
**GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE**

**GUN VIOLENCE:** Total gun violence is DOWN 20% compared to 2024

- There was 1 non-fatal shooting incident causing injuries to 1 victim the week ending 07.06.25
- NOTE: an additional 4 victims received non-fatal injuries as part of the homicide incident below
- For the year, there are a total of 52 firearm-related incidents resulting in 63 victims

**TOTAL HOMICIDES:** Homicides are DOWN 29% compared to 2024




- There was 1 homicide incident for the week ending 07.06.2025

- Overall Clearance Rate: 155% for 2025**





