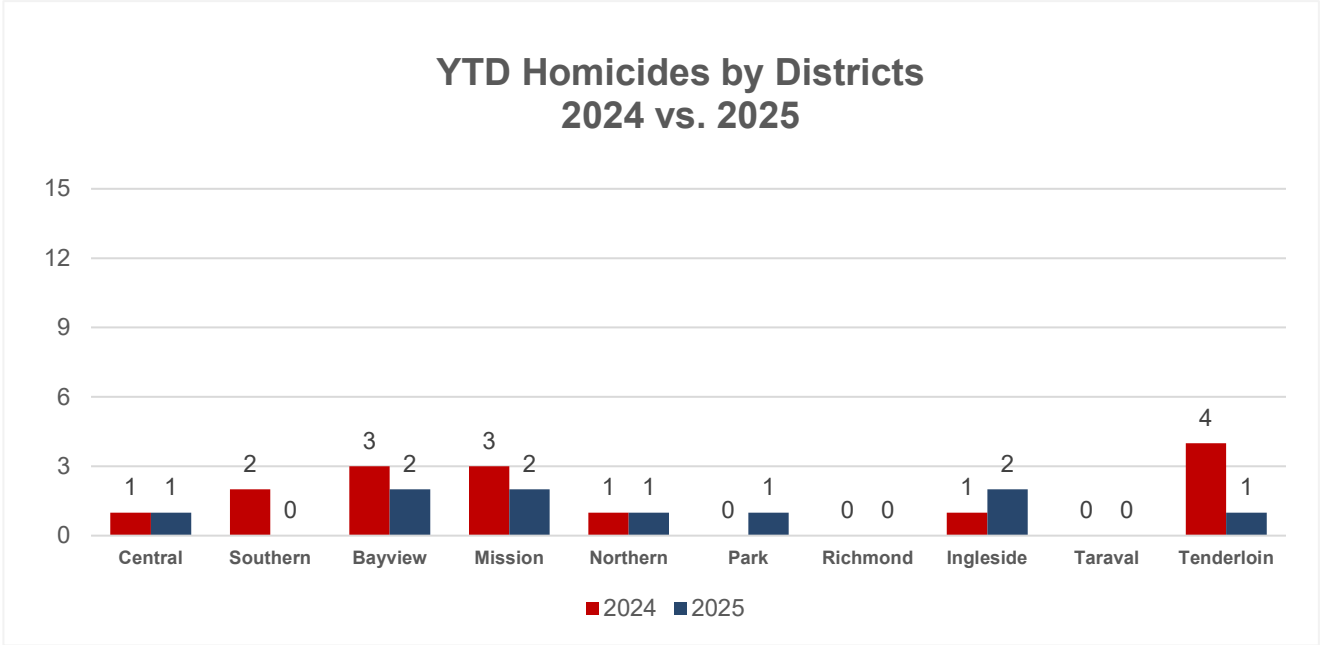
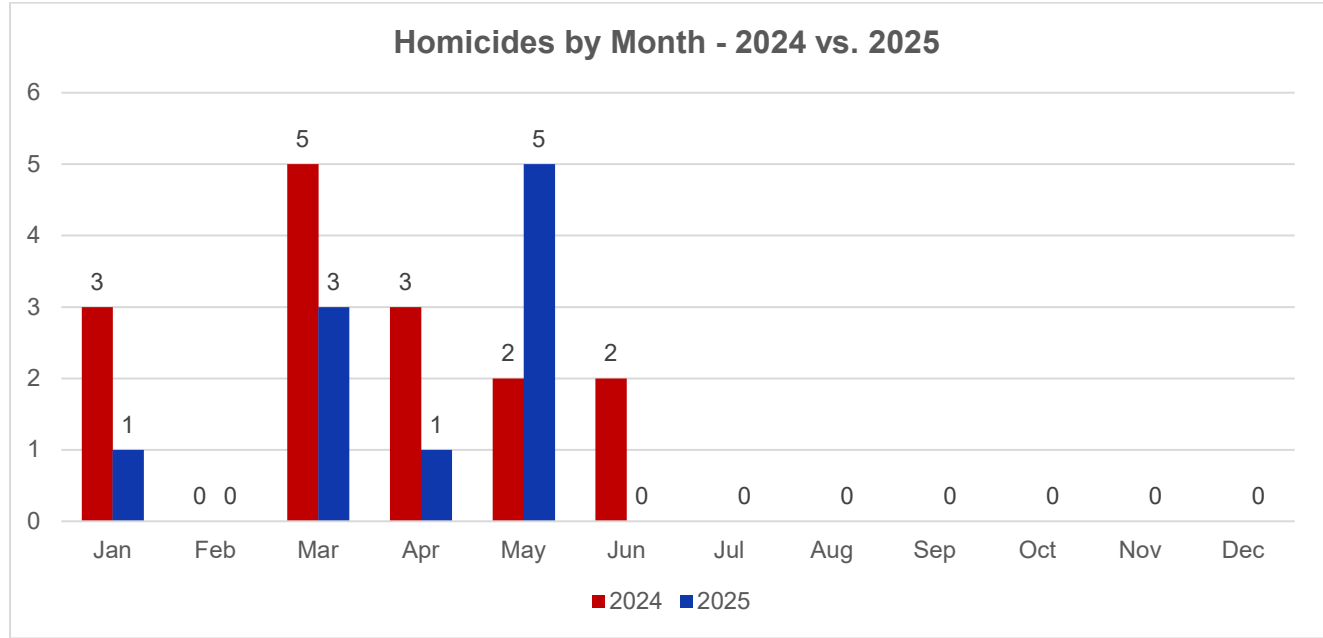
