The Signature Aviation San Francisco FBO facility will focus on delivering for all of Signature's Guests; their clients, their pilots, their crew, and their residents. Set in the heart of the San Francisco Bay, the main terminal building will be mindful of the history of the Pan Am Clipper class experience and utilize this as a beginning benchmark for the guest journey. The terminal campus will serve as a metaphorical runway for the guests and traveler. All the spaces will have the core design principles of effortless movement with an intuitive objective, surrounded by subtle luxuries supported by purposeful experiences. These principles will become apparent in each scale of a "take-off room" for the guests which will serve as the preparation space prior to boarding or as a reflection opportunity upon arrival. This experience is created through the blurring of indoor to outdoor spaces. Introducing natural light filled double height spaces which provide for a breath of fresh air before or after departing.
