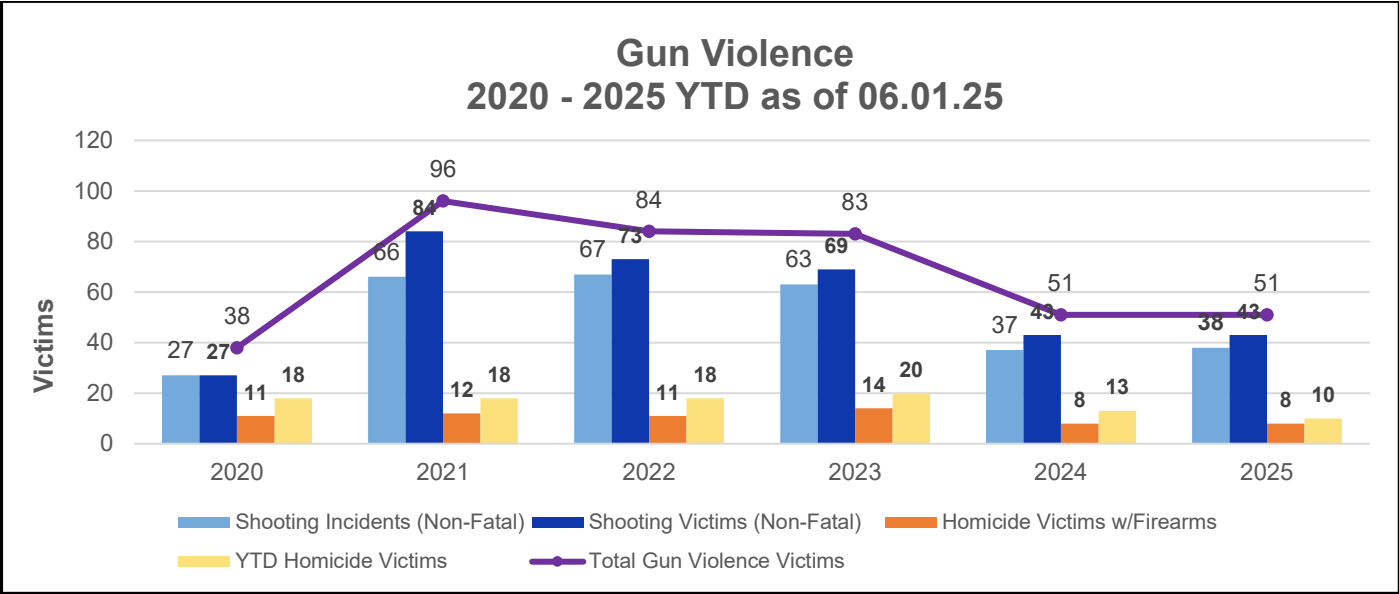

GUN VIOLENCE – 0% difference compared to 2024

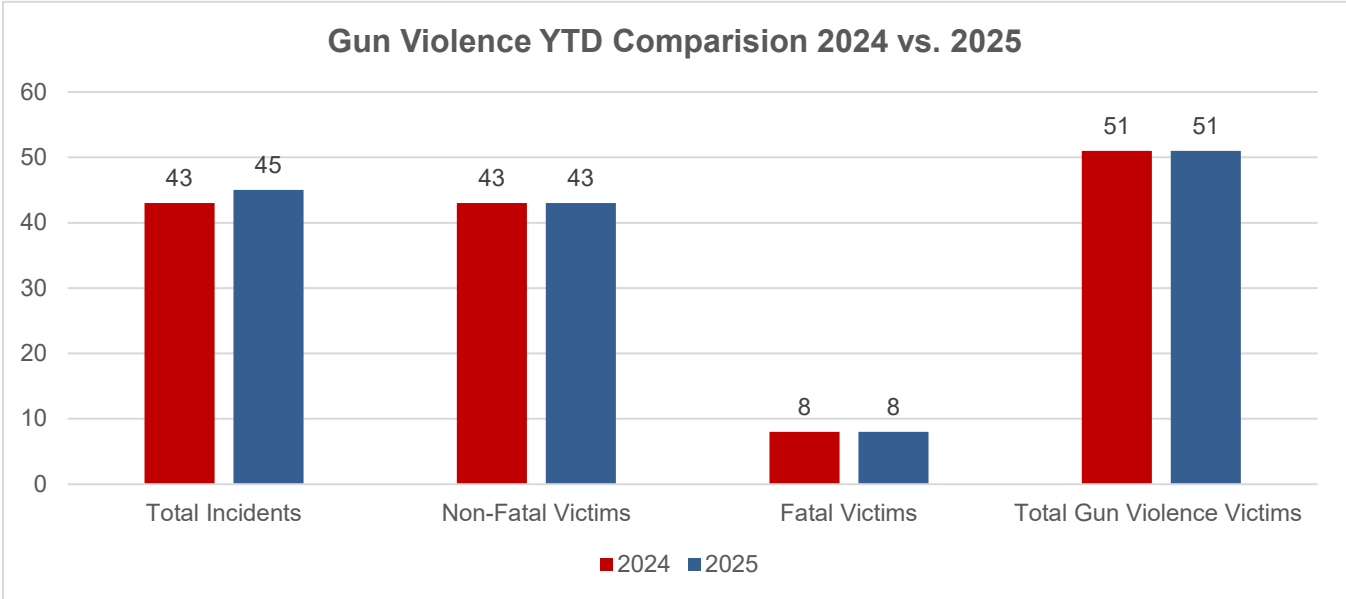
- There was 1 non-fatal shooting incident causing injuries to 1 victim the week ending 06.01.25

