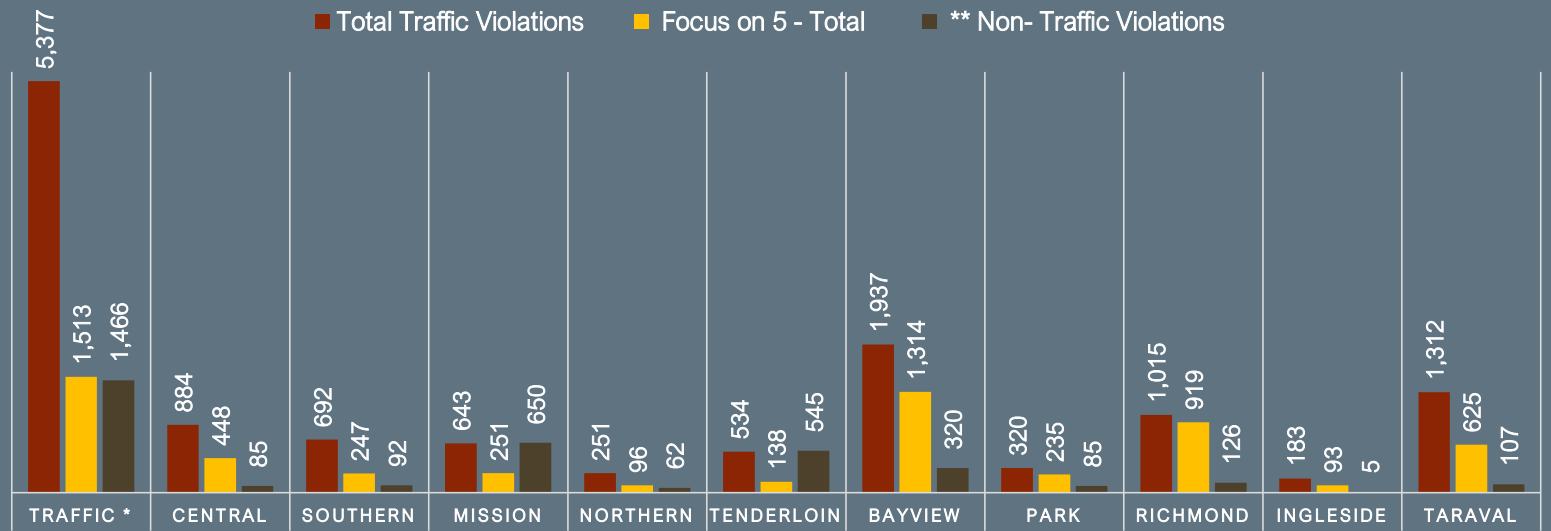

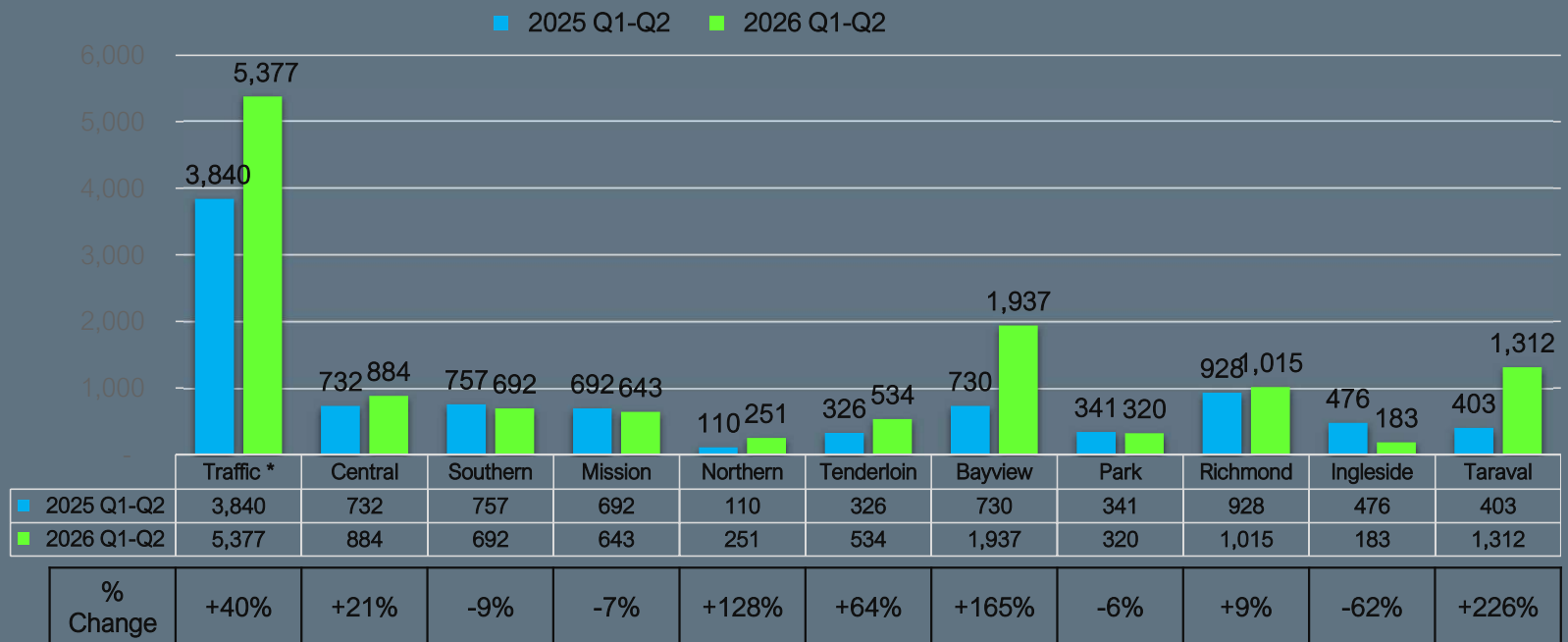

Department Wide Total Traffic Violations Issuance 2025 vs 2026 Q1 ~ Q2

