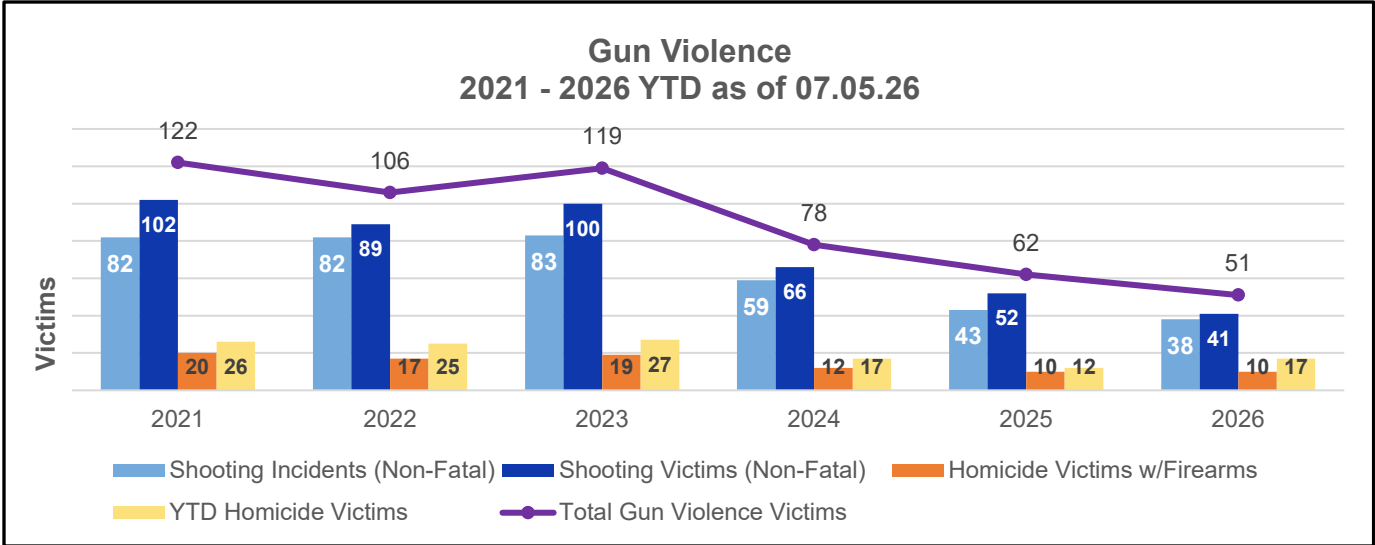
GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE

GUN VIOLENCE: Total gun violence is DOWN 18% compared to 2025

- There was 1 shooting incident