
GUN VIOLENCE – CITYWIDE

GUN VIOLENCE: Total gun violence is DOWN 29% compared to 2025

- There were 4 firearm-related shooting incidents causing injuries to 6 victims the week ending 02.02.26
 - 1 incident had 3 victims: 1 fatal/homicide and 2 non-fatal victims
 - 1 incident was a self-inflicted fatal; 2 incidents resulted in 2 non-fatal victims
 - For the year, there are a total of 8 firearm-related incidents resulting in 10 victims




TOTAL HOMICIDES: Homicides are UP 200% compared to 2025

- There was 1 homicide incident reported the week ending 02.02.26 which include 2 non-fatal victims**
 - There are 3 homicides YTD with 2 resulting from a firearm.
 - There are 0 homicides in February 2026
 - Overall Clearance Rate for 2026: 200%**