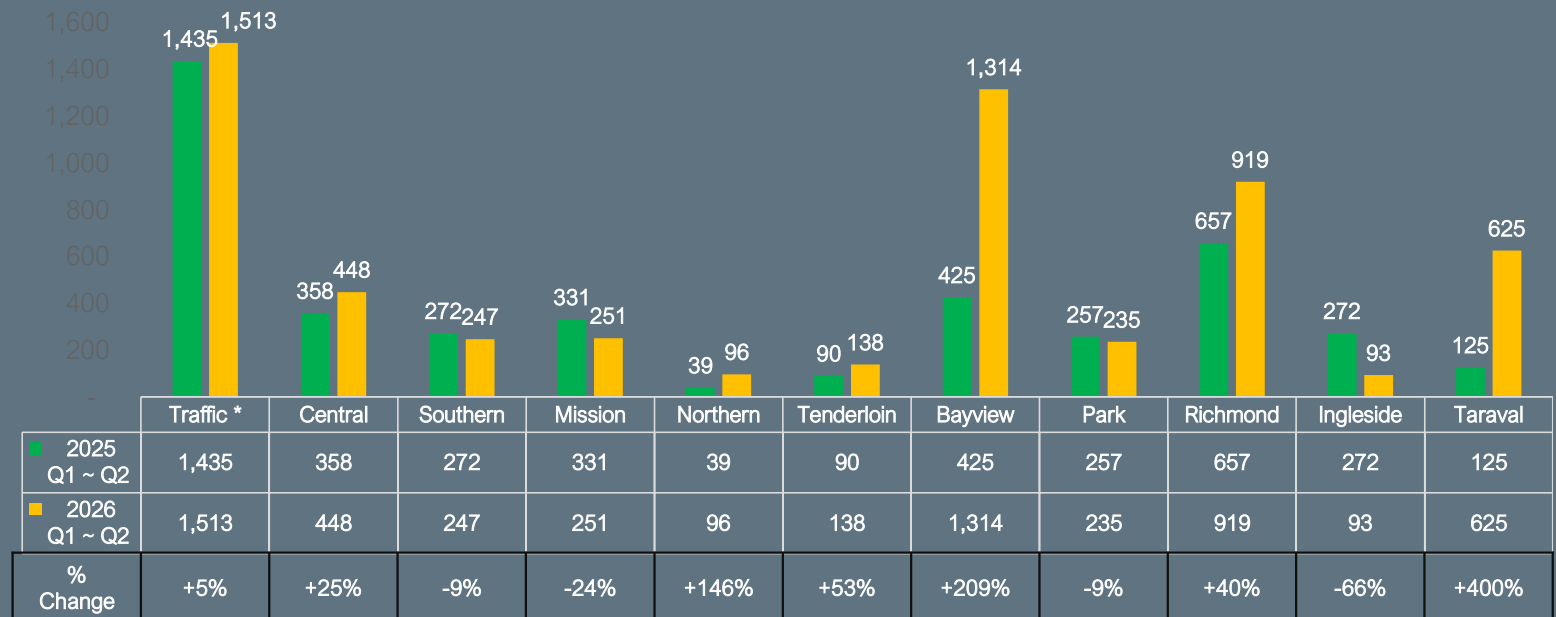

Department Wide Focus on the Five Traffic Violations Issuance 2025 vs 2026 Q1 ~ Q2



