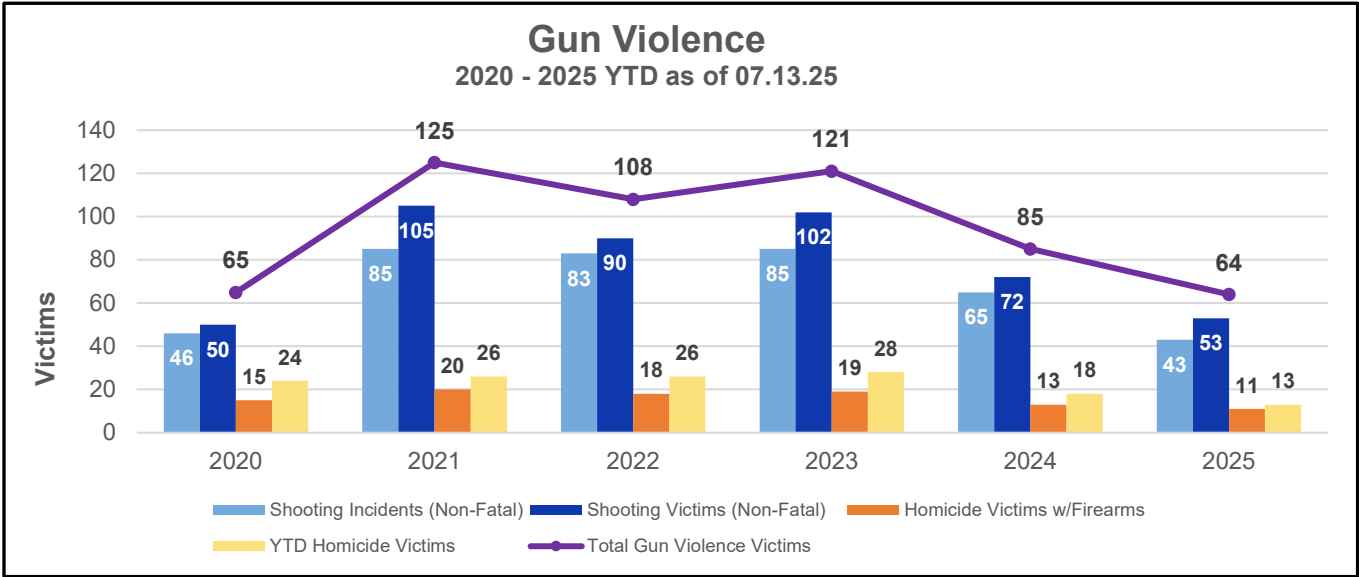
GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE

GUN VIOLENCE: Total gun violence is DOWN 25% compared to 2024

- There were no non-fatal shooting incidents causing injuries any victim the week ending 07.13.25