causing injuries to 2 victims the week ending 07.05.26
 - There is a total of 44 fatal/non-fatal shooting incidents resulting in 51 victims; 10 homicides, 41 non-fatal

TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are UP 42% compared to 2025

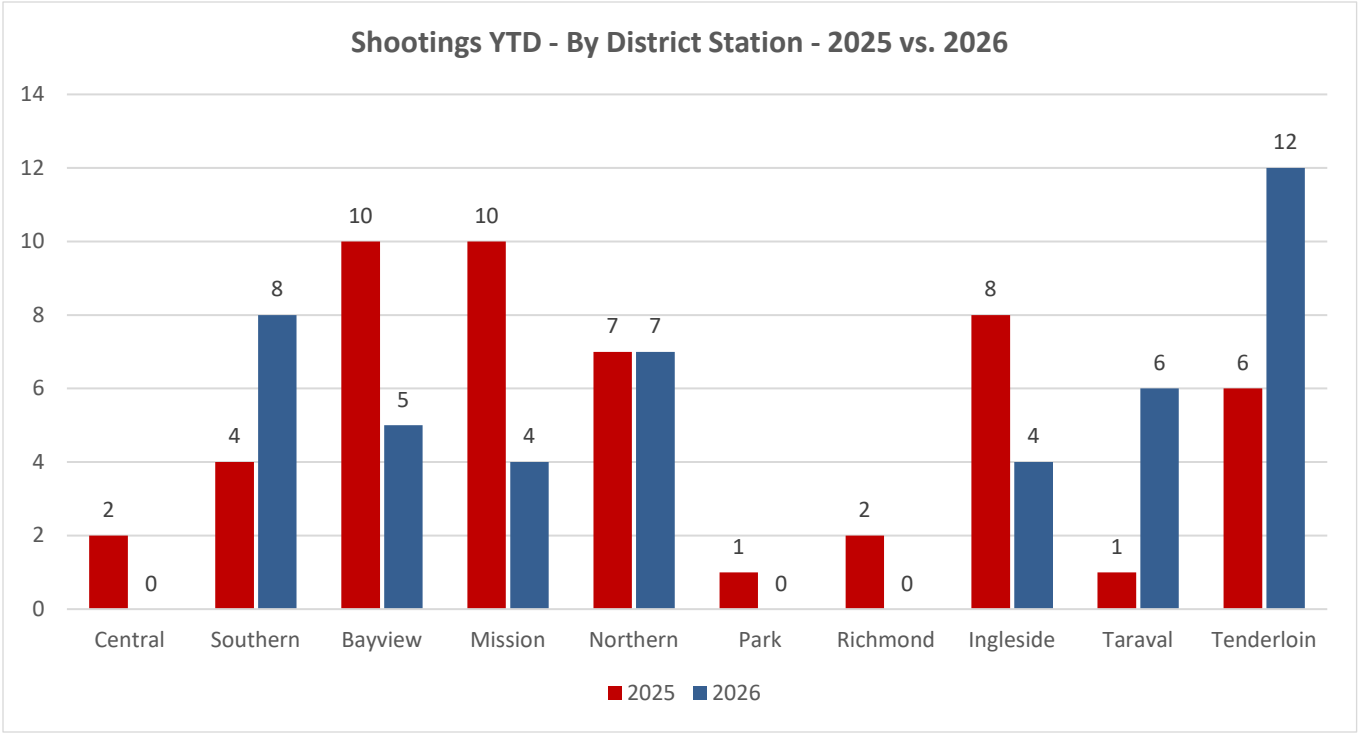
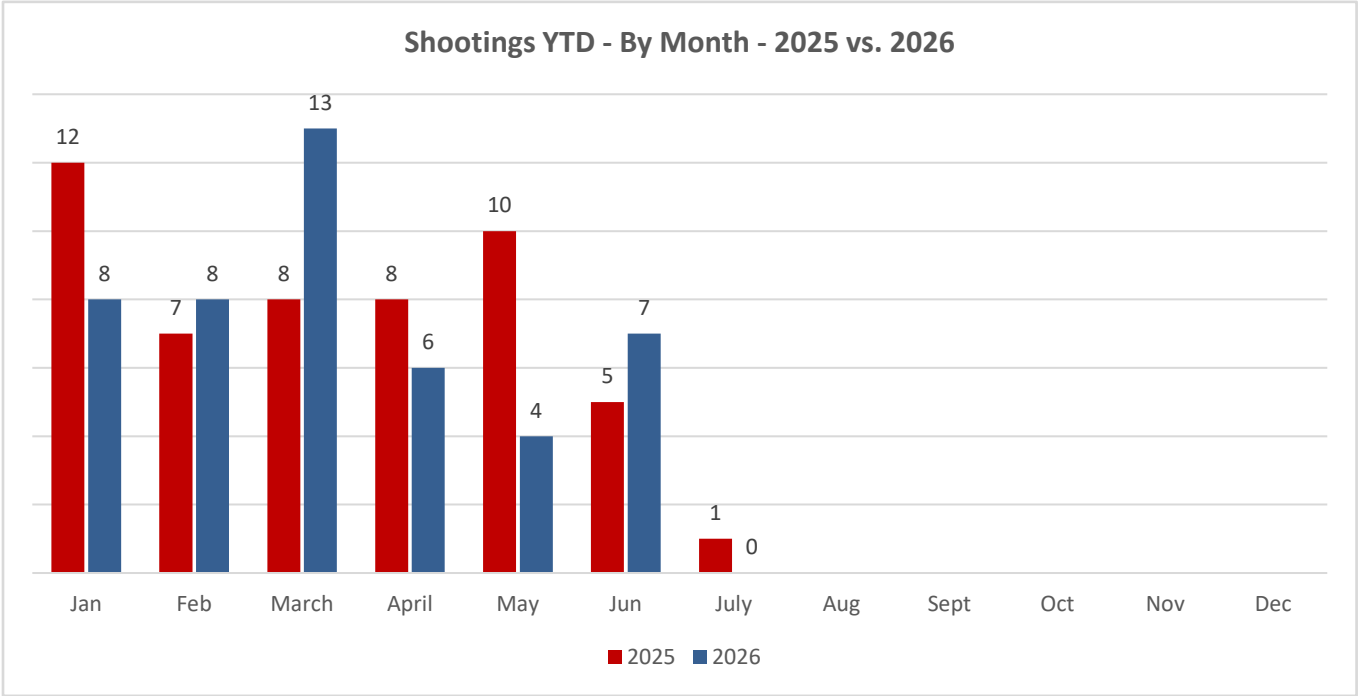
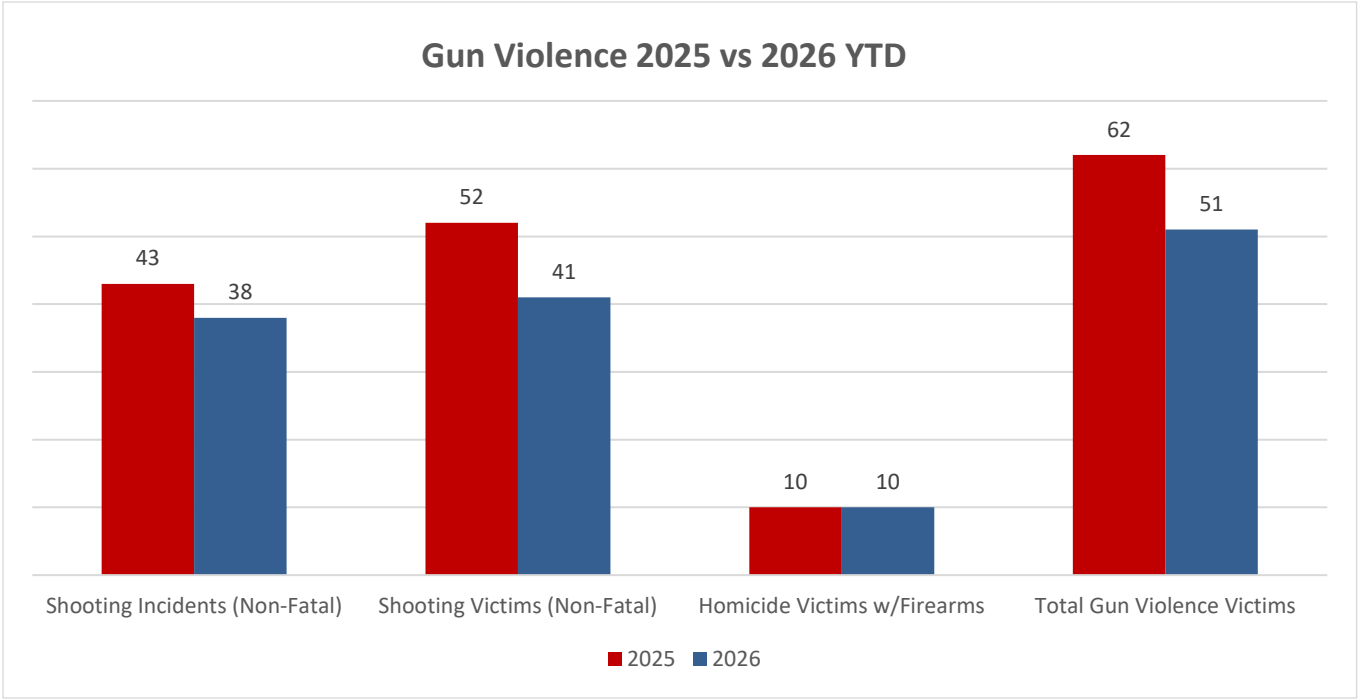