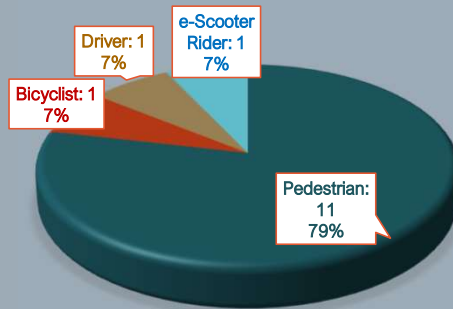

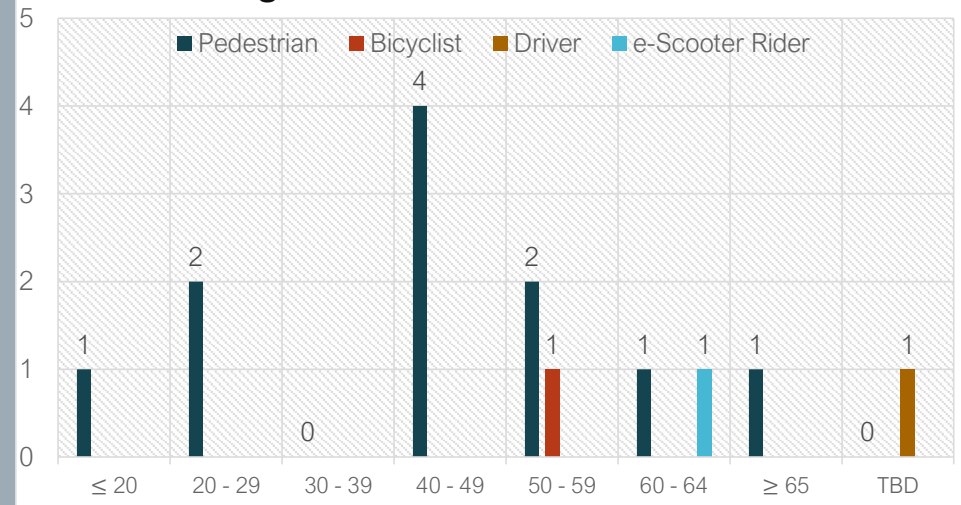
SF Vision Zero Traffic Fatalities 1/1/2026 – 6/30/2026