  - For the year, there are a total of 52 firearm-related incidents resulting in 64 victims

TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are DOWN 28% compared to 2024

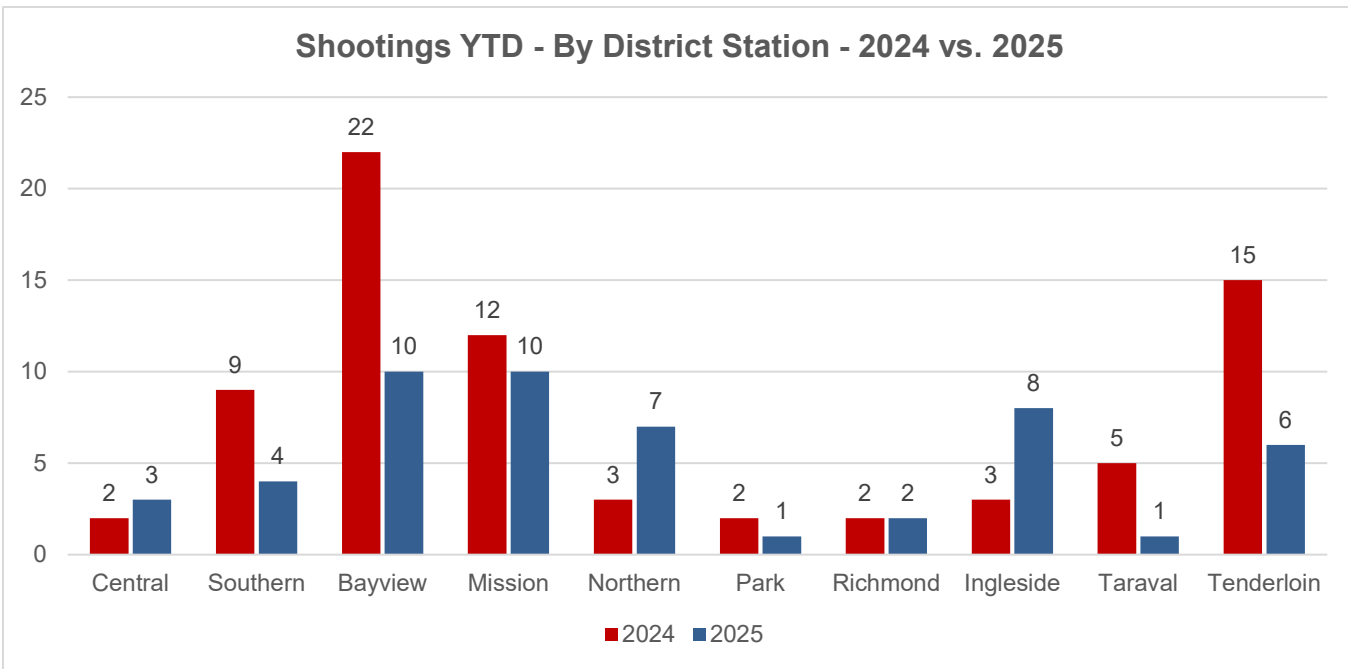
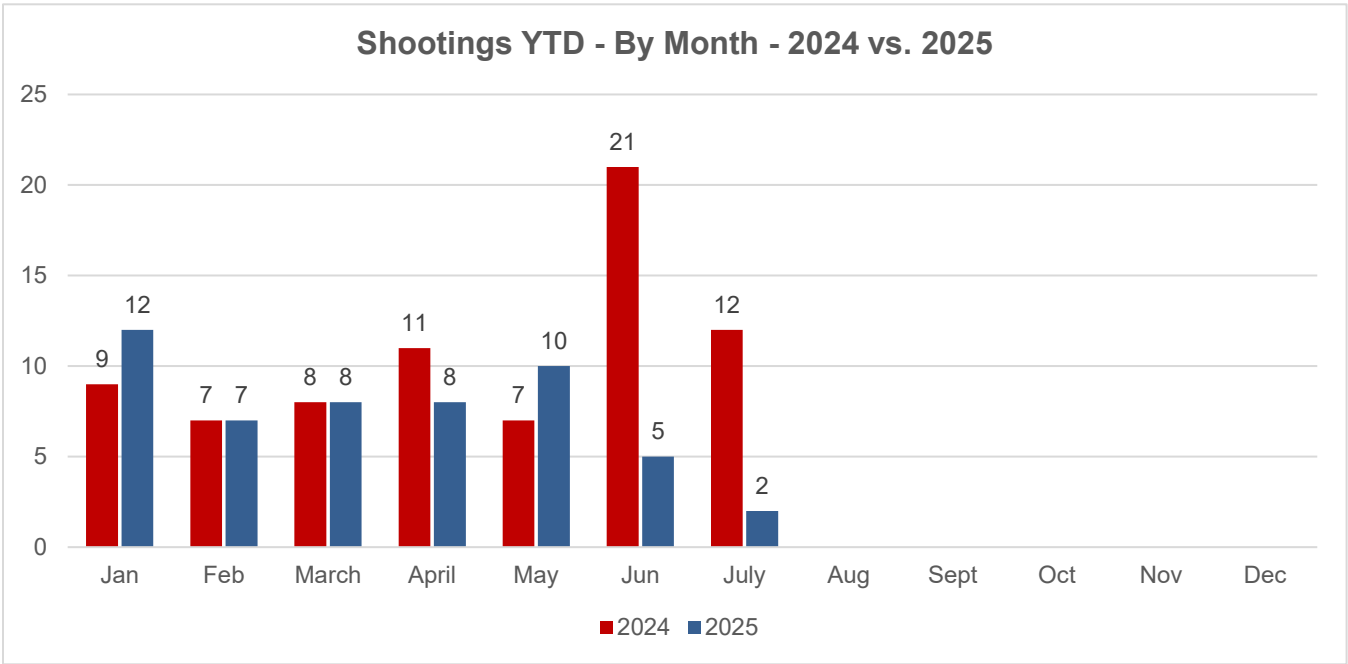
