On Tuesday, April 1, 2025, pursuant to Department General Order 3.10.I(D), the Firearm Discharge Review Board (FDRB) convened to review the completed OIS investigations for the Second Quarter of 2025. The meeting was held at the Public Safety Building. The FDRB reviewed completed **OIS 21-002 and OIS 22-001**.

Sergeant Joshua Bryant presented **OIS 21-002**. After considering the facts, conclusions, and analysis in the case, the FDRB voted unanimously to concur with the recommendations of both "IN POLICY" and "OUT OF POLICY" regarding the officers involved in this discharge.

Ms. Woo of the DPA did not have any comment regarding the incident. FTFO members discussed future trainings planned to address tactical decision-making considerations that arose from this incident.

Sergeant Marilu Aguilar then presented **OIS 22-001**. After considering the facts, conclusions, and analysis in the case, the FDRB voted unanimously to concur with the recommendations of "IN POLICY" regarding the officers involved in this discharge.

Ms. Woo of the DPA only brought up a policy consideration about DGO 5.01 that contains confusing language about whether officers are prohibited from utilizing ERIWs when handling incidents involving individuals armed with firearms. FTFO members agreed that the language could be clearer and discussed that officers are trained to utilize both lethal and non-lethal options in all situations. In this incident, the officers using ERIWs had lethal cover and were highly trained specialists.