 - There are 0 homicides in June 2025
 - Overall Clearance Rate: 130% for 2025



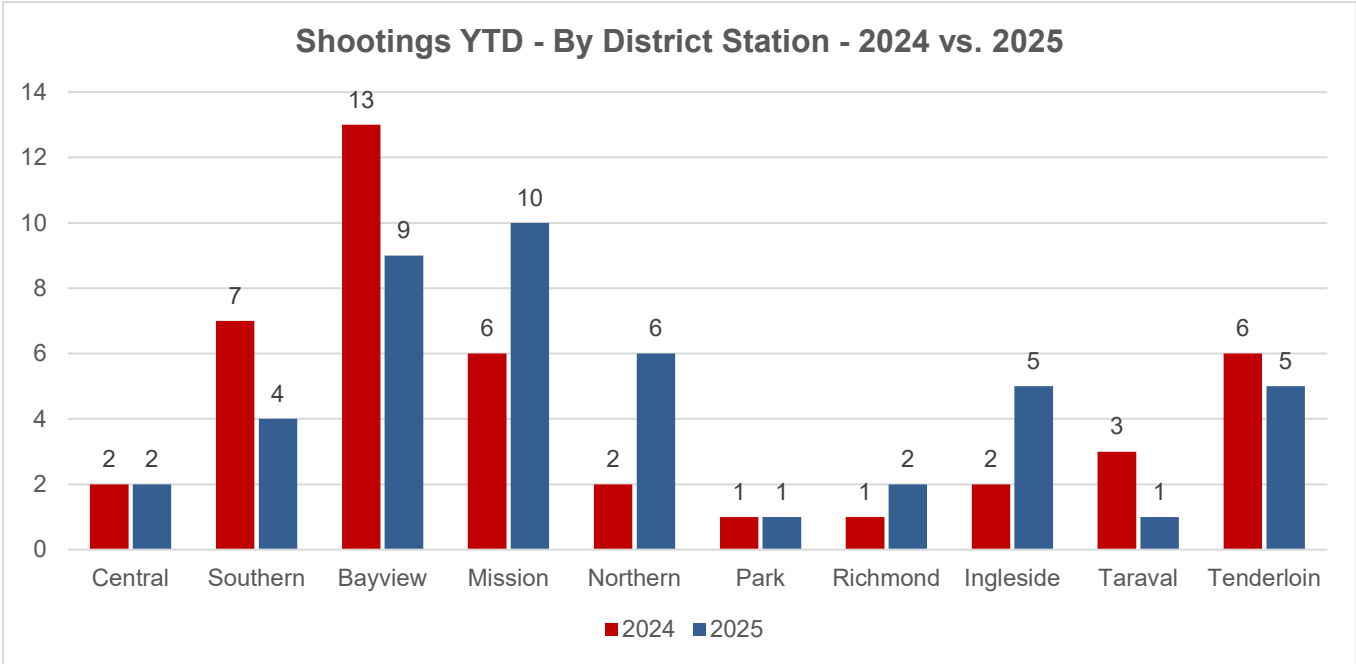
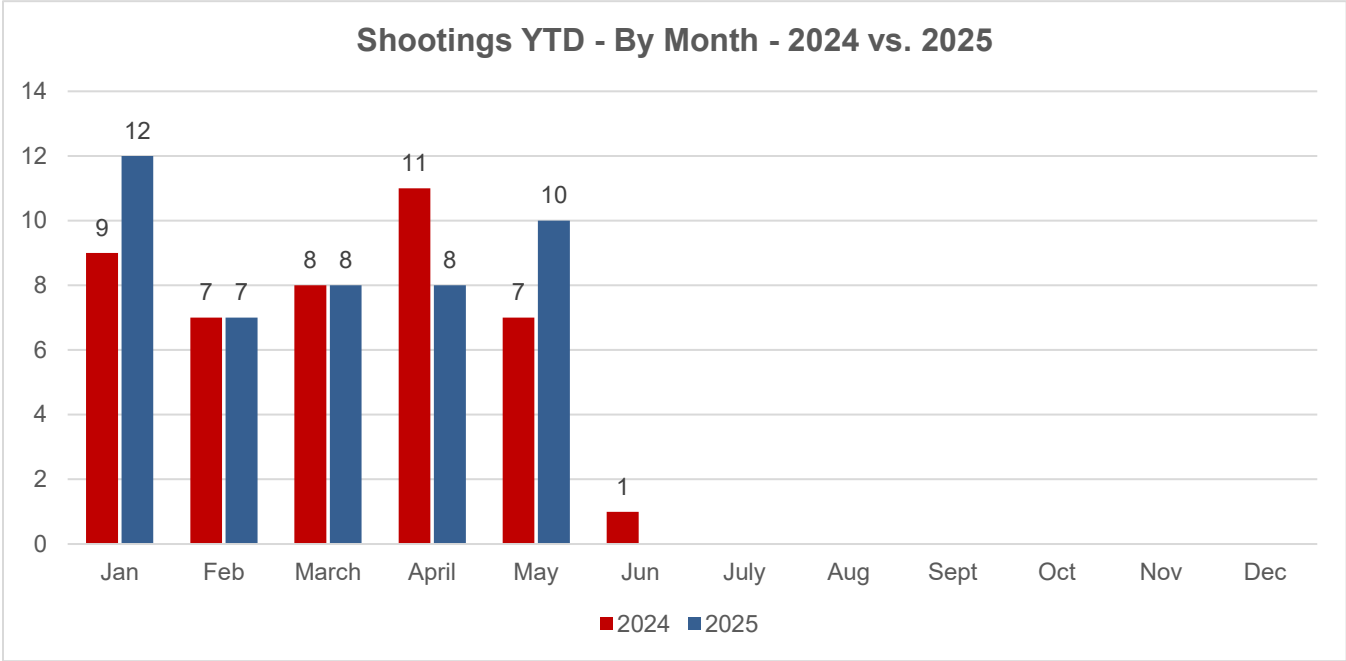