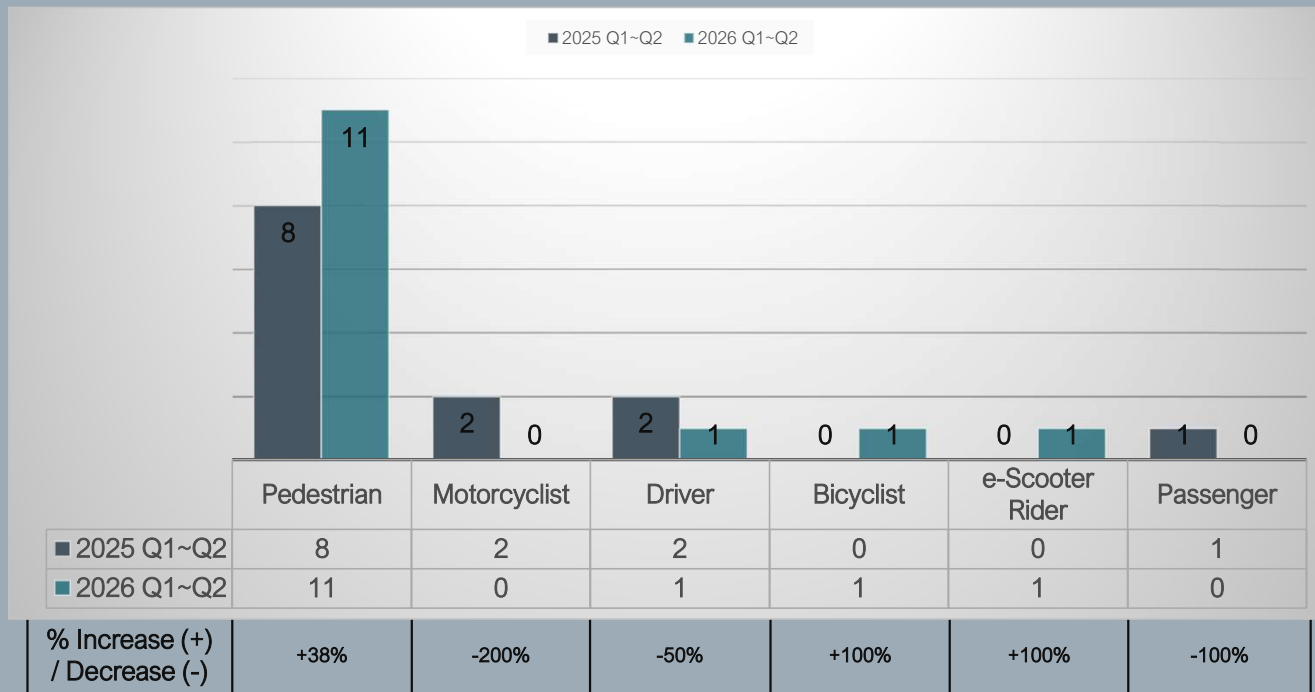

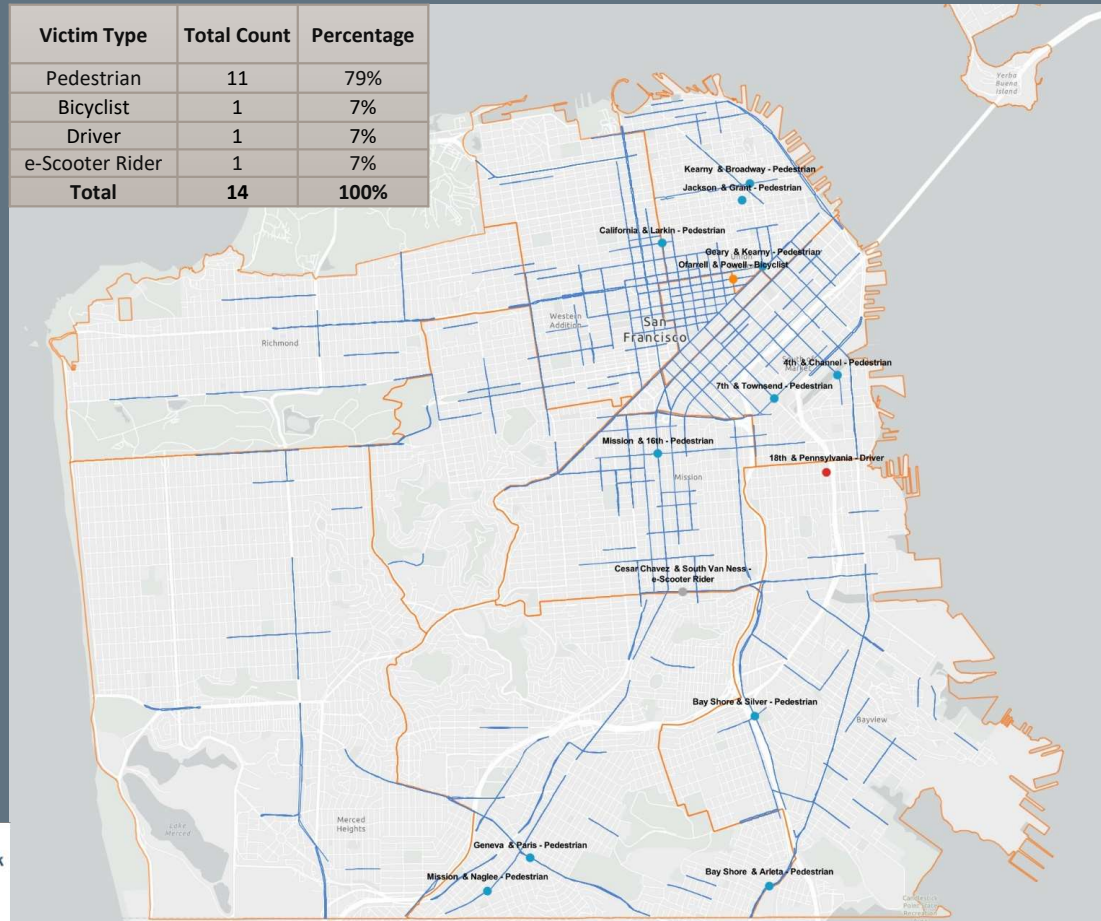
