
GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE

GUN VIOLENCE: Total gun violence is DOWN 26% compared to 2024

- There were 3 non-fatal shooting incidents causing injuries to 3 victim the week ending 08.31.25
 - For the year, there are a total of 65 firearm-related incidents resulting in 79 victims

TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are DOWN 32% compared to 2024




- There were no homicide incidents that occurred during the week ending 08.31.2025**

 - Overall Clearance Rate: 147% for 2025**





