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Dear Ballot Simplification Council,

I am writing to request that you clarify the effect of the measure entitled “Allowing Private Vehicles on the Great Highway in Sunset Dunes Park.” The digest fails to capture the simple reality that the measure would allow vehicles to drive **on** the park, not **in** or through the park. Sunset Dunes is a former roadway that was converted into a park, with the City adding new features on it over time. The measure makes it sound like vehicles could drive **in** the park much like vehicles can drive in Golden Gate and McLaren parks, when in reality **the former roadway is the park**, meaning that the park would close and all park stuff would have to be removed to make way for cars. This is a critical distinction because voters need to understand that permitting vehicles on the park precludes people from using the space as a park. Parents with strollers will no longer be able to walk in the park, park features would need to be removed, etc.
