## Summary for Nov 19, 2025

The Department of Police Accountability's highlight for the week:

- **Audit Update**
  - DPA provided a copy of the draft use-of-force audit to SFPD for review, and we've asked SFPD to provide a response by December 4<sup>th</sup>.
- **Policy Update**
  - We have identified crowd control cases to discuss with an SFPD SME to see whether policies or practices are leading to unnecessary tension with protesters, pursuant to our mandate under San Francisco Charter Section 4.136(h).
- **Executive Update**
  - Director Henderson received the Bruin Excellence in Civic Engagement Award from the UCLA Alumni Association.

### Investigation Updates:

- ♦ **Statistics Since the Last Police Commission Meeting (Nov 12, 2025):**
  - **Cases Opened:** 11
  - **Cases Closed:** 16
  - Year-to-Date Comparison:
    - **Case openings are up 22%** (143 cases) compared to the same period in 2024.
    - **Case closures are up 8%** compared to this time last year.