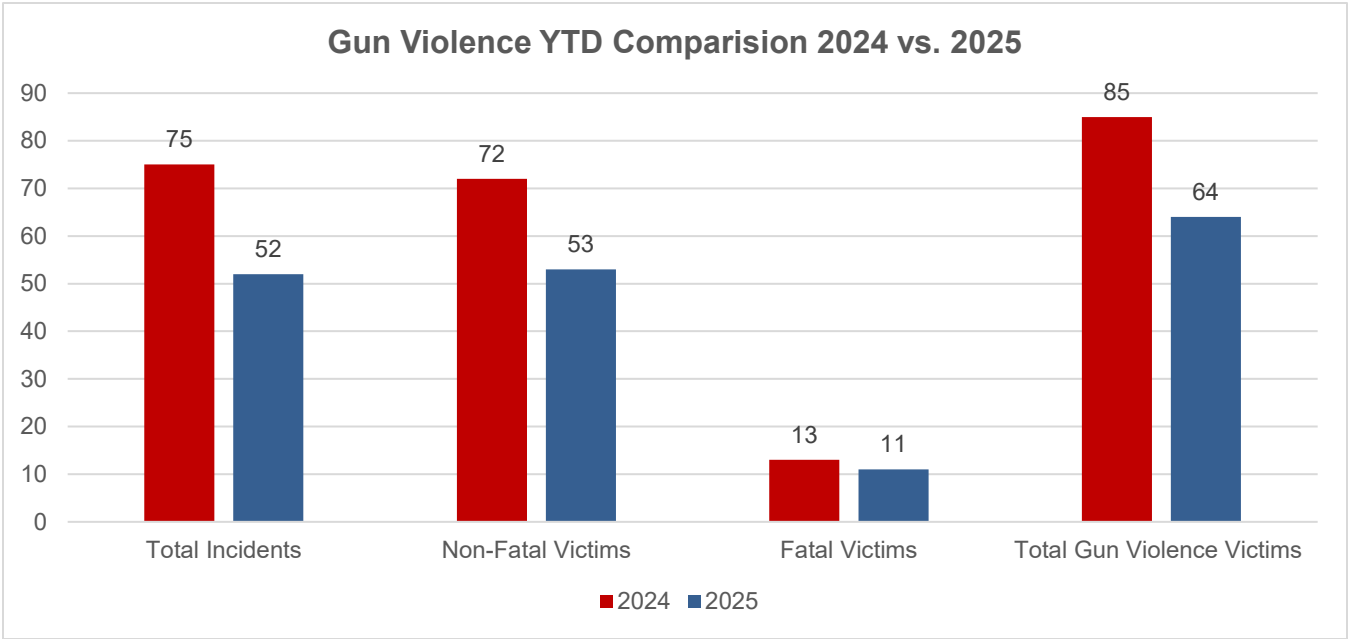
- There were no homicide incidents that occurred during the week ending 07.13.2025
  - However, there was one homicide reported when the victim of a shooting incident that occurred on 07/03/25 succumbed to injuries on 07/08/25.
