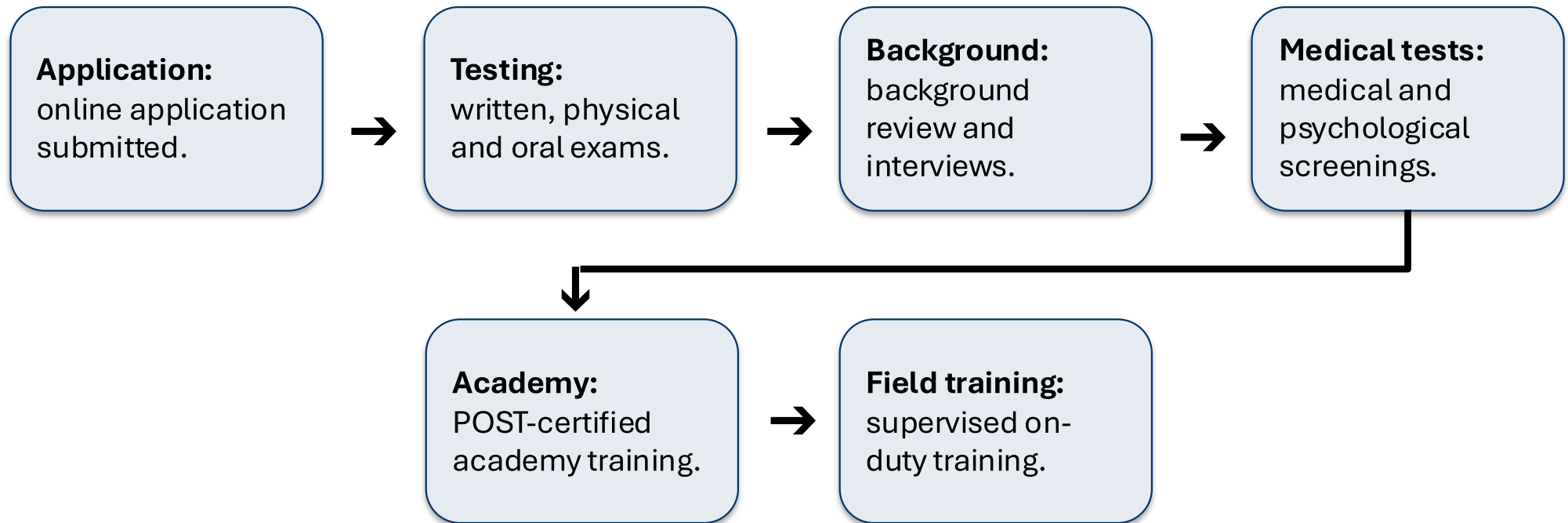

Recruitment & Applicant Process



Recruitment and testing jointly managed by SFPD and DHR

Process Improvements



Combined testing to streamline



Increased Academy frequency (five per year)