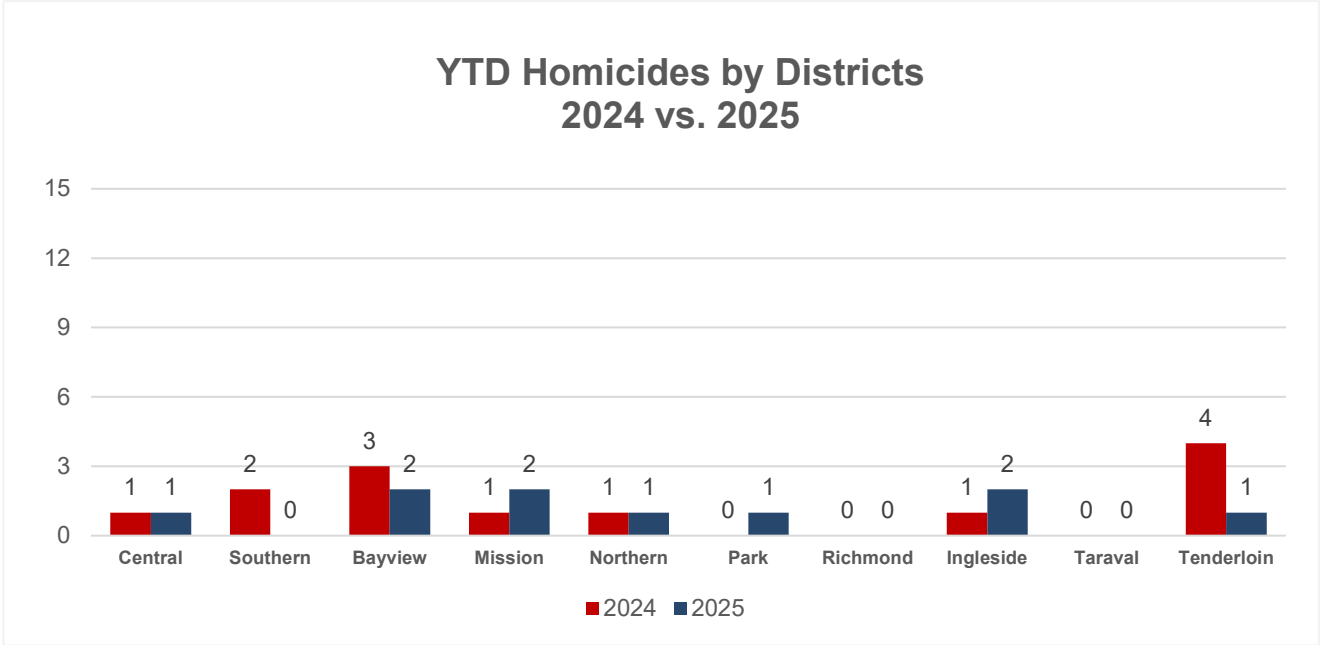