  - There are 13 homicides YTD with 11 incidents resulting from a firearm.
  - There are 2 homicides in July 2025
  - Overall Clearance Rate: 142% for 2025



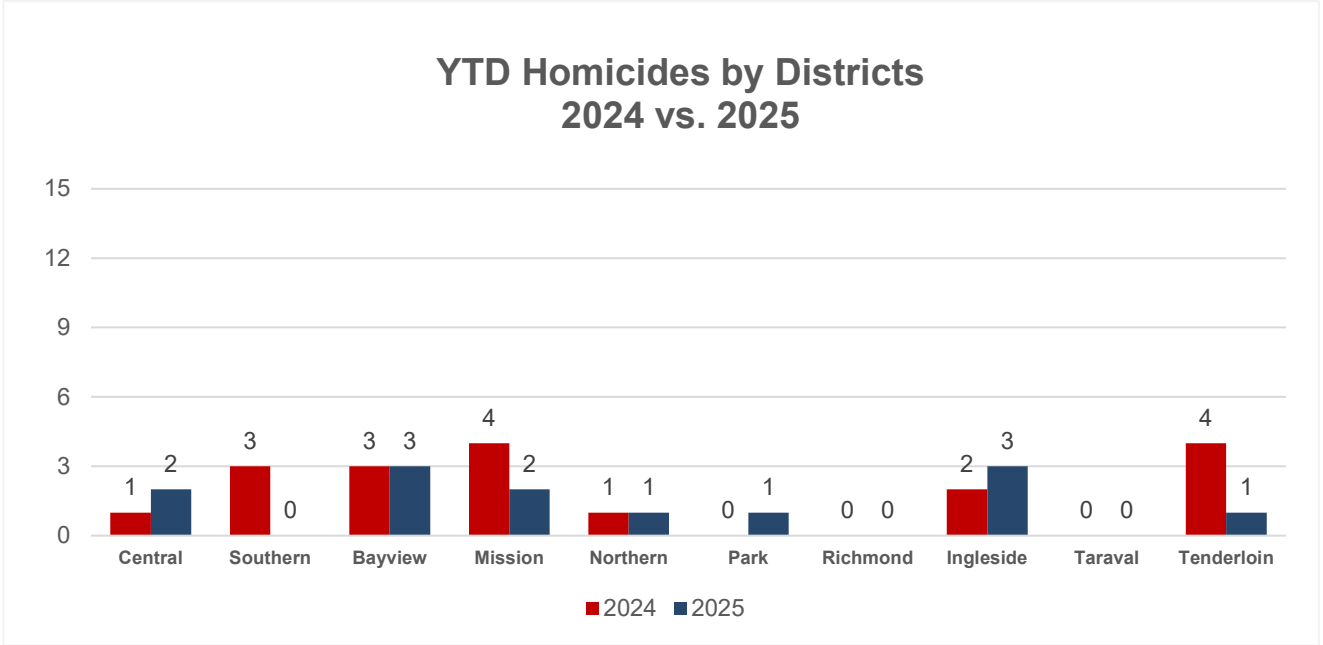
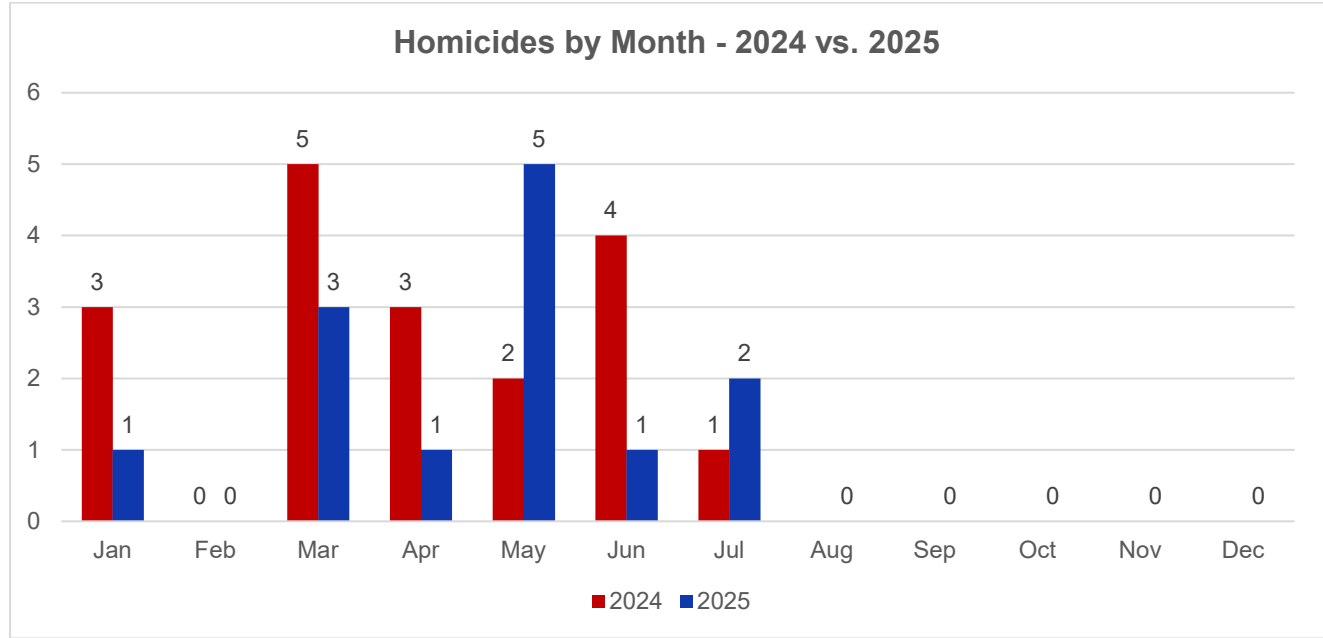
