Honorable Members of the Police Commission,

I am writing to express grave concern regarding the recent confrontation in the Tenderloin involving the Mayor's security detail and two members of our unhoused community, Tony Phillips and Abraham Simon.

The secondary surveillance footage of this incident raises serious questions about the "Officer-Created Jeopardy" doctrine. The video shows an officer initiating a violent shove against a citizen who did not appear to be an immediate physical threat. This escalation resulted in injuries and arrests that might have been avoided through standard de-escalation tactics.

I urge the Commission to:

Ensure a transparent disciplinary review of the officers involved.

Review the training and protocols for Executive Security details specifically when engaging with individuals experiencing homelessness or behavioral health crises in the Tenderloin.

We cannot allow the safety of city officials to be used as a justification for the summary use of force against the city's most vulnerable residents.