Expanded background unit; transition to eSOPH for faster tracking



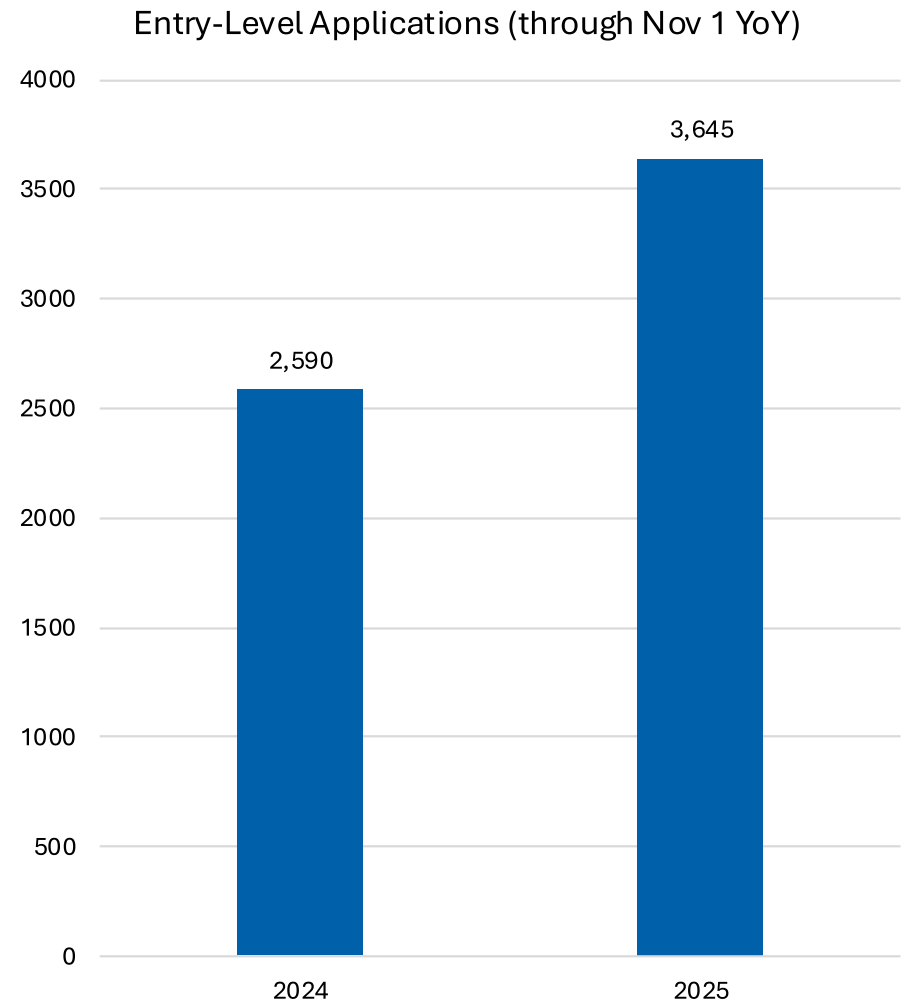
Parallel screening (medical, psych, polygraph)



Ongoing DHR collaboration

Application Trends

- 3,645 entry-level applications in 2025 (increase of 40% compared to 2024)
- 216 lateral applications in 2025
- Broader outreach and simplified online interface



Academy

- Four full classes started this year; fifth begins December 2025
- Recent classes:
 - Class 284: 31 graduated
 - Class 285: 31 graduated
 - Class 286: 37 in progress
 - Class 287: 51 in progress
 - Class 288: December 2025
- Academy capacity: 50-55 per class

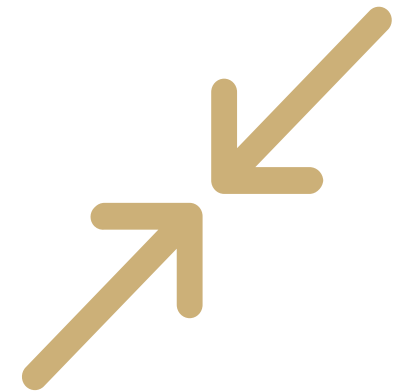
Backgrounds & Processing Time



Background investigation timelines reduced by 40%



Added full-time investigators, triage of high-quality candidates



Improved tracking, transition to eSOPH

Ideal Candidate Timeline (Case Study)

- Best-case 2025 candidate example:
 - May 14: Assigned to investigator
 - June 6: Interview and COE
 - June 16: Medical exam
 - June 21: Polygraph
 - July 1: Psych exam
 - July 9: Hiring meeting
- Approximately 8 weeks total from assignment to clearance

Candidate Quality & Diversity



- All applicants complete POST-certified background, psych, and medical reviews
- Working with Controller's Office on academy success analysis
- Bilingual incentive: \$80 biweekly

Next Steps

- Continue recruitment and background process improvements through 2026
- Improve integration with DHR
- Maintain transparency with regular public updates