- There were NO homicide incidents reported the week ending 07.05.26**

 - Overall Clearance Rate for 2026: 118%**



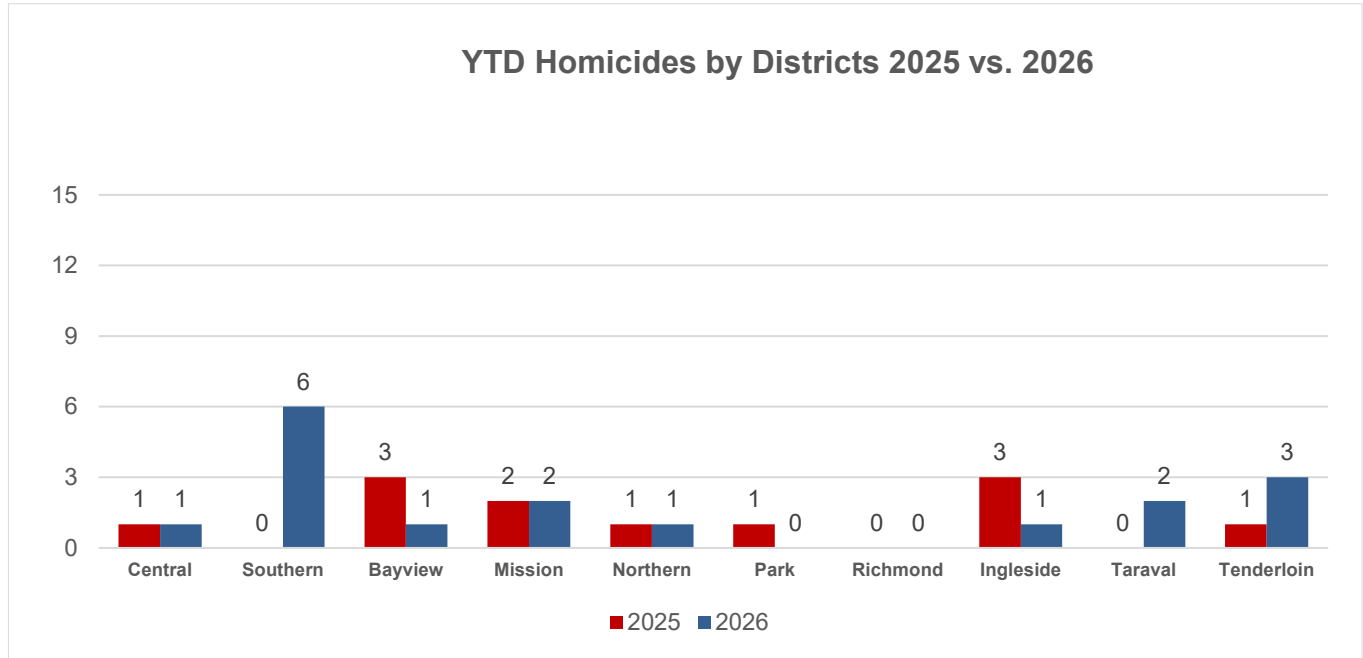
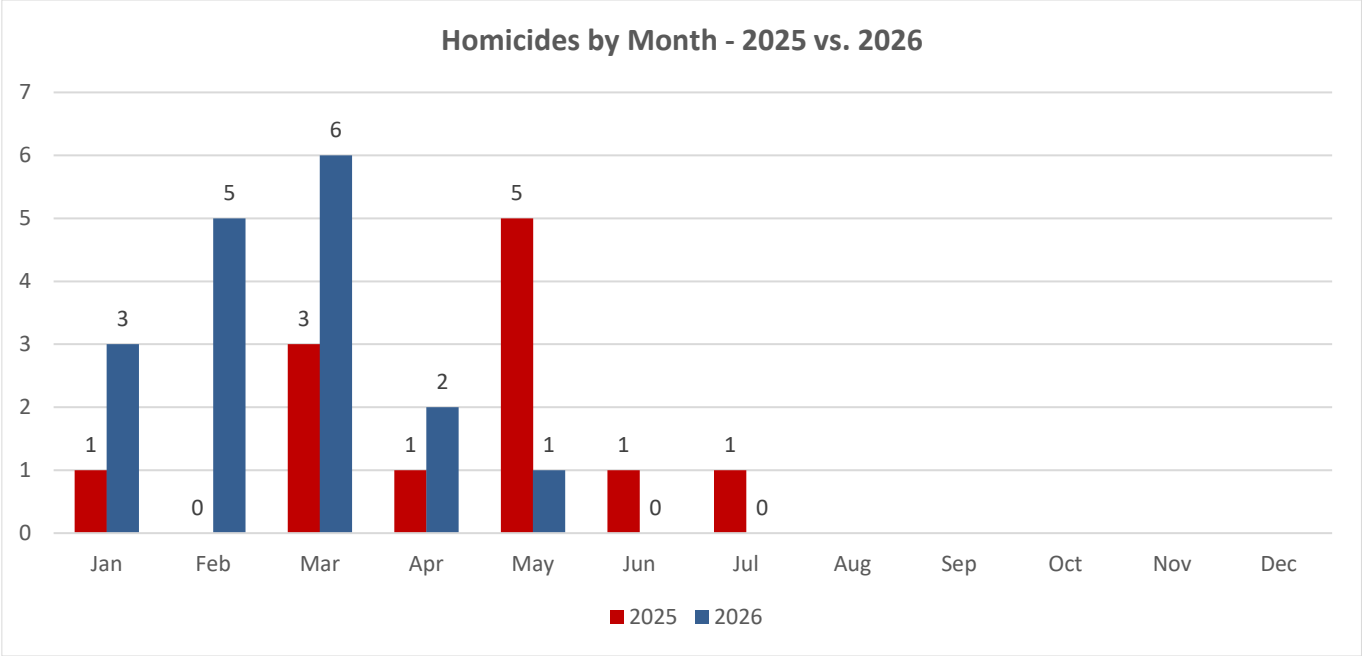
